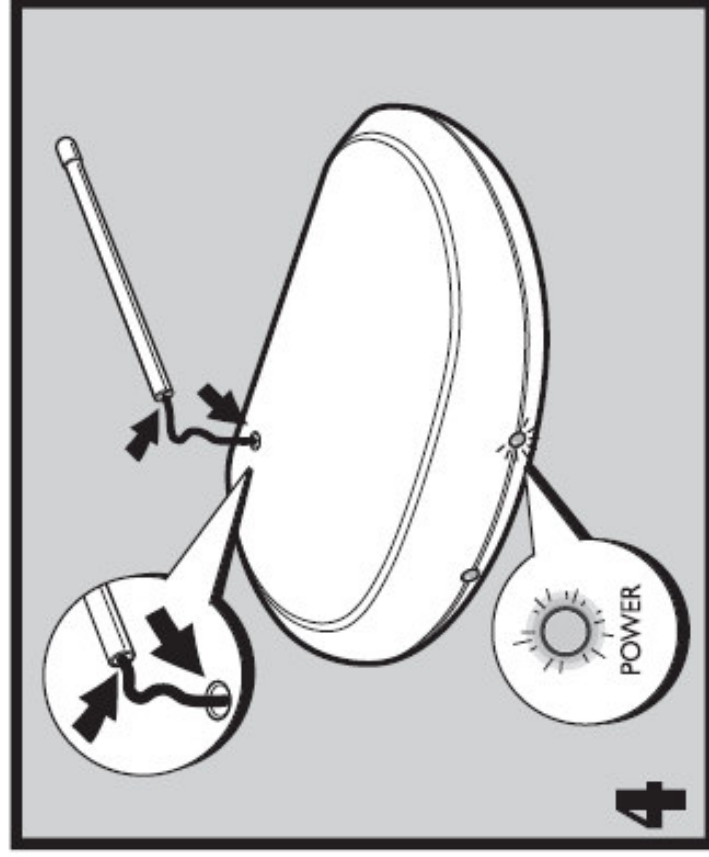
- (GB)** Open the rechargeable battery compartment on the right side (**R**) of headphone receiver, and insert two **AAA** type rechargeable batteries as enclosed in the packaging of the product, making sure their positive and negative (+ and -) poles are correctly aligned.



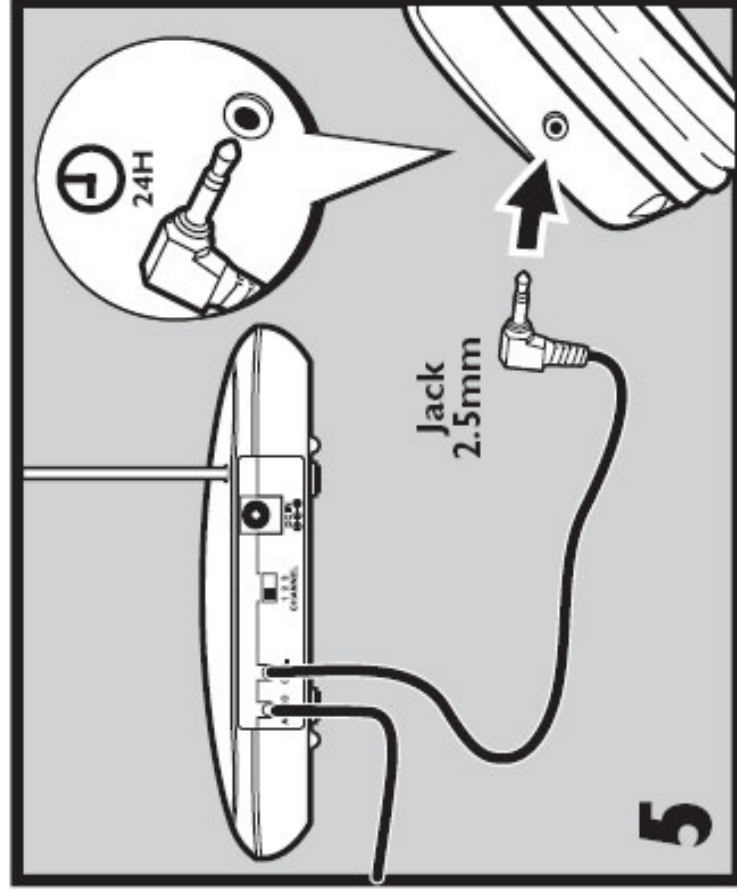
- (GB)** Close the rechargeable battery compartment.



- (GB) Connect the plug on the **AC/DC** mains adapter cable to the **DC IN** socket at the back of the cradle then plug the adapter into mains wall outlet.

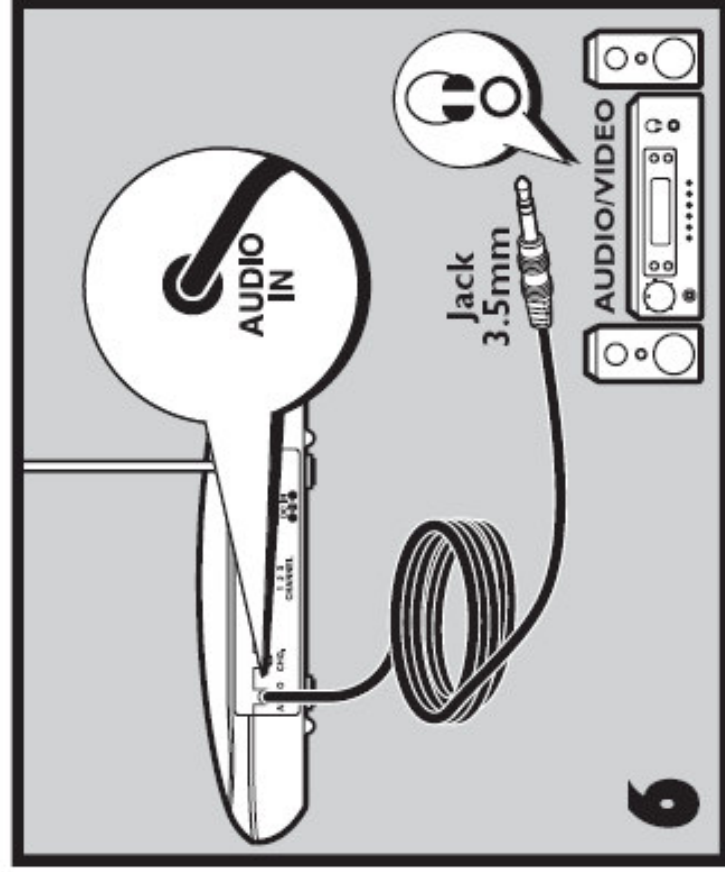


- (GB) The **Green** running light comes on when the transmitter is connected to the audio source and the audio source is turned on.



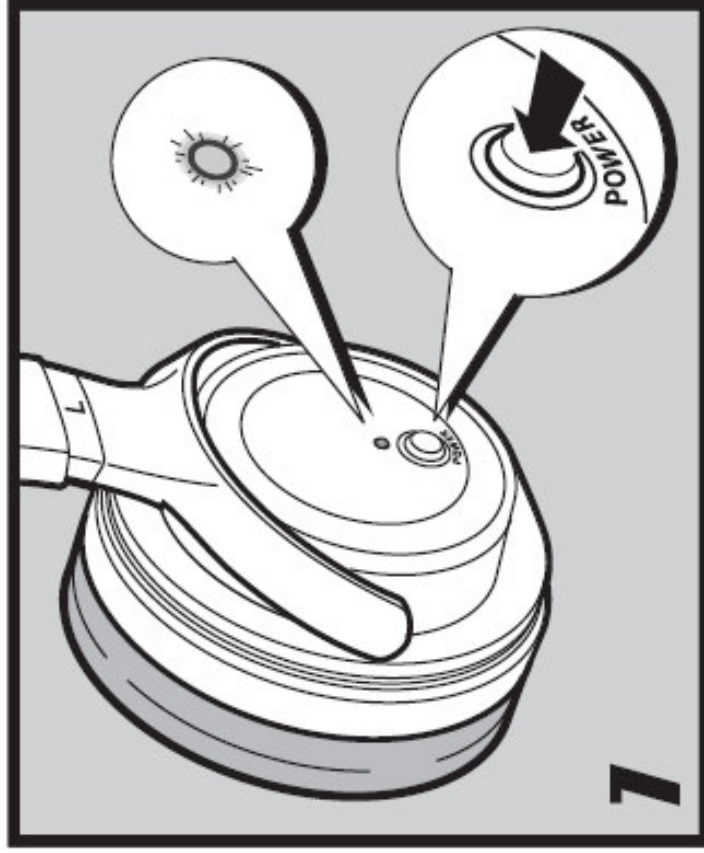

Take the charging cable with the **2.5mm power jack** and plug it into the recharging socket on the headphones. Make sure the Red light is on. Leave the headphones to charge for 24 hours. Second and subsequent charges take about 10 hours.

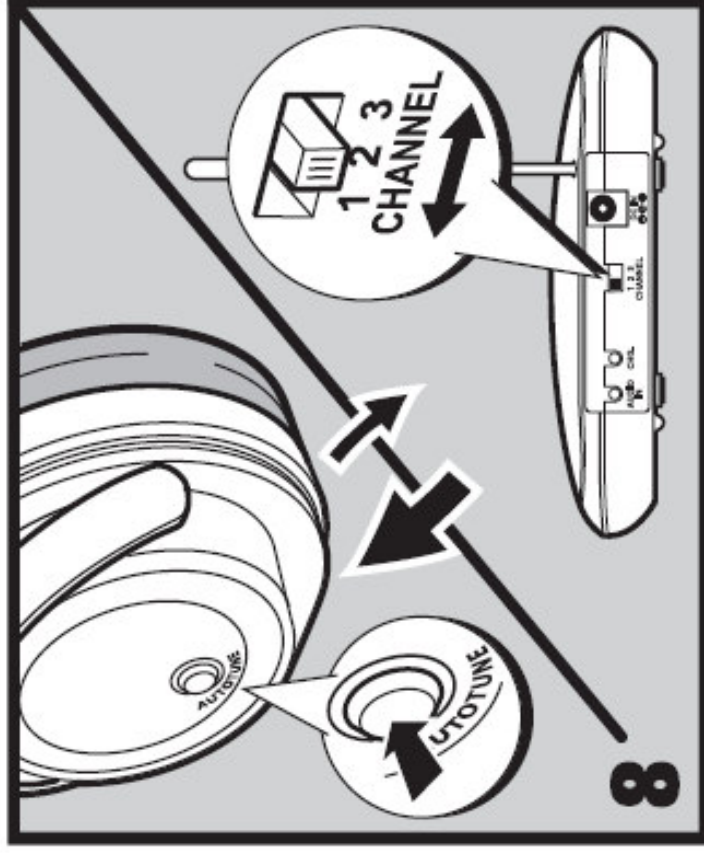

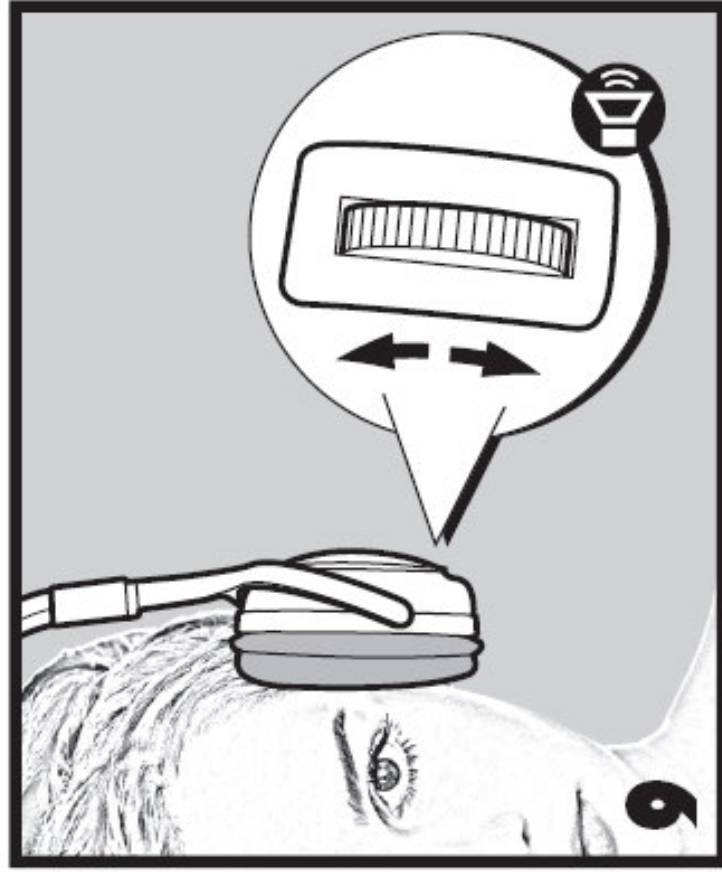
Connect the audio cable, fitted with its 3.5mm Jack Plug, to the headphone socket of an Audio appliance (amplifier or other device). Switch on the appliance and adjust its volume to roughly a quarter of the maximum setting.



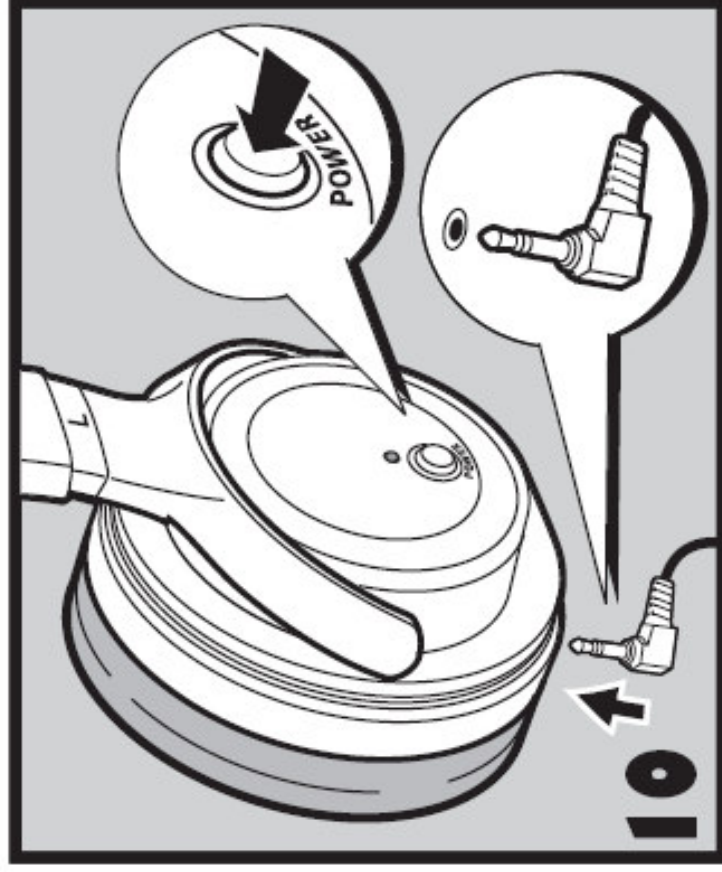
- (GB)** Switch on the headphones and make sure the running light comes on; this confirms that the rechargeable batteries contain power. Turn the volume adjustment thumbwheel to the half-way position.



- (GB)** Adjust headphone reception by pressing the auto scan button. If the sound is poor, change to a different channel on the transmitter and press the auto scan button once more.



- (GB) Turn the volume down on the headphones before putting them on your head; once you are wearing them, adjust the volume to suit.



- (GB) After using the headphones, switch them off and connect them back up to the transmitter using the cable with the **2.5mm power jack**, thereby recharging the rechargeable batteries.
