





- 1) Open battery compartment on the underside of the radio control, insert one 9 Volt battery and close cover.
- 2) Open battery compartment on the underside of skateboard insert 2 AAA batteries and close cover.
- 3) Turn power switch "DN" on the side of radio control and Red LED will be light up.
- 4) Turn power switch "ON" on the underside of skateboard.
- 5) Attach magnetic figure to the center of board.








Do not use rechargeable batteries.
