PIVOTAL TRAINER ASSEMBLY

- Attach long beams to Y brackets (H, L to I)
- Attach sleeve brackets to vertical long beams (G to H)
- Attach vertical short beams to sleeve brackets (D to G)
- Attach 90° brackets to the top horizontal long beam, then mount to vertical short beams from previous step. **The top long beam is marked with holes in the middle** (A to B, AB to D)
- Align the motor/universal mounting bracket and ballistic shield on top of the horizontal long beam. Tighten them all together with screws (C to B)
- Thread the target armature through the motor housing (E to C)
- Mount 2 clamps to the target armature Tighten with zip ties. Ideal mount: 3rd hole to the outside (F to E)
- Attach the paper targets to the clamps. Arrange the targets so that "Shoot" and "Don't Shoot" are facing opposite directions. Adhere targets to cardboard for best results (N, O)
- \bullet Take the third clamp and thread the nylon rope through and tie off. Slip knot recommended (J)
- Attach the clamp to the bottom center of the paper target. Tie the excess nylon rope to bottom horizontal beam (J to K)
- Stake the legs if needed (M)


