


### BASIC OPERATION - PARENT UNIT


#### Adjust speaker volume

Press **•** to adjust your parent unit speaker volume.



#### Talk to your baby unit

Press and hold **TALK** and speak to your baby unit. You can still hear sound from the baby unit even if you turn off the **TALK** button. Turn off the **TALK** button to stop talking and hear your baby again.



## PARENT UNIT ICONS (CONT'D)

**SOUND SENSITIVITY AND SOUND ACTIVATION**

**Adjust sound detection sensitivity**

You can turn on Sound activation and adjust the VOX sensitivity to control how many sounds that the VOX unit will respond to when the baby unit is off or dimmed.

When the baby unit detects sounds that exceed the current sensitivity level, the parent unit starts transmitting the sound to the parent unit. By sound activation, the parent unit will automatically turn on and alert you to baby if you are asleep and you can't hear it.

**Split mode**

The parent unit will automatically turn on and off when the baby unit is connected to the parent unit.

**Protot mode**

(For VMS4632-C only)

\* Baby unit detects temperature is off or is lower than the set minimum.

**NIGHT VISION**

The camera has infrared LEDs that allow you to see your baby at night or in dark rooms. When the baby unit is turned on, the infrared LEDs will automatically turn on and off depending on the surrounding and other infrared icons.

**Tip**

The projection light located on the top of the baby unit projects a starry night light scene onto the wall to help your baby fall asleep.

**Sound activated screen and audio**

When Sound activation is on, the parent unit will turn off after 10 minutes of inactivity. In the VOX sensitivity mode, the parent unit will turn off or dimmed.

• Displays when parent unit's battery is low and needs charging.

• Displays when connection between parent unit and baby unit is lost.

• Displays when sound is detected by a baby unit when in Split view. [For VMS4632-C only]

• Baby unit detects temperature reaches or exceeds the set minimum.


• Baby unit detects temperature is off or is lower than the set minimum.

**DIM MODE**

The parent unit display will dim to conserve energy after 10 minutes of inactivity, in which there is no motion sensor data received from the baby unit.
