


# SKBM2010: User Guide



- 1. Insert USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer. (The USB reciever is stored in the mouse)
- 2. Push the **[POWER]** switch on the mouse to the on position.
- 3. Press the **[CONNECT]** button on the mouse.
- 4. Press the **[CONNECT]** button on the keyboard.
- 5. Do not exceed 30 feet between the keyboard/mouse and

## **Troubleshooting**

- Turn off your computer's power management feature before charging the mouse so that your computer doesn't enter sleep
- If necessary, use a USB extension cable to keep the receiver away from the computer.
- Avoid using the mouse on a metal surface. Metals, such as iron, aluminum or copper shield the radio frequency transmission and may slow down the mouse's response time or cause the mouse to fail.
