Required / Requisite

Make sure the Xbox One is fully powered on and signed into a Xbox Live profile before connecting the Transmitter for the first time.

Note: Remove the clear plastic caps from the ends of the Digital Optical Cable before connecting.

Settings

1. Go to the Xbox One Home Screen and Press **X** on the Xbox One Controller.

2. Go to Settings > Display & Sound > Optical Audio. Select Bitstream Out.

3. Go to Settings > Display & Sound > Bitstream Format, Select Dolby Digital.

Required / Requisite

1. Start this process with the headset powered OFF. Press and hold the Pairing Button on the Transmitter until the Transmitter's Pairing LED flashes rapidly (5 seconds), then release.

2 Press and hold the Power Button on the Headset until the Headset's Power LED flashes rapidly (5 seconds), then release.

3 Within 30 seconds, the Transmitter and Headset's LEDs will remain on solid, indicating that pairing has been successful.
