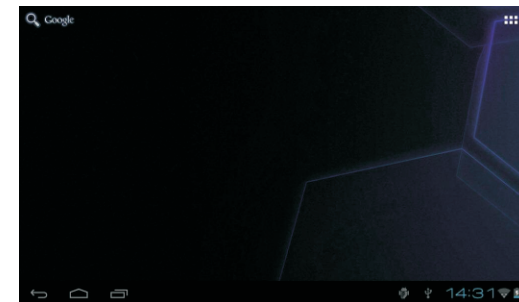
### Security Alert

1	Camera	Taking pictures or recording video
2	Built-in microphone	Used for video Conference,dubbing and simple recording
3	Audio output Interface	Audio output,connect to headphone
4	Cut power	Forced off with needle insert the reset hole, you can't turn off the tablet PC by press power button 4S, when the system stuck
5	DC-In Jack	Connect to the DC power supply
6	Micro-USB Port	Connect Micro-USB device
7	Mini-HDMI Port	External mini high-definition Multimedia monitor
8	Micro-SD	External Micro-SD card to extend storage
9	Built-in speaker	Sound output
10	Battery status indicator	If the light being amber means the battery is charging, if the light being blue means it's been fully charged.
11	Power button	Press for more than 4 seconds to turn on/off; press once for screensaver, press again to wake it up
12	Volume button	Increase the volume
13	Volume button	Decrease the volume
14	Back key	Back to the previous interface from the current interface
