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
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


# Panel Controls





- Power control sensor

- Power button




- Select when adjusting volume or select/adjust "MENU."

# Remote Control



## Note

- Use two "AAA" batteries.
- Be sure to use replacement batteries of the same type as the original ones.
- The life of a battery depends on how much it has been used.

\* The number in ( ) indicates the page in which the function of each button is explained in detail.

**TV/VIDEO(DVD)/SAT/CATV**  
Channel number (0~9)  
Use to select channel directly 0~9

**Display button**  
Indicates the current state and resolution.

**TV/VIDEO**  
Use this function to make video input selection. It changes in the following sequence TV -> Video1 -> Video2 -> TV

**ZOOM button**  
Used to zoom the screen. To enlarge, press the(+) button, and to return to the previous condition, press the(-) button.(Zoom Mode : Zoom 0~20)

**Menu button**  
Used to display a desired menu.

**Previous Channel button**  
It returns to previous channel.

**Mute button**  
Mute sound.

**Picture Mode button**  
Every press of the button cycles through the four different. Normal -> Movie -> Music -> News -> User.

**MTS button**  
This feature allows you to select the language and stereo sound while broadcasting

**CHANNEL ADD/ERASE**  
The feature either memorizes the current channel or erases a channel that has previously memorized

**Power button**  
Pressing the Power button of the Monitor allows the Display to be standby. (Red light is shown in the Remote Control Sensor.) At this time, if you press the Power button of the Remote Control, the Display is turned ON (Green light in the Sensor).

**100**  
Use it when selecting a channel number of over 100

**Multimedia**  
Use this function to make video input selection. It changes in the following sequence DVI -> PC -> Component 1-> Component 2 -> DVI

**CH button / Adjusts the channel.**

**Volume button / Adjusts the volume.**

**Screen Size button**  
Adjusts the size of the screen (Normal, 16:9, etc.)

**Caption button**  
This feature allows you to choose the caption.

**VIDEO/DVD Function**

**Still button**  
Used to view a still picture during watching moving images.(Sound can be heard.)

**Sound Mode button**  
Every press of the button cycles through the five different modes: Normal -> Movie -> Music -> News -> User.

**Sleep Timer button**  
Each time you press this button, a different input mode appears. The sequence is as follows: 15Min. -> 30Min. -> 60Min. -> 90Min. -> 120Min. -> OFF After the time is selected, it automatically becomes standby state.


### When Using Remote Control:


- Be sure not to allow the Remote Control to drop or to become wet.
- Keep it away from hot or moist locations.



### Installing the Batteries in your Remote Control:

- Push to open the cover of the remote controller
- Set the batteries in the battery cell after checking the electrode, and then shut the cover.





## To setup device change of remote control

### Method to setup device change of remote control

- The remote control is setup to be used for operating the HDTV provided together.  
You may also setup the remote control in order to operate cable TV receiver or video, etc with a remote control.

#### Notices:

##### ● Caution


- All the preset codes are erased when replacing the battery.  
In this case, you must reset the remote control again.

#### ● METHOD TO SETUP DEVICE CHANGE OF REMOTE CONTROL

- Ensure that power plugs of the outside device to be used are connected and that power turns off.
- Find the code number of the outside device to be used in the code list (See Setup Code of Remote Control).
- Continue to press the device change button related with the outside device to be used when the device change lamp (video / cable) flashes.
- With the remote control oriented downward, enter the remote control setup code number made of three numbers by using the number button of the remote control. If the code is correctly entered, power will turn on in the designated device (if no power turns on, repeat this process by using another code).
- Continue to press the device change button until the device change lamp flashes three times.


# Antenna Connection

## Indoor Antenna Connection

1. Connect the feeder cable of the antenna to the combining adapter.

### WHEN THE IMAGE IS NOT CLEAR


- Unclear screen image and bad reception may be a cause of wrong antenna connection. Be sure to check its direction and place when installing.




2. Connect the combining adapter to the antenna input at the back of the TV set.

- You may obtain the combining adapter at your closest Service Center.






## CTV Antenna Connection


- Such community TV Antenna installation may be found in most of co-op apartments.
- If you use the provided coaxial cable, only plug the cable.(recommendation)

Plug the coaxial cable to the antenna socket, and fix it firmly by turning it to the right.






## Outdoor Antenna Connection


Outdoor Antenna connection-such as VHF or/and UHF-may be necessary for installation at private houses

## To Watch TV

### To Watch TV

- Buttons with same name in the pdp set performs same function.

Press the "Main Power" button of the pdp set.

- The buttons of the remote control and the pdp set operate only when pressing the "Main Power" button of the pdp set. The remote control and the pdp set do not operate if turning the "Main Power" button of the pdp set off.

When pressing the Channel button

- Select two digits if using the number button for channel selection. For example, to watch the No.9 channel, Press the number button 0 and 9. If pressing only number 9, it takes long time for selecting channel.

To mute the sound

1. Press the "Mute" button.
2. No sound is heard if "Mute" is displayed on the screen.
3. Sound is heard again if pressing the "Mute" button once again. For example, please use this button when telephone rings or when guest comes while watching TV.

Check of TV operation status

- If pressing the "Display" button, status of channel or broadcasting being currently watched or entry status of video component is displayed on the screen.
