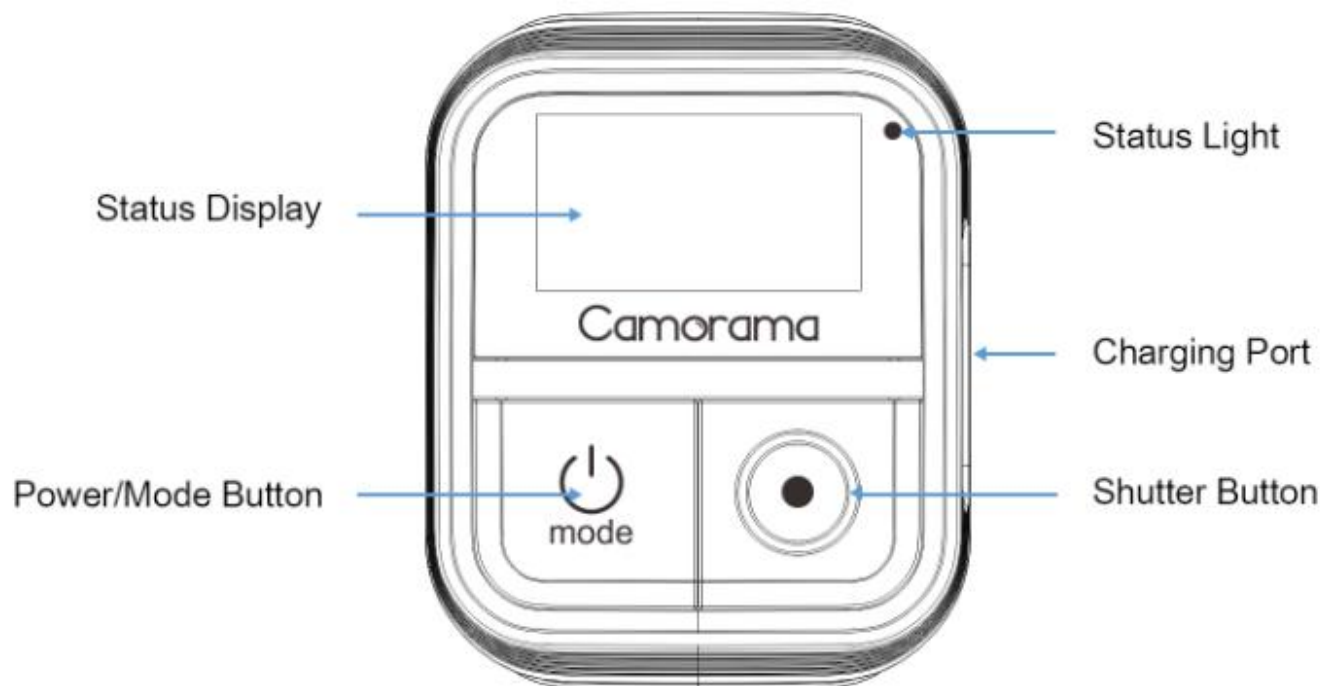




Camorama Remote Control Start Guide

1. Product Description

This product is the dedicate remote control watch for the Camorama panoramic camera. This remote wirelessly connects to the camera to control the camera and indicate camera status.



2. Getting Started Guide


Charge ⚡

The device comes with an omnidirectional magnetic charging cable. It is recommended to use a 5V / 1A power source to charge the remote.

A red light indicates the device is charging and the light will go off once the device is fully charged. The device can last around 15 hours on a full charge.

3. Basic Usage Guide

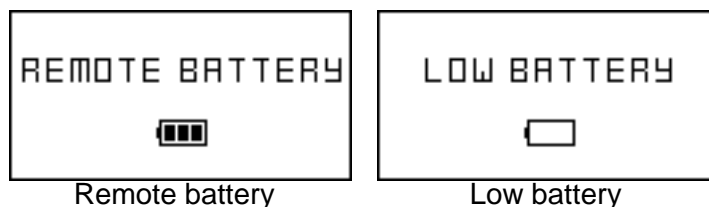
(1) Power on /off: mode

Power on: Short press the power button  to power on. The device will display the battery status and the current time.

The display is set to sleep automatically. Short press the power button or the shooting button to wake up the screen.

Tip: If the remote has not been connected to the camera for a long time, the time displayed may not be accurate. Reconnect the camera to sync the correct time.

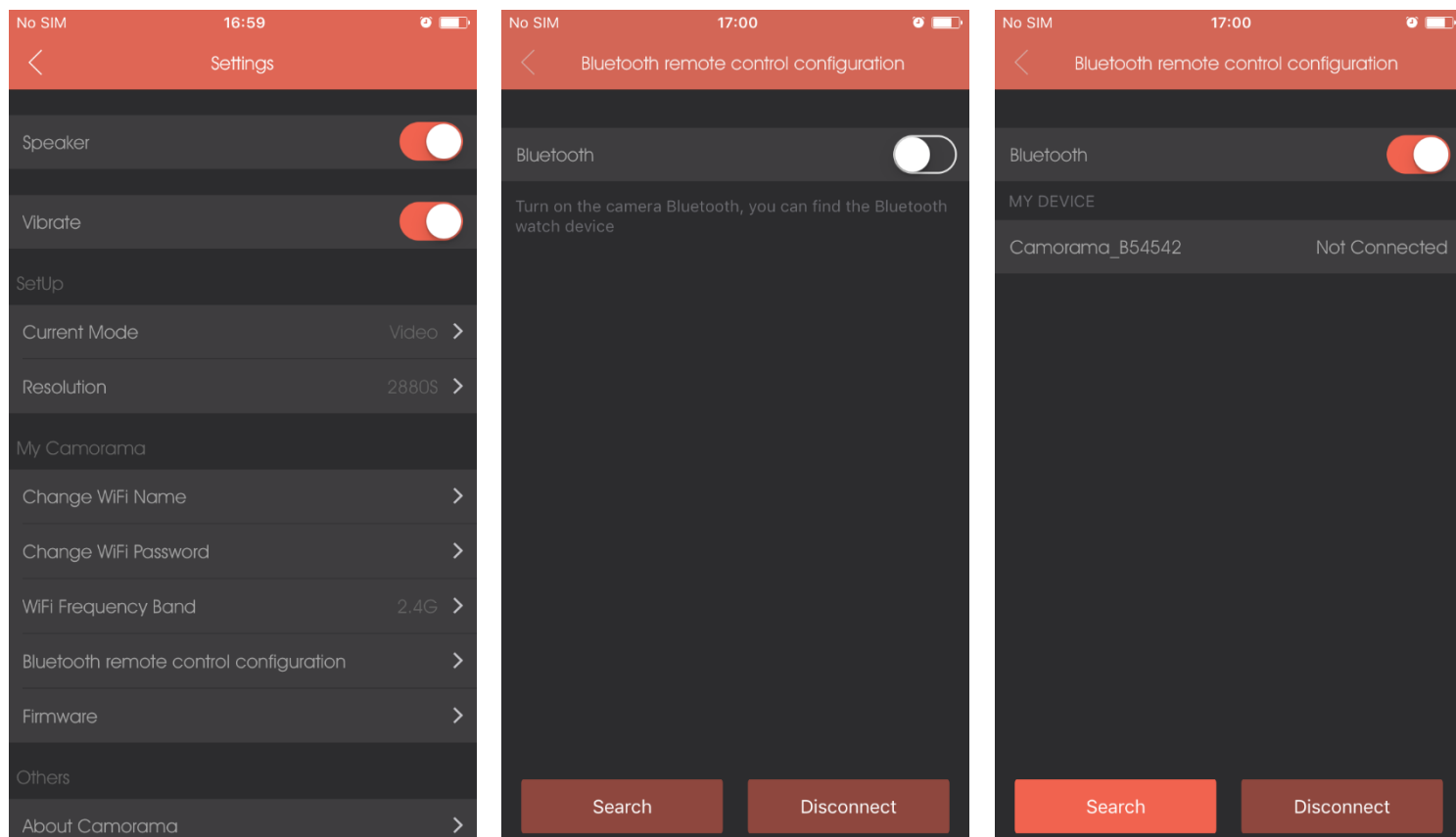
Power off: Press and hold to power button to power off. Before powering off, the watch of display the battery remaining. If battery is low, please charge the device.



(2) Connecting the Camera:

First Time: To connect for the first time, turn on both the camera and the remote control watch. In the Camorama app, turn on Bluetooth connection and select the device to connect. After connection, the remote watch will display the current shooting mode.

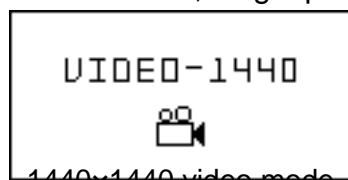
For subsequent connections, the remote watch will automatically connect to the camera. To release the automatic connection, go into Camorama app settings and forget the Bluetooth connection.



Connecting the Camera

(3) Switching the Shooting Mode:

After the remote is connected to the camera, the remote will display the following shooting mode. Short press the power/mode button to switch the shooting mode. Shooting modes include 1440x1440 video, 1920x1920 video, 2880x2880 video, single photo, and continuous shooting.

(4) Record:

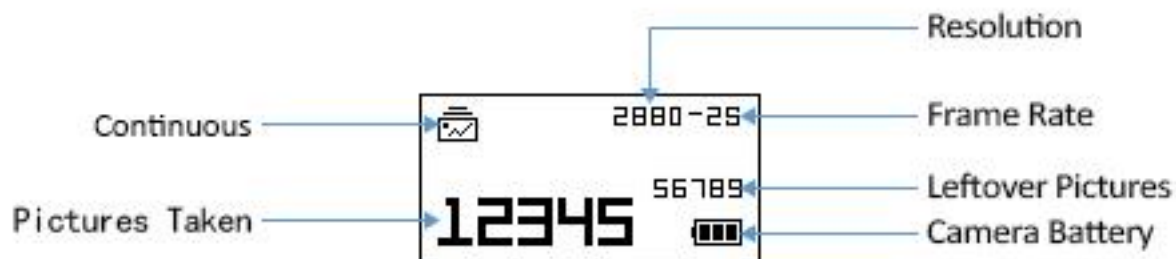
Under the photo mode, short press the capture button to take a panoramic picture.

Under the video modes, press the record button and the remote will show the current shooting status along with a flashing indicator light. To stop the video, press the power button again.

While recording, the camera will display the current shooting mode, resolution, frame rate, time elapsed, remaining time (storage), and camera battery.

4. Common Problem Solutions

- In the case of barrier free, the wireless connection distance between the remote control and the camera is about 6 meters.
- The camera has some built-in magnets, do not put the device close to easily magnetized items, such as mechanical watches.
- It's recommended to use the included USB to Micro USB cable to charge this device.
- Battery Maintenance: We do not recommend the camera in full or low battery conditions for a long time without working. If the camera is unused for a long time, it is recommended that the camera is charge and discharge every six months and keep the power around 50%.
