1.1 Introduction

In the first installation and use of this product, please be sure to carefully read all the information description, which will help you make better use of the product, get a comprehensive understanding of the use of mobile phones and enjoy its perfect functions and simple method of operation.

The full keyboard phone is designed for GSM / GPRS network environment. In addition to the basic function of communication, it also includes Chinese and English input, Bluetooth, JAVA,WIFI, FM radio, Mp3, Mp4 player,Kingr Move, polyphonic ringtones, calendar management, Entertainment, calculators, etc., a variety of practical functions, to facilitate your work and leisure activities. In addition, it uses individual man-machine interface, the perfect functional design to meet your needs.

Note: If the content described in this manual does not match with your phone, please phone prevail.

Our Company reserves the right to make changes without any prior notice the contents of this manual.

1.2 Safety

- If your phone is lost or defective, please immediately notify the telecommunication sector or its outlet, to disable the phone and SIM card. It will help you avoid the economic losses if someone makes a call pretend to be you.
- When you contact with the telecommunications sector or its outlet, they need to know your phone's IMEI number (which is printed on the label on the back of the phone; remove the battery and you can find it), please take good care of this number for future needs.
- To make your phone avoid misuse, please take precautionary measures, such as:
 - Set PIN number in the SIM card of your phone, and change it before others know.
 - You'd better take along your phone or lock it in the trunk when you leave your car; please do not put the phone in the place easy to be seen.—
 - Set calls restrictions

1.3 General considerations

- Only use your cell phone batteries and chargers designated. Using

other products may cause battery leakage, overheating, bursting and fire.

- Do not crash, shake or throw the mobile phone to avoid error and fire.
- Do not leave the battery, the phone, the charger in a microwave or a high-pressure device, or it may cause circuit damage and fire and other accidents
- Do not use mobile phone near the place with flammable or explosive gases, or it may cause malfunction and a fire.
- Do not put the phone near the place with high temperatures or excessive dust or it may cause malfunction.
- Please keep the phone be out of children's reach, for avoiding injury may be caused when they play with it as a toy.
- Do not place the phone on the table which is uneven or unstable, to prevent from malfunction or damage caused by falling.

1.4 Notes on use of mobile phones

- Please turn off your phone on the plane, in hospitals or in the areas where using it is prohibited. The phone will affect electronic equipment and medical devices, please follow the relevant provisions of the place, The phone has a timer automatic start function, please check your timer switch settings to make sure your cell phone won't automatically turn on during the flight.

- Do not use your phone near weak signal or high-precision electronic devices. Interference from radio wave may cause malfunction of electronic devices and other problems. Especially pay attention when near the following devices: hearing aids, pacemakers and other medical electronic equipment, fire detectors, automatic doors and other automatic device. If you meet with the impact of a pacemaker and other medical electronic equipment caused by mobile phone, please contact with the manufacturer of the device or local distributor.
- Do not press on the LCD screen or use it to knock something else, otherwise it will cause breakage of the LCD panels and LCD liquid leakage. If the LCD fluid enters your eyes, it will be in danger of blind. Then immediately wash the eye (do not rub your eyes) and go to hospital.
- Do not disassemble or modify the phone, or it may cause damage, leakage and circuit failure.
- In rare cases, using the phone in some models of cars may adversely affect the electronic equipment inside. Do not use your phone in this case to avoid loss of security guarantees.
- Do not use needles and other sharp things to press the keys, otherwise it will damage the phone or produce misuse.
- If the antenna is damaged, please do not use the phone, or it may cause personal injury.

- Avoid putting the phone too close to the magnetic cards and other magnetic objects; mobile phone radiation may remove the information stored in the floppy disk, the savings card, and the credit card.
- Please keep thumbtacks and other small metal objects away from the handset of mobile phone. The magnetic made by speaker will attract the small metal objects, which may cause personal injury or damage to the mobile phone.
- Avoid wetting the phone. If water or other liquids enter the mobile phone, it will cause overheating, leakage and failure.

1.5 Notes on batteries

- Do not leave batteries in the fire, otherwise it will cause the battery catch fire and burst.
- Do not use wires, needles and other metal objects to short-circuit the battery; or put the battery with metal objects such as necklaces together, otherwise. It will result in battery leakage, overheating, bursting and fire.
- Do not solder the battery ends; otherwise it will lead to leakage, overheating, bursting and fire.
- If the battery fluid into the eye, it would be the risk of blindness. Then please do not rub the eyes; you should rinse it with water, and then

immediately go to hospital.

- Do not disassemble or modify the battery, or it will cause battery leakage, overheating, bursting and fire.
- Do not use put the battery near fire or other high-temperature heater, it will cause battery leakage, overheating, bursting and fire.
- If there are charging temperature, discoloration, distortion and other anomalies when the battery is in use, charging or store, please stop using and replace it with a new battery.
- If the battery liquid touches the skin or clothing, which may burn skin, please rinse with water immediately, and go to hospital if necessary.
- If the battery has fluid leakage or gives off a strange odor, please take it away from the flame immediately to avoid fire and burst.

1.6 Notes on using the charger

- Use the 220V AC. Use other voltage may cause leakage, fire and damage to the cell phone and charger.
- Do not short-circuit the charger, otherwise it will cause electric shock, smoke and damage the charger.
- Please do not use the charger if the power line is damaged, otherwise it will cause a fire and electric shock.
- Please clean the dust on the power outlet in time.
- Please do not put water containers next to the charger to prevent

overheating, leakage and failure caused by water spills.

- If the Chargers come into contact with water or other liquids, pull the power from the outlet down immediately to prevent overheating, fire, electric shock and charger failure.
- Do not disassemble or modify the charger, otherwise it will result in personal injury, electric shock, fire and damage the charger.
- Please do not use the charger in bathroom where has high temperatures, otherwise it will cause electric shock, fire and damage the charger.
- Please do not touch the charger, wires and electrical outlets with wet hands, otherwise it will cause electric shock.
- Do not put heavy objects on the power cord or modified the wires, otherwise it will cause electric shock and fire.
- Before you clean and maintain the power plug, unplug it out of the socket set.
- Seize the charge when you unplug the plug. Pulling the power cord may damage the wires, electric shock and fire.

Note: This manual is in Chinese Simplified operation mode instructions, and it is slightly different from the English mode of operation.

If the content described in this manual does not match with your phone, please phone prevail.

1.7 Cleaning and maintenance

- Do not use the phone in bathroom where has high temperature, for battery and charger is not waterproof, and it should also avoid the rain.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the phone, battery and charger.
- Do not use alcohol, thinner or benzene solution to wipe the phone.
- Dirt outlet will lead to poor contact, power-down, which can cause no longer charge. Please do regular cleaning.

1.8 General precautions

Mobiles:

- Use the phone between the 5⁰C~40⁰C temperature and under the 35% to 85% humidity environment.
- If possible, use your phone away from the ordinary telephone, television, radio and office automation equipment in order not to affect the effect of these devices and the mobile phone.

Battery:

- Keep the battery in cool ventilated place and out of the sunlight.
- Phone battery's life is limited. Battery's working time is reduced gradually during the frequent charging. Invalid charging for many times means the battery's life is over, and it should be replaced by a new battery of specified type.

Waste battery handling instructions:

- For your safety and taking care of the environment, do not throw the waste batteries into general garbage. The battery waste shall be expressly provided by the local sites for disposal of batteries recycled.

Charger:

- Do not charge in the following areas: direct sunlight; outside with temperature below 50C or above 400C; humid, dusty place or vibration (it may cause failure); near television, radio and other electrical appliances (it will affect the image and sound effects).

2.2 SIM card

You must insert a valid SIM card before using the phone. SIM card is

the key to the digital GSM network.

All the relevant information and your call established of a network connection are recorded in the SIM card initialization of the metal surface area; meanwhile the names, phone number and SMS stored and received are also recorded in the phone book of your SIM card. SIM cards can be removed from your phone and put it into any GSM phone to use (a new mobile phone automatically read the SIM card).

In order to prevent loss and damage from the card information, you should avoid touching the metal surface area, and keep SIM card away from electricity and magnetism place. Once the SIM card is damaged, you can not enter the GSM network.

Note: Be sure to remove SIM card after the phone off. There is absolutely prohibited in the case of an external power supply connected to insert or remove a SIM card, or SIM card may be damaged.

2.2.1 SIM Card insertion and removal

- Off the phone, and remove the other external power supply.
- Insert the SIM card into the SIM card connector, and ensure that the SIM card is properly inserted and the card's metal contacts well.
- When you need to remove the SIM card, first off it then removes the SIM card.

2.3 Battery

The initial state of battery charge has about 50% of the electricity. The first time to charge you should completely exhausted it (depleted battery will not turn on it) and then completely filled it; have it completely run out before the second charging; so after three consecutive cycles, the battery will be easier to achieve the best condition.

Note: The battery is welded one. Do not arbitrarily remove it under normal circumstances.

2.3.1 Battery charging

- Plug the charger.
- Plug the charger connector into the bottom of the phone, "charging / data transfer interface."
- At this time, the screen upper right corner of the charge level indicator will flash in cycle: If the charge is turned off, charging indicator will appear on the screen, which means the battery is charging. If the phone is still excessive used when the power is low, the charging indicator may take some time after the start to appear on the screen.
- When the indicator in the upper right corner of the screen indicator shows full and no longer flashes, it means that the charge has been completed. This process usually takes 3 to 4 hours. During charging,

batteries, cell phone and charger may become hot, which is normal.

➤ After charging, disconnect the AC power outlet with phone and charger.

➤ Note:

—It must be placed in temperature $+5^{\circ}\text{C}\sim+40^{\circ}\text{C}$ for ventilation while charging and be sure to use the charger provided by the manufacturer. Using an unapproved charger may be dangerous and it violate the recognition of the mobile phone and warranty.

—When the phone is automatically shut down or show low battery warning "battery low", it is timely to charge the battery. If you do not run out it before charging the battery, the phone will automatically reduce the charging time.

—The standby and talk time provide by Mobile phone manufacturers are based on the ideal working environment. In actual use, the battery working time may be changed as the network status, work environment and the way of use.

—After charging, please disconnect the charger with the phone and power.

If you do not have the charger with power and phone off, then after a fairly long time (about 5-8 hours), battery power consumption to a certain extent, the phone began to charge again. We suggest that you do not do it like this, because it will have some impact on your battery performance

and life.

2.4 Power

- To turn on the phone, please press the switch button for a while.
- When you open the phone and insert SIM card, your phone will automatically verify whether the SIM card is available. Then the screen will display the following order:

—Enter the phone password (if you set the phone lock password)

- Mobile decryption is decrypt; the phone will search for available networks automatically.

Once contacted, the network provider's name will appear in the upper left corner of the screen. It means cell phone is in the normal standby mode, you can engage in normal use.

Note: If the screen says "no service" means that you are out of the normal network coverage (service area), but you can still send an emergency call as the signal strength.

2.5 USB data cable to use

The way of using USB data cable: one end of the USB data cable is inserted into the PC (personal computer) on the USB port, then connect the other end to the bottom of the phone, "Charge / Data Interface" on.

The phone supports USB, USB data cable you can connect your phone to

your computer, mobile phone and the computer to copy, move files, etc, T can also browse the photos stored on the card, audio, video and other documents.

Note: This phone only supports the power-state data transmission.

2.6 T-flash card to install/ remove

T-flash card, which is a multimedia memory card to increase memory, is built into the fuselage of the phone. This relatively small card should be installed or removed carefully to avoid damage. non-professional personnel had better do not open the fuselage T-flash card extraction.

Note: This phone does not support T-flash card hot swap.

3. Basic Instructions

3.1 Keyboard introduction

3.1.1 Basic keys

➤ ON / OFF button:

—Press and hold button function of the Executive on or off ; in any menu interface, press this button to the idle screen.

➤ OK button:

—Standby for access to the main menu interface, the implementation of

identified functions in other menu. That the implementatinon of the same features as the left soft key.

➤ **Left soft button:**

—Standby for access to the main menu interface, the implementation of identified functions in other menu.

➤ **Right soft button:**

—Click here to enter the standby list to the phone book interface.

—Press this button when a call reject the implementation of the current phone features; returns in other executive functions menu interface.

➤ **Dial button:**

—Press to enter standby enter the number to dial-up selection screen, press this button while standby access to the call log interface, and the other in a call can be answered when the press(Note: the list in the phone book and SMS interface, click here to view Button to select the dial-up were entered into the interface).

➤ **Volume control**

3.3 Phone function

When the network provider's logo appears on the display, you can make or receive calls. Upper left corner of the display, the network signal bar shows the signal strength (When there are 4, it shows that the signal is

the strongest). Call quality is affected greatly by the obstacle, so the movement in a small area can improve call quality.

3.3.1 Make a call

➤ International calls

To make international calls, you can press the * key until the display international call prefix symbol "+", which will allow you do not know the local international telephone prefix number (example: in China, 00), from any States call.

3.3.2 Answer the call

- Under normal circumstances, there is an incoming call, press the answer key or click the option to receive calls; press END key or touch the end of the call button, end the call.
- If the headset is plugged in, you can also use the buttons on the headset to answer calls

3.3.3 Reject calls

- Press this button when a call reject the current call.

3.3.4 Call menu

During the call state, according to the option to access the call menu. It is the same way to the method of operation and functions of the menu.

The call menu only can be seen during a call; and call waiting, call hold and other functions need network supporting, please contact with your network provider.

In the call menu, you can do the following:

- Hands-free: hands-free calls to open the current function (Note: During a call press the right software can also perform hands-free interface call).
- Mute: Do not send / send local voice restoration
- To keep: to keep the current call or the call recovery is maintained.
- End the call: To end the current call.
- Volume: implement current volume up and down.
- DTMF: on or off DTMF.
- Recording: to record voice calls.
- Address Book: to enter the phonebook menu.
- Information: enter the information menu.

Conference call

When there are three-way call, press the left soft key to enter option "switch" menu to switch the call card.

—Speakerphone: Hands-free call to open the current function (Note: During a call press the right software can also perform hands-free interface call).

—Mute: Do not send / send local voice restoration

- Switch: Exchange the side of keeper and activitier.
- End the single call: end the active current call.
- End the current call: end the current to maintain the call.
- Transfer: The current call transferred to other phones.
- Volume: By adjust the volume up and down arrow keys.
- DTMF: Open or close the dual tone multi-frequency.
- Recording: Record a voice.
- Address Book: To enter the phonebook menu.
- Information: To enter the information menu.

*** Note: Some menu items only appear in the circumstances determined. Such as "switch" only exists in the state of the phone and call phone only appears to be suspended.**

3.4 Handsfree

- During the call, click on the touch screen or press the right soft key can be hands-free speakerphone. (Note: press the left soft key in the dial-up process can also open the hands-free)

4. Menu Introduction

4.1 Phonebook

You may make full use of phone book to store some vip's name, mobile phone number, family number, company number and so on.

Please choose “phone book” from main menu, and then enter it.

Note: this mobile phone can store 2000 phone numbers.

You can see the following options in phone book detailed as :quick search, name search, add number, copy all, delete, incoming categories, other numbers, setup, incoming photo sticker, incoming ring, incoming films and so on.

Phone book list interface press option sword can perform the following actions:

View: Choose to view the current number

Call: Select 1 from the card or card 2 dial-out.

Send: Select the text or multimedia message sending.

New: To and new contact.

Delete: Select Delete this number.

Mark: Select a single record all the tag or the tag.

Copy to SIM/ Phone : This number is copied to the SIM card or mobile phone.

Assign to group: Select stored in any number on the mobile phone to join the group or blacklist.

4.2 Messages

4.2.1 Create new

➤ SMS

Write SMS: write messages into the sub-menu, you can enter text messages.

—Complete: Select text input is completed, said the article, you can enter the next step.

1. Add recipient: choose to receive information number.
2. Saved as drafts: Select this to edit messages saved to the Drafts.
3. Insert: Select insert pictures, sounds, videos, templates, contacts, calendar (Note: Selecting this operation will be automatically converted to MMS).
4. Converted to MMS: MMS converted this information.
5. Send Options: Select from the card 1 or card 2 send this message.
6. Input Menu: Select the following:

—Insert a symbol: You can insert the symbol you want

—Input Method: Select the desired input method editing

—Language: Select language editing interface here

* **Note:** Some cities and regions of the short message center do not support more than 70 characters (or 160 English characters), the length of the message.

➤ MMS

MMS can be edited into the option to select the following:

1. Add To: choose to receive MMS number.
2. Insert: Choose Insert pictures, sounds, videos, templates, contacts,

schedule.

3. Insert page: in the current editing mode, select Insert before or after this page.

4. Preview: Preview the current editor of multimedia options.

5. Convert to SMS: Select this can be directly converted to text editing interface.

6. Save as a draft: this MMS saved to Drafts.

7. Page Setup: to set the play time and the text display.

4.2.2 SMS

Enter this menu to select the appropriate SIM card, enter the Inbox, Draft box, Outbox, Sent box menu list interface.

➤ Inbox

—Reply: Select by way of SMS or MMS reply to each other.

—Forward: forward the current message or multimedia message to other people.

—Delete: Delete current information.

—Call sender: selective calling the current number.

—Save sender: ave the number of sender.

—Copy to SIM card or mobile phone: select the current information copied to the SIM1 / 2 or mobile phone.

—Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

➤ **Drafts box**

Select Drafts to enter, the screen pop-up boxes: open, write the information, delete, copy to the SIM card or mobile phone, tag, details:

—Open: Select Open to view this information.

—Write a message: Select the SMS or MMS to edit the information.

—Delete: Delete current information.

—Copy to SIM card or mobile phone: select the current information copied to the SIM1 / 2 or mobile phone.

—Tag: optional tag or all of the tags.

—Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

➤ **Outbox**

Select Sent Items box to enter, the screen pop-up boxes: heavy to send, write messages, delete, delete all, go to the Drafts, the details:

—Re-send: Select Resend.

—Write a message: Select the SMS or MMS to edit the information.

—Delete: Delete current information.

—Delete all: Select this mailing box to delete all the information.

—Go to Drafts: Drafts of choice to move this information.

—Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

➤ **Sent box**

Select Outbox after entering the interface pop-up boxes: open, write the information, delete, copy to the SIM card / mobile phone, tag, details:

- Open: Open to view this information.
- Write a message: Select the SMS or MMS to edit the information.
- Delete: Delete current information.
- Copy to SIM card or mobile phone: select the current information copied to the SIM1 / 2 or mobile phone.
- Tag: optional tag or all of the tags.
- Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

4.2.3 MMS

➤ **Inbox**

Select the Inbox list to view any information into the interface options menu in the realization of this interface by the following: back, forward, delete, call sender, IP call, copied to the SIM card or mobile phone, the details:

- Reply: Select by way of SMS or MMS reply to each other.
- Forward: forward the current message or multimedia message to other people.
- Delete: Delete current information.
- Call sender: selective calling the current number.
- IP call: Select the form of a call through the IP.
- Play message: Play current information.
- —Save sender: ave the number of sender.

—Objects: Extract the current information in the pictures, ring tones, etc.

—View Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

➤ **Drafts box**

Select Drafts to enter, the screen pop-up boxes: open, write the information, delete, copy to the SIM card or mobile phone, tag, details:

—Open: Select Open to view this information.

—New message: Select the SMS or MMS to edit the information.

—Delete: Delete current information.

—Mark: Mark or mark all.

—Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

➤ **Outbox**

Select Sent Items box to enter, the screen pop-up boxes: heavy to send, write messages, delete, delete all, go to the Drafts, the details:

—Delete all: Select this mailing box to delete all the information.

—Move to Draft: Go to Drafts.

—View Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

➤ **Sent box**

Select Outbox after entering the interface pop-up boxes: open, write the information, delete, copy to the SIM card / mobile phone, tag, details:

- Open: Open to view this information.
- New message: Select the SMS or MMS to edit the information.
- Delete: Delete current information.
- Mark: Mark or mark all.
- View Details: View the current message of the date, time and sender.

4.2.4 Template

Common information can be used to write some sentences in order to avoid sending duplicate messages one by one when the input can be edited or deleted.

4.2.5 Voice Mail

Listen to voice mail by calling voice mail. The first time, you will be asked to enter your voicemail number.

4.2.6 Setting

Select this to enter, can SMS, MMS, cell broadcast, voice mail and make the appropriate settings:

➤ SMS

—Service Centre number: set the phone number of the current short message.

- Service center No: select GPRS or CSD.
- Validity period: set the time for receiving text messages.
- Message type: select a text, call, email, fax.
- Staus report: can be set on or off.
- Direct reply: can be set on or off.
- Inbox location: choose to receive text message is stored.
- Backup sent msgs: to turn on or off.
- MMS: can be set and send the page to set options.

4.2.7Memory Status

Select this entry, you can view the current SIM card or mobile phone for use.

4.3 Call history

The call history contains All Calls, Missed Calls, Answered Calls, and Outgoing Calls. You can enter "Option" for such operations as View, Dial,

4.4 Settings

4.4.1 General

4.4.1.1 Personalization

Include the display, standby interface, ring setting and language

setting.

➤ Display

——Transition :On or Off.

——Screensaver : Can enter the Status, Duration, Screen display settings accordingly.

——Backlight: you can set LCD backlight brightness and backlight time through this function.

——Wallpaper : Select any picture to do the standby wallpaper.

——Operator name : Select on or off.

➤ Display language

You can set the language, written language and the default input method here.

This phone has various language modes including English, you can press the key to choose the language you want to use.

You can set the written methods in this phone for the different languages. When the language is English, you can choose the default input method: Abc. When the language is other language, you can choose other input methods.

➤ Navigation keys

Set about the direction of the upper and lower standby interface shortcut function keys.

4.4.1.2 Date/Time

Time and date: set time and date.

- —Set Home city: choose a city for the time setting.
- —Set time/date: set current time and date.
- —Set format: set the display format of time Setting.12 hours and 24 hours.

4.4.1.3 Power on/off

You can set the time and state of automatic power-on and power-off.

4.4.1.4 Information

You can check your phone ID code, memory information, software version here.

4.4.1.5 Security

➤ PIN code setting

You can start the PIN lock system and modify the password of PIN1 and PIN2 here. You should input the PIN code preset by the network service provider first, then you can operate this function.

➤ Phone lock

You can start the phone lock and modify the phone password here. You should input the factory default password first, then you can operate

this function.

The factory default password is 0000.

➤ SIM lock

You can check the SIM card lock state and modify the password here.

➤ Auto keypad lock

You can set the item manually to lock the phone immediately and also can select automatical lock, so that the screen and keyboard will be automatically locked when the phone enters the standby screen and has not been used for a period of time.

Press the left soft key + * key to unlock it.

4.4.1.6 Restore settings

You can use this option to reset the phone to the factory state or only to the default setting. You should input your phone password first, then you can operate this function. Phone default password is: 0000.

When the phone is reset to the factory state, all the data will be deleted.

4.4.2 Phone

➤ Call setting

You can choose to set the call waiting, sending this phone number,

any key to answer, call time reminding, automatic redial, automatic answer, answer reminding, cost setting, IP number and call group of card 1 and card 2.

——Call waiting: Switch on/off call waiting function. And choose inquiry to check current call waiting state.

——Call identity: Select on or off sending native number.

——Any key answer: Select on or off any key answer.

——Minute reminder: Select set call time remind.

——Auto redial: Set on or off automatic replay.

5.2.1 Common problems

Please confirm whether you have inserted SIM card. If your card has been inserted but can not be used, please try to use a dry cloth to wipe the

gold part of SIM card, then insert SIM card again, if it still can't be used, please contact your system supplier.

➤ No network

If you locate in the area that has no network coverage, or there is a physical obstruction between the transmitter and you, such as the hermetic space, the standby screen will show no network, you can't dial or answer the phone. You can try to close the window where there is network coverage.

➤ Emergency calls only
