

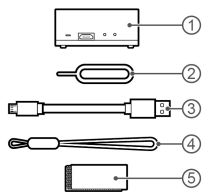

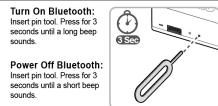

- 5. Velcro Pad

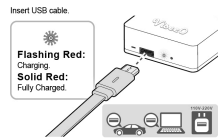
**Turning On & Off Bluetooth**

**Power Off Bluetooth:**  
Insert pin tool. Press for 3 seconds until a short beep sounds.

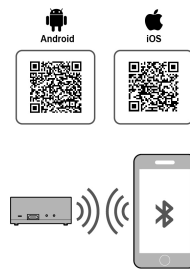


Insert USB cable.

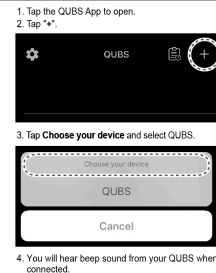
**Flashing Red:**

1. Tap current name.

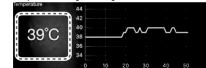


2. Type new name in Edit name field.

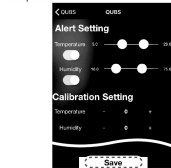

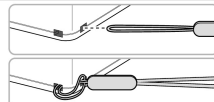
1. Tap on Reading Heading.



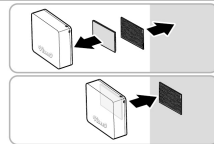
2. In QUBS menu, set the alert settings.
