

Wireless Bluetooth 4.1 Audio Receiver with Mic

Product Details




1. Multi-function button (MFB)
2. LED indicator
3. Mic
4. 5V Micro USB charge port

Important Note

Please charge the Bluetooth receiver with standard DC 5V USB power adapter or car charger. Any charger with high-voltage output is NOT allowed and may affect the product performance.

How it Work



1. Turn On/Off


- Press and hold MFB for 3 seconds, the indicator light will flash blue 2 times/s. It is now turned on.
- Press and hold MFB for 3 seconds once again, the indicator will flash red 2 times. It is now turned off.
- To conserve power, if it is not paired to a device successfully within 5 minutes, it will turn off automatically.

2. Pairing to Your Device

- Keep it within range of a Bluetooth-ready cell phone; the distance should not exceed 10m/32ft.
- The receiver must be turned off. Press and hold the MFB for 3s, the indicator light will flash blue 2 times/s. The receiver is in pairing mode.
- Find the Bluetooth setting of your cell phone and start the search for Bluetooth devices.
- From the list of devices found, select the "Ugreen-Bluetooth"
- After pairing, the music receiver would automatically connect with the cell phone. The indicator will flash blue 1 time/10s.

Notes:

Once the devices have been paired, you do not need to repeat the pairing process, simply power both on, and they will automatically re-connect. (5 Bluetooth ID could be stored max)



3. Multi-Function Button Operation

Make sure your cell phone is successfully paired to this receiver, and this receiver is connected to your speaker or car stereo.

Play Music

- Short press – start to play music
- Short press once again--pause music play

Notes:

when you do not play music and double-click the MFB, you can dial the phone number of last call.

Incoming Call

- Short press --answer the coming call
- Short press once again-- hang up
- Double click--reject the call

Notes:

This receiver does not support voice volume control. You can adjust the volume on your cell phone.

4. Low Power Reminder

- When the battery power is less than 3.3V, the red indicator light would start to flash.
- Please kindly charge the Bluetooth receiver in time once it disconnects to your cell phone because of low battery.

5. Charge the Receiver

- This receiver is with a built-in rechargeable battery. Charge the battery completely before its first use.
- The red indicator light would turn blue when the battery is fully charged.
- It takes up to 1.5 hours to fully charge the receiver.
- Support charging while use.
