# Remote Control



## Note

- Use two "AAA" batteries.
- Be sure to use replacement batteries of the same type as the original ones.
- The life of a battery depends on how much it has been used.

\* The number in (  ) indicates the page in which the function of each button is explained in detail.

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**Input Select button** 44  
Used to select a desired input. Every press of the button cycles through the five different modes: Video 1 → Video 2 → Computer → Component 1 → Component 2

**Power button** 16  
Pressing the Power button of the Monitor allows the Display to be standby. (Red light is shown in the Remote Control Sensor.) At this time, if you press the Power button of the Remote Control, the Display is turned ON (Green light in the Sensor).

**ZOOM button** 38  
Used to zoom the screen. To enlarge, press (+) button, and to return to the previous condition, press (-) button. (ZOOM Mode: Zoom 0~10)

**Menu Select button** 32  
Select Menu by pressing ▲ (Up), ▼ (Down), ◀ (Left), ▶ (Right) buttons.

**Screen Select button** 31  
Every press of the button cycles through the four different modes: Normal → Cinema → Dynamic → User.

**Sound Mode button** 41  
Every press of the button cycles through the five different modes: Normal → Movie → Music → News → User.

**Mute button**  
Mutes sound.

**Check** 46  
Indicates the current state and resolution.

**Menu button** 42  
Use this button do display a desired menu.

**Volume button** 32  
Adjusts the volume.

**Aspect Ratio** 34  
Adjusts the size of the screen (normal, 16:8, etc.)

**Still** 40  
Used to view a still picture during watching moving images. (Sound can be heard.)

**Sleep Timer** 49  
Each time you press this button, a different input mode appears. The sequence is as follows: 15 Min. → 30 Min. → 60 Min. → 90 Min. → 120 Min. → OFF After the time is selected, it automatically becomes stand-by state.

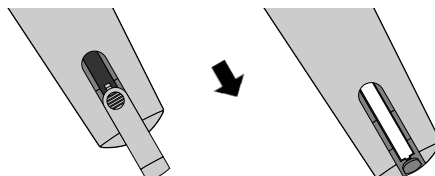

Separate the Cover Stand. (It is used when using for wall mounting, so store it.)

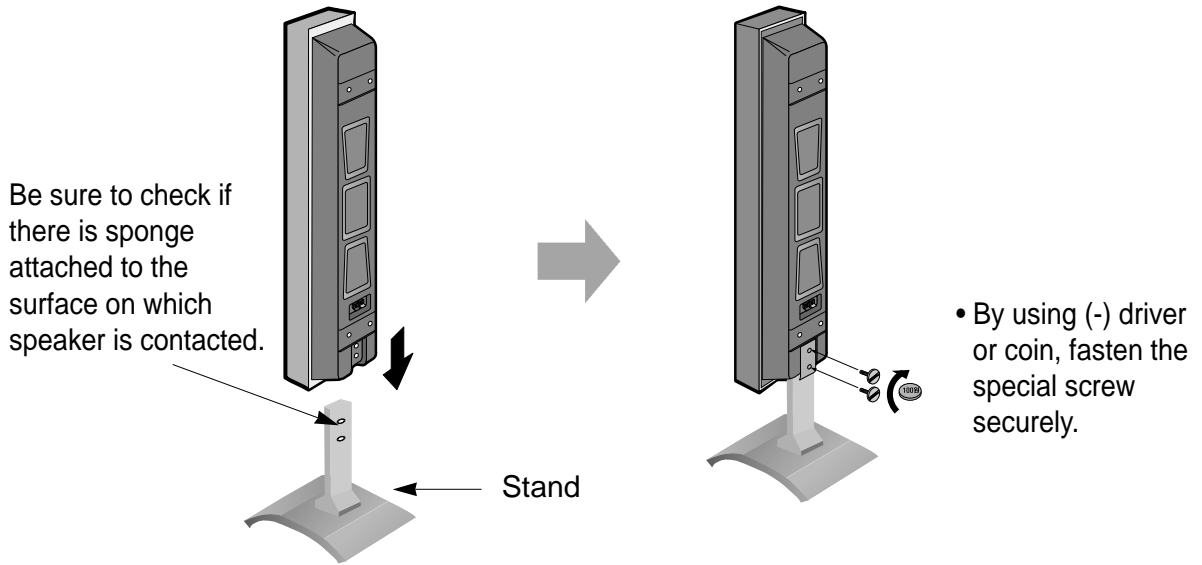

- 4) For detailed connection method is referred to the Owner's Manual of Digital πE° Receiver.
- 5) Component? : Signal with which brightness and color signals are separated, producing sharp screen.
- 6) If the Digital Broadcasting Receiver has PC Output terminal (D-sub15pin), connect to 'PC INPUT' in the back panel of PDP.  
When watching TV by PC Input, some signals may be seen at the top and bottom area of the screen. In this case, select [Menu] → [Screen] → [Vertical Size] to adjust.

- 2) The way of connecting DVD to PDP is as follows:  
Y ↔ Y   Cb ↔ Pb, B-Y,   Cr ↔ Pr, R-Y
- 3) DVD output can be made by Video, S-Video, Component Video, and depending on DVD devices, there are various output modes, so be sure to check when purchasing.
- 4) When connecting S-Video and normal Video simultaneously, S-Video will display on the screen.

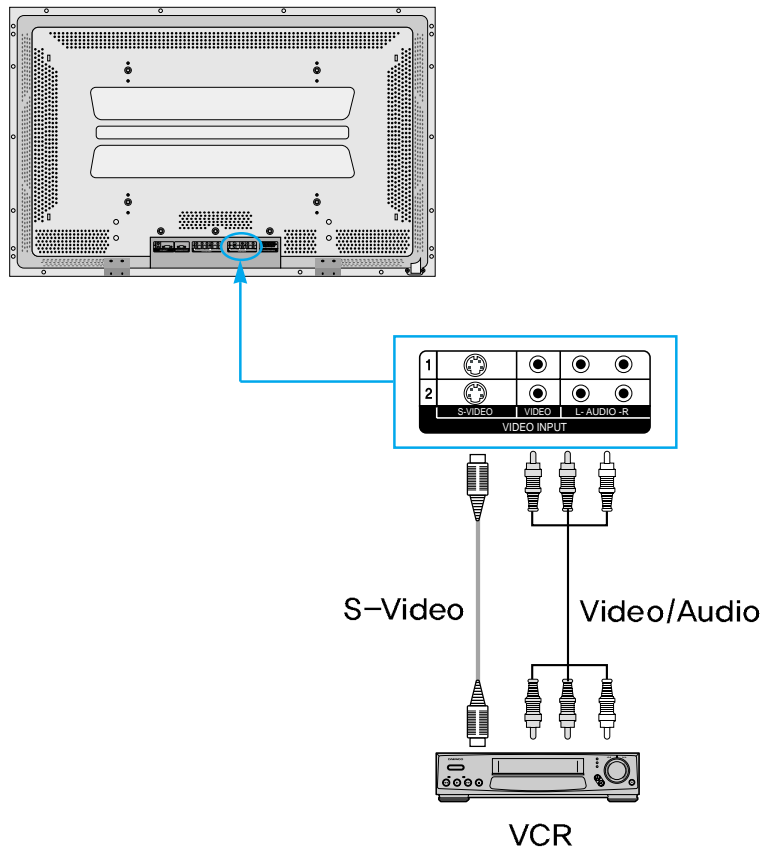

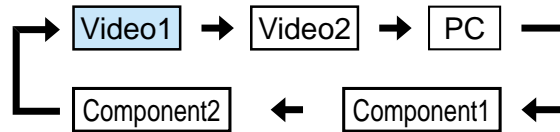

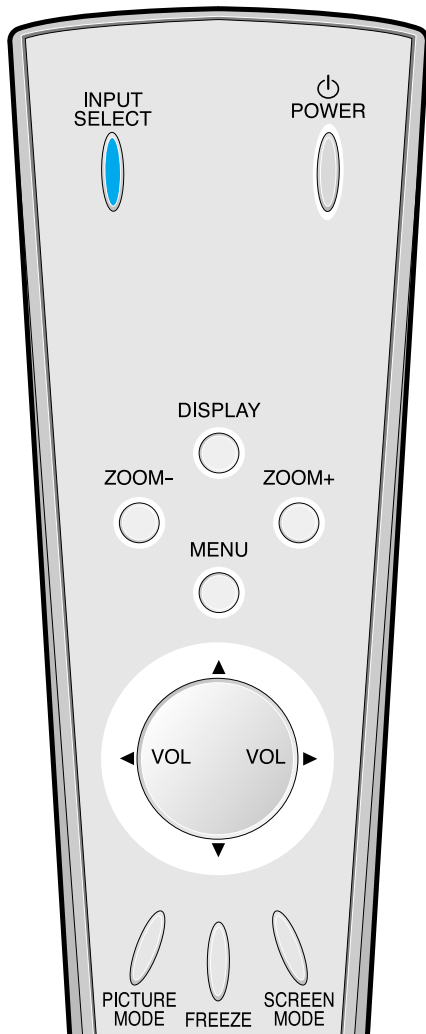

- 2) When connecting to normal video terminal, connect 3 color AV cable (video, left audio, right audio) to PDP; for S-Video terminal, connect Audio terminal (Left, Right) in the same way, and connect Video terminal by S-Video cable (sold separately).
- 3) When connecting normal Video terminal and S-Video simultaneously, S-Video terminal is selected, and this can be checked by [Check] button of the Remote Control.

- Before connecting a PC to PDP, be sure to adjust the resolution of PC.
- This product is not supported by Plug and Play, so select Standard Monitor when setting computer monitor.

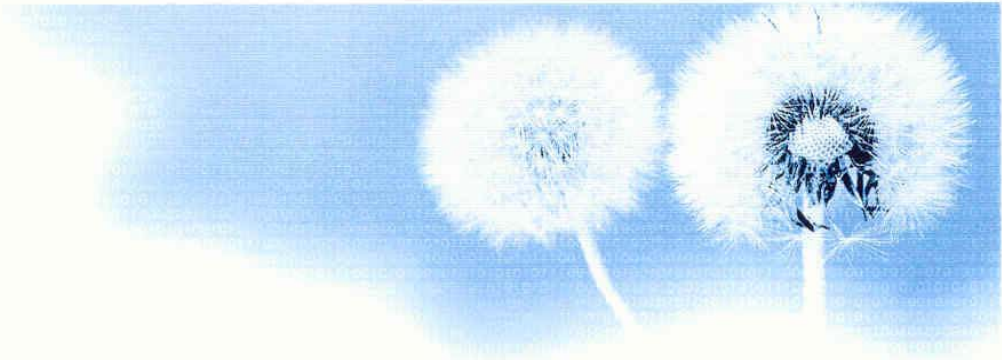
## 1 Before connecting to PDP, set the resolution of the computer.

- Go to SETUP-CONTROL PANEL-DISPLAY PROPERTIES in Window Screen.
- Choose the SETTINGS tab in the DISPLAY Menu.
- In the SETTINGS Menu, select 640x480 or 800x600.

## 2 Connect a Computer to PDP.

- Prepare the computer cable (D-sub 15pin) and PC audio cable.
- Connect the Computer(Output) to PDP(Input) as shown below  
Turn the PDP and Camcorder/Game Console ON.





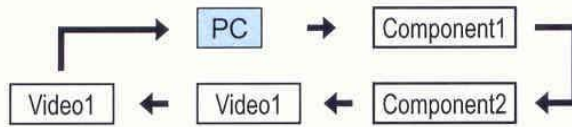

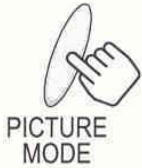

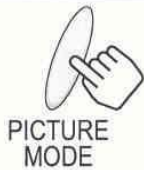

# Selecting Auto Screen Mode

## 1 Selecting Screen Mode



Each press of the button will select one of four screen modes.



Each time you press the button, a different screen mode appears. The sequences used are as follows:



- \* Normal : For a highly defined image in a normally bright room
- \* Dynamic: For a clear-cut image emphasizing high contrast for sports viewing
- \* Cinema: For a movie
- \* User: Allows the user to customize settings as desired.

## 3 Menu on the screen will disappear.

- After selecting a desired screen mode, the menu on the screen will disappear.
- Normal, Dynamic, and Cinema Modes are factory preset values. If you want to customize screen modes, refer to the following page.

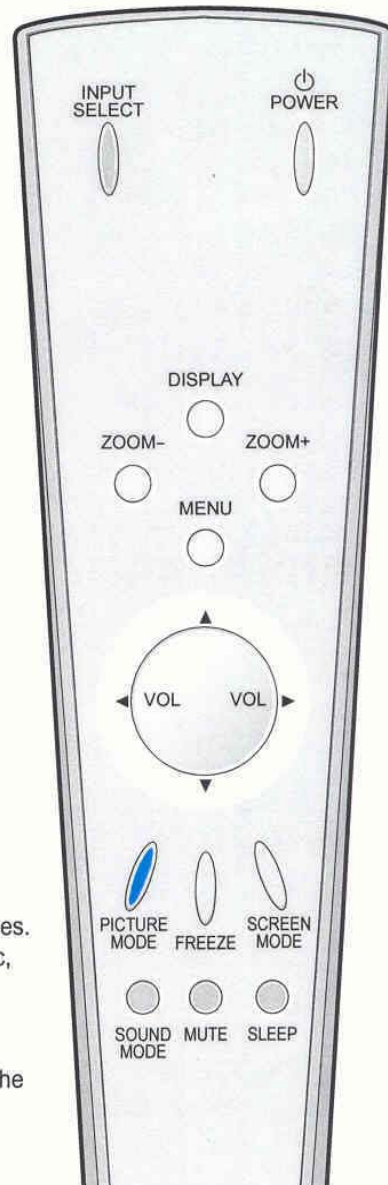


### NOTES:

- \* Normal, Dynamic, and Cinema Modes are factory preset values.
- \* When adjusting sub-menus while you are in Normal, Dynamic, and Cinema Modes, the Screen Mode will be automatically converted to User Mode, and the adjustments will be made.
- \* Pressing of the [INITIALIZATION] button in the [FUNCTION] Menu will allow for the Brightness, Contrast, etc. to return to the factory preset values.
- \* SHARP Menu adjusts picture sharpness.
- \* Adjusting Color Temperature makes the mood warm or cold.

- Select image modes that are automatically set depending on the kinds of pictures, and enjoy them.

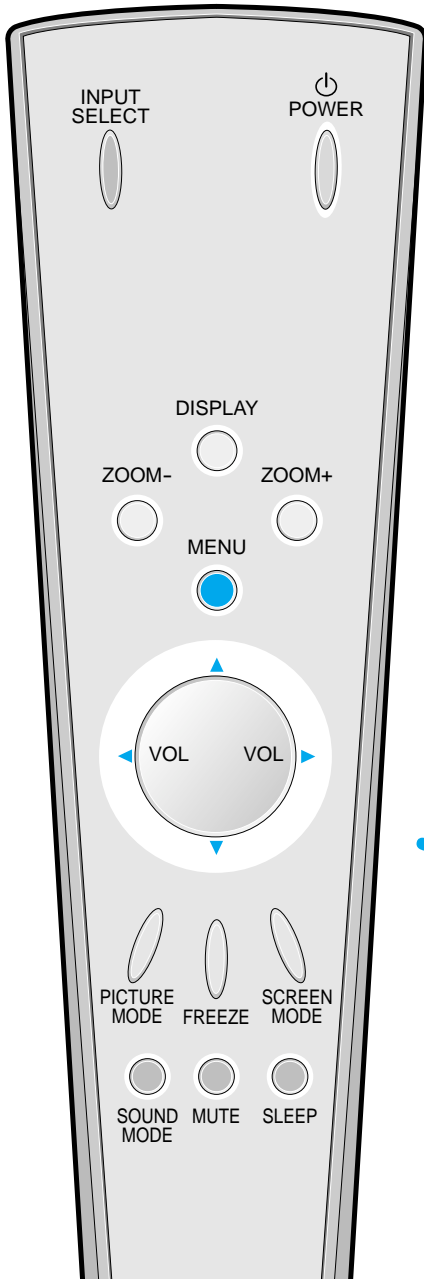

## Customizing Picture

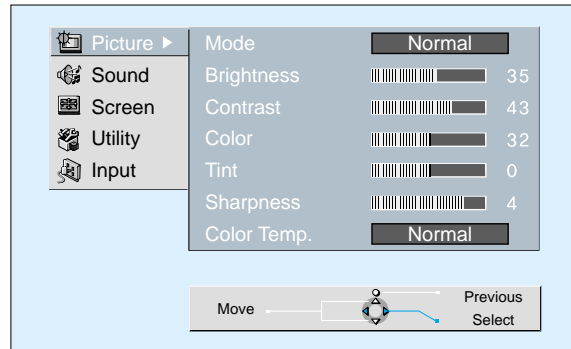
- You can adjust color tone and brightness to your preference as desired.

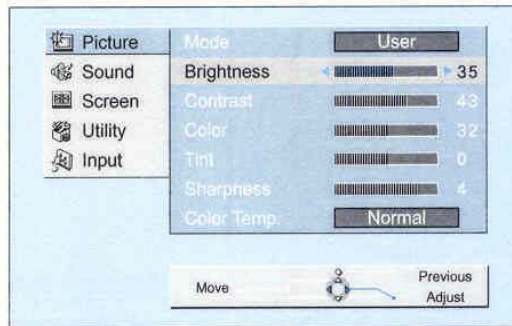
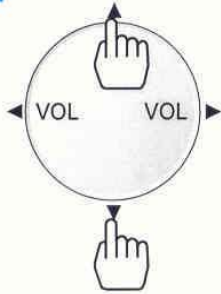






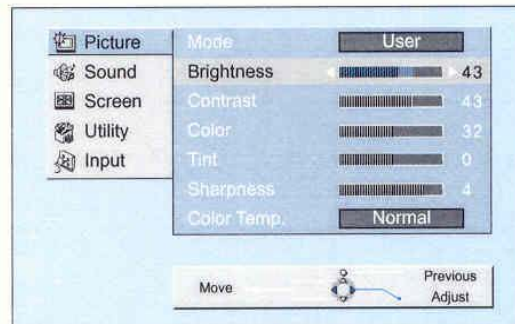
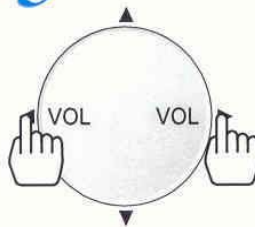
## 4 Select User Mode Adjustments

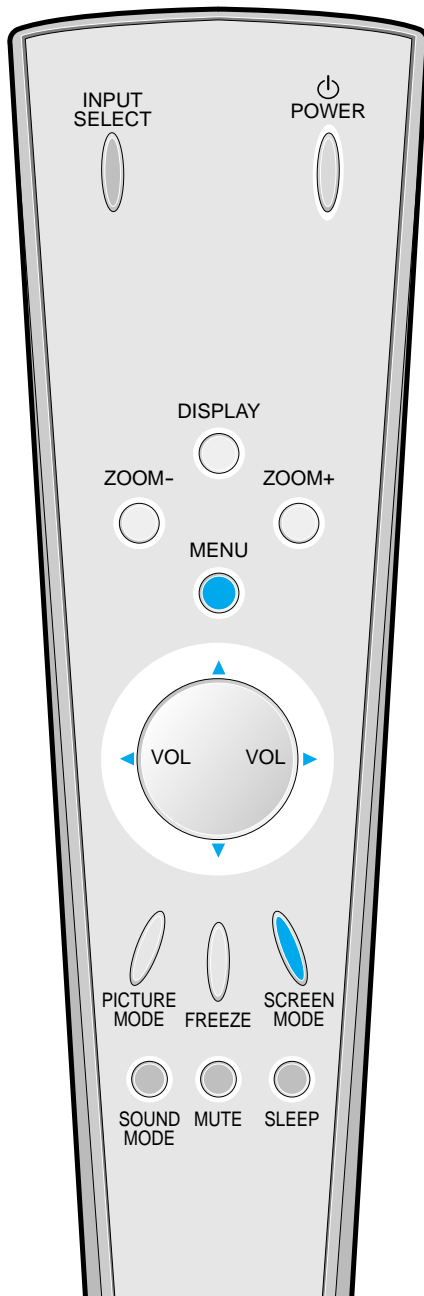

\* While you are in the Computer INPUT mode, you can only adjust brightness, contrast, and color temperature.

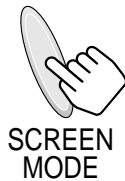
# Adjusting Screen Size

## Adjusting Screen Size

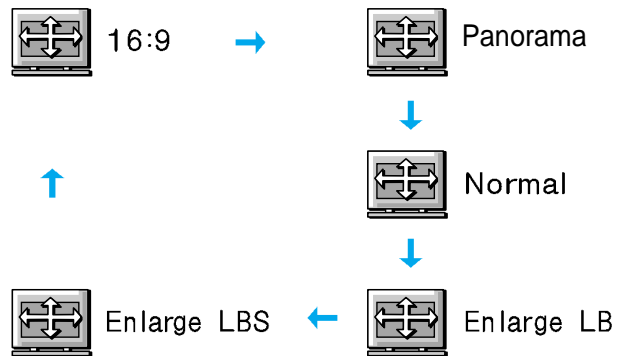
- You can adjust screen size or aspect ratio as desired.



## 1 Press the SCALING button.



- Each time you press the SCALING button on the Remote Control, a different picture mode appears. The sequences used are as follows:
- The MENU shown below will display on the screen.



## NOTES:

- When the INPUT SIGNAL is [DTV in COMPONENT 1 or COMPONENT 2], aspect ratios of 16:9 and 4:3(Normal) will only be applied.
- Digital broadcasting (720p, 1080i) is fixed at the aspect ratio of 16:9.
- Displaying a picture in a normal mode(4:3) for extended periods of time may cause phosphor burn-in.
- 16:9 : Theater-like 16:9 picture formats
  - Panorama : 16:9 picture formats giving panorama effect
  - Normal : Displays pictures of normal size (i.e., a 4:3 aspect ratio)
  - Zoom 2 : Reduces the height of horizontally extended pictures with caption.
  - Zoom 1 : Enlarges horizontally extended pictures equally in all directions to maintain the aspect ratio constant.

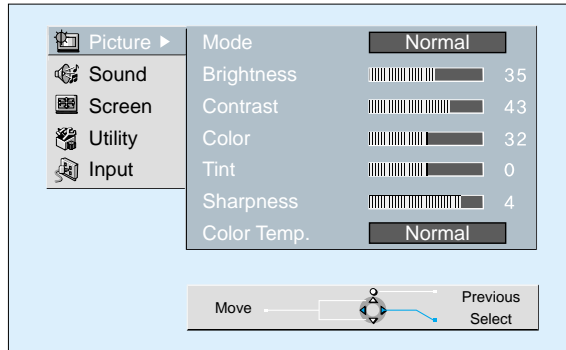

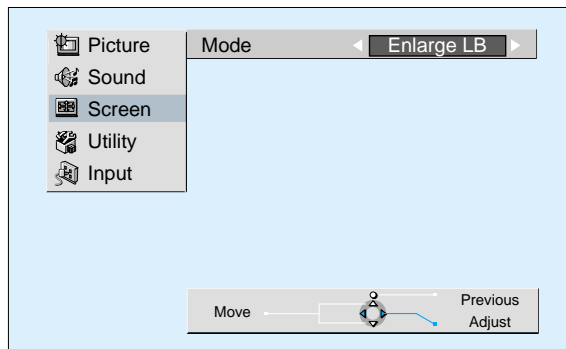
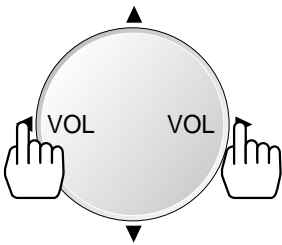
## 2 Select "Screen".

# Adjusting Screen Position and Size

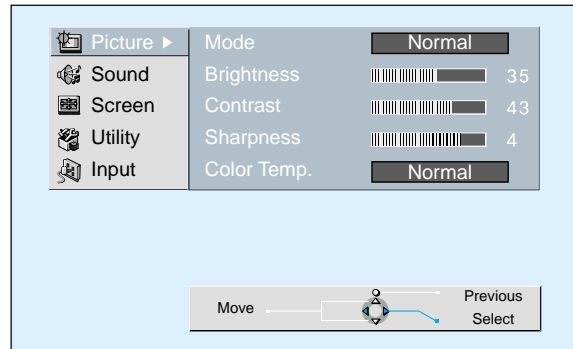
## Adjusting Screen Position and Size

- You can adjust the screen position and size as desired.
- This function is only used when adjusting the screen position on the PDP monitor by using computer input signal.

## 1 Press the MENU button.

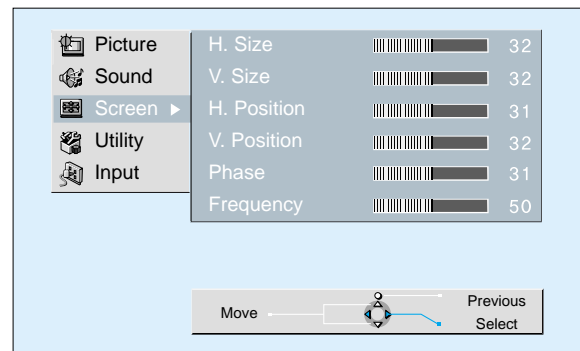
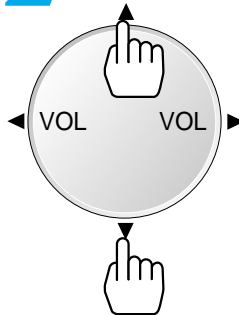

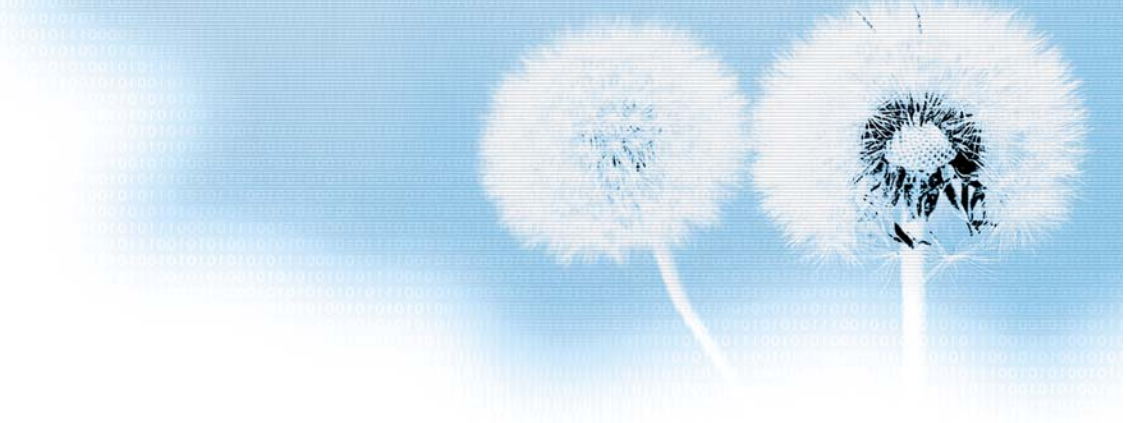

## 2 Press the ▲/▼ button.

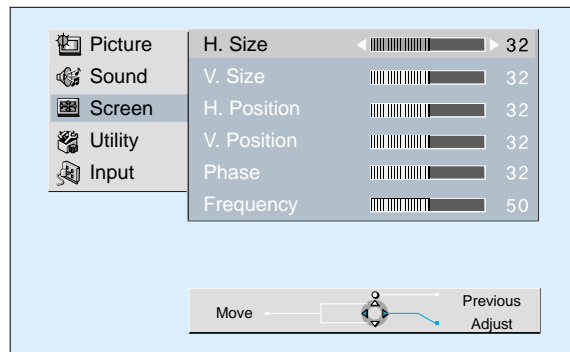
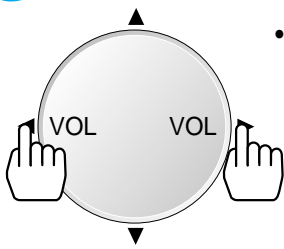
- Press ▲/▼ button to select 'Screen'.





### 3 Press the Volume ◀▶ button.

- Press the Volume ◀▶ button to select “Scaling”.
- While you are in ‘Screen’ mode, press ◀ or ▶ button to select a desired item, and then adjust.



#### NOTES:

- \* Horizontal/Vertical Values can be adjusted from [Computer Input]
- \* Horizontal Value: As the value increases, screen width increases
- \* Vertical Value: As the value increases, screen height increases.
- \* Horizontal Position: Increasing value moves screen to the right.
- \* Vertical Position: Increasing value moves screen up.
- \* Phase: Adjusts the position to obtain the screen.
- \* Frequency: Adjusts the base to obtain the screen.

# Enlarging Screen Size

## Enlarging Screen Size

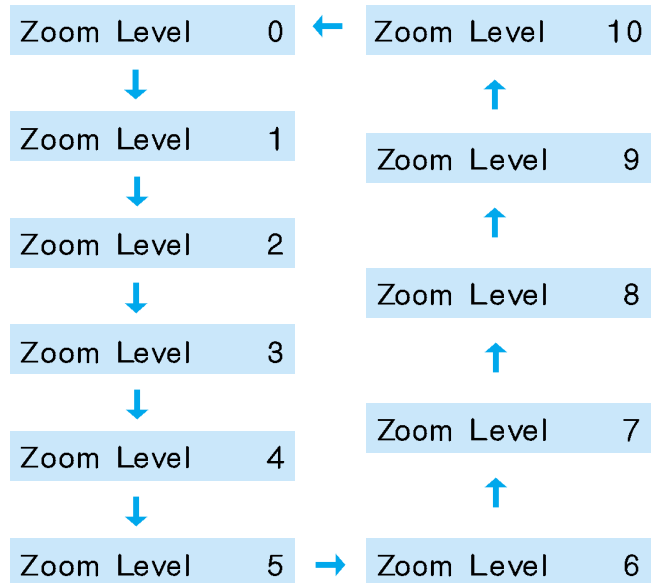
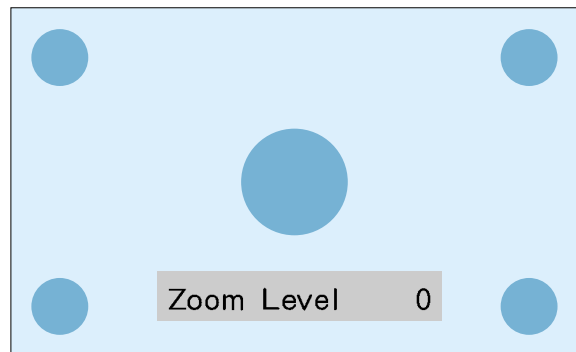
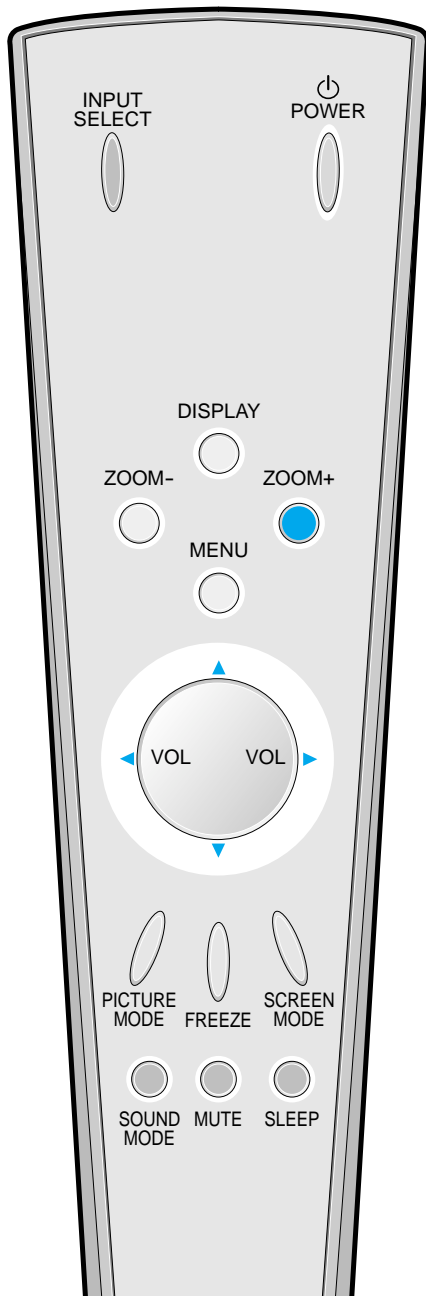
- With this function you can view enlarged size of the screen.

## 1 Press the 'ZOOM+' button.

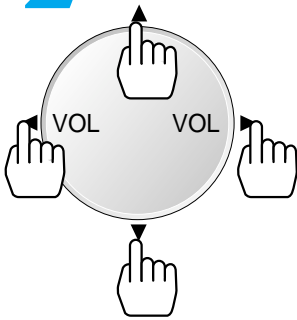

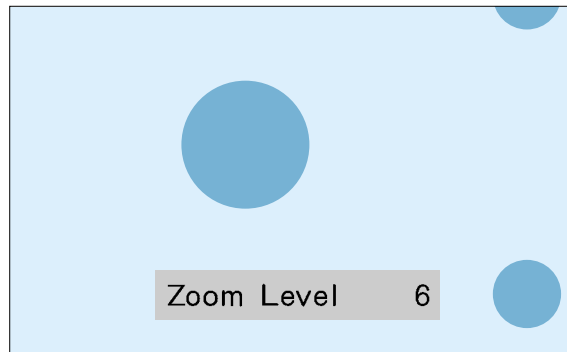
- Press the 'ZOOM+' button to show currently selected screen size.
- Each time you press 'ZOOM+' button, the screen size will increase stepwise in 0 ~ 10 scale.
- To reduce the screen size, press the [ZOOM-] button.



## 2 Move the Screen Position.



- While you are in 'Zoom' mode, press ▲/▼, ◀/▶ buttons to move screen stepwise up/down, left/right, respectively.



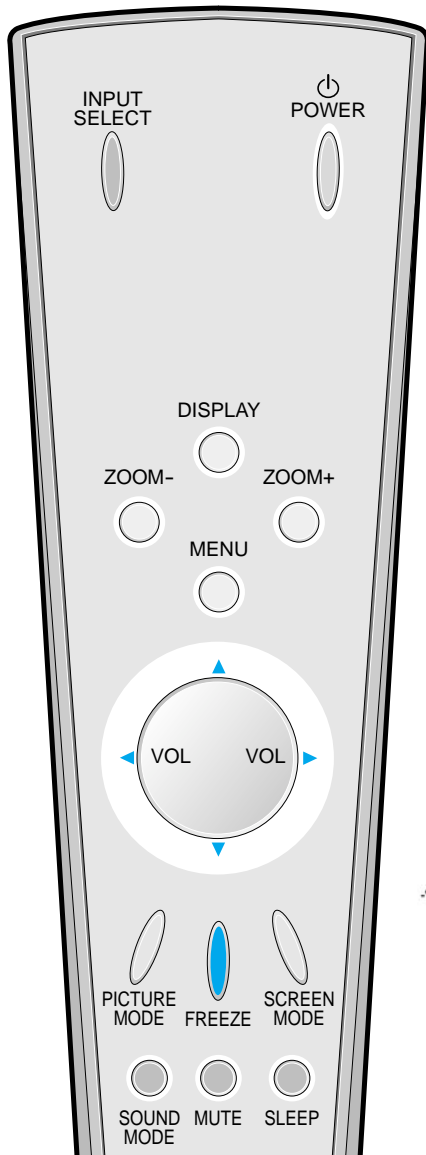
### NOTES:

When the screen is enlarged, the pixel of the screen can become thick and dim.

# Watching a Still Image

## Watching a Still Image

- With this function, you can view still images temporarily. However, displaying the same images such as still images for a long time may cause after-image lagging.



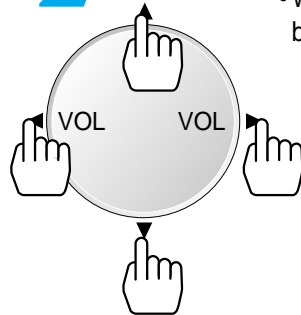
## 1 Press the 'STILL' button.



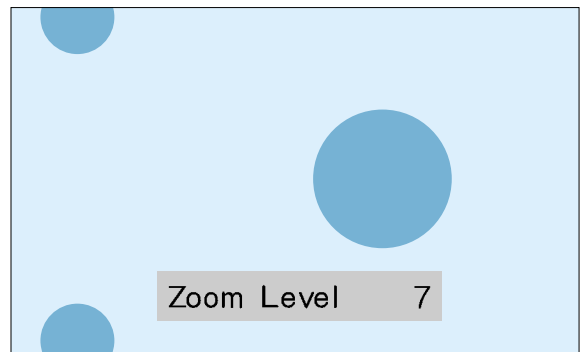
- If you wish to freeze a picture, press the 'STILL' button. You can still hear the sound.
- Press any button to cancel the 'STILL' function.
- To view the enlarged images, press the [ZOOM+] button.



## 2 Move the Screen Position.



- While you are in 'STILL' mode, press ▲/▼, ◀/▶ buttons to move screen stepwise up/down, left/right.



## NOTES:

- Displaying the same images such as still images for a long time may cause after-image lagging.
- In this case, such images may become less noticeable if moving images are later displayed.
- However, an after-image may become a permanent one, damaging the Plasma Display; therefore, avoid displaying the same images should be avoided.



# Adjusting Auto Sound Mode

## 1 Select SOUND Mode.



- Press the [SOUND MODE] on the Remote Control.
- Pressing the [SOUND MODE] first time will display the current SOUND MODE.

## Adjusting Auto Sound Mode

- Enjoy various sound modes by selecting your favorite Sound Mode depending on the kinds of moving pictures.

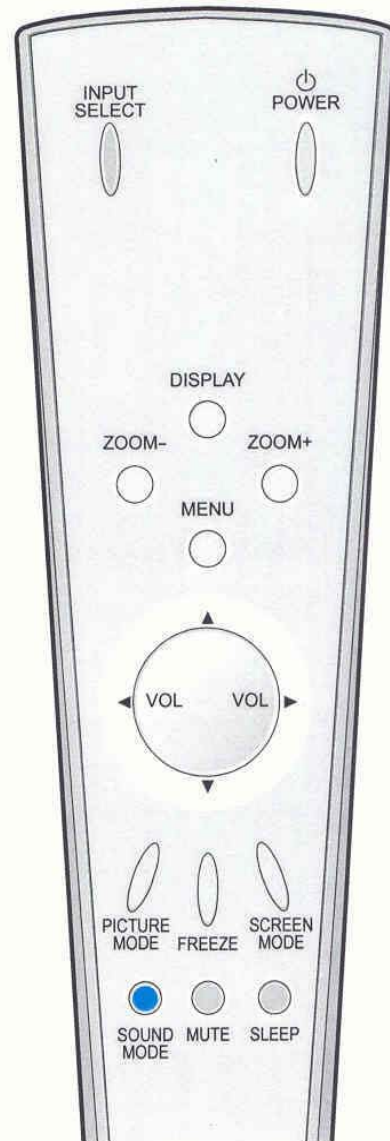
## 2 Every press of the button changes modes.



- \* Normal : Suitable for watching any motion picture
- \* Movie : Select this mode to simulate being at a movie theater
- \* Music : Ideal for listening to music
- \* News : Allows for human voice to be heard more clearly
- \* User : Allows the user to adjust as desired.

## 3 MENU will disappear.

- After selecting a desired SOUND Mode, on-screen menu will disappear in about 2~3 seconds.
- Normal, Movie, Music, News Modes are factory preset values.

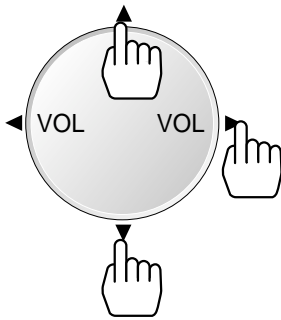


## 3 Select SOUND BALANCE.

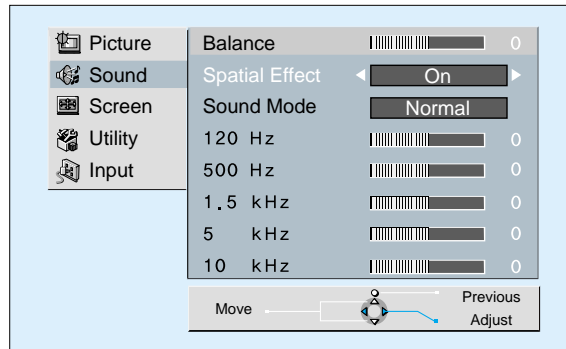

- Sound Balance: Adjusts sound balance of left and right speaker.



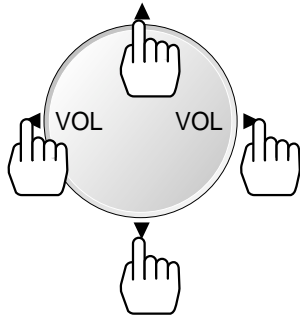
## 4 Select DOLBY SOUND Mode.



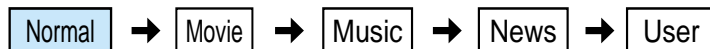
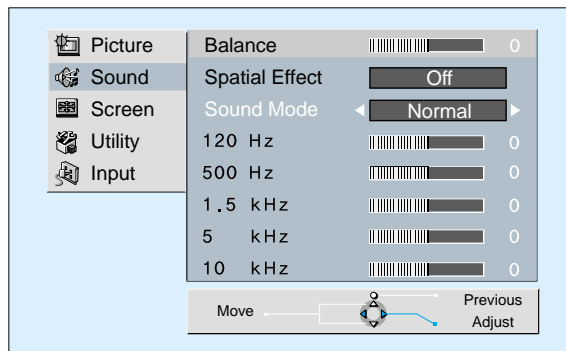
- Select the Dolby Sound by pressing ▲ / ▼ button, then select ON/OFF by pressing ► button.
- DOLBY SOUND: Used to feel grotesque by emphasizing middle and low sound.



## 5 Select SOUND Mode.



- Select the Sound Mode by pressing ▲ / ▼ button, then select by pressing ◀ / ▶ button.



- \* Normal : Suitable for watching any motion picture
- \* Movie : Select this mode to simulate being at a movie theater
- \* Music : Suitable for listening to music
- \* News : Allows for human voice to be heard more clearly
- \* User : Allows the user to adjust as desired.



### NOTES:

- 1) Custom Mode : Used as an Equalizer with which the user can adjust sound frequency as desired.
- 2) If you modify sound frequency in auto Sound Mode (News, Movie, Music, etc.), it is automatically switched to Custom Mode.
- 3) Low sound is emphasized as the frequency is lowered to 120 Hz, and high sound as raised to 10 KHz.
- 4) When the INPUT is MONO, if you connect to Left Audio Input, you can hear from both speakers.

# Selecting INPUT SIGNAL

## INPUT SIGNAL

- Used to select INPUT signal of external device connected to the PDP.

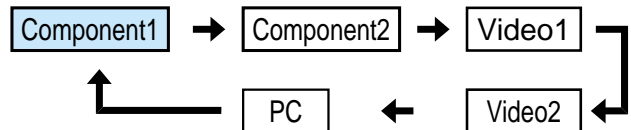
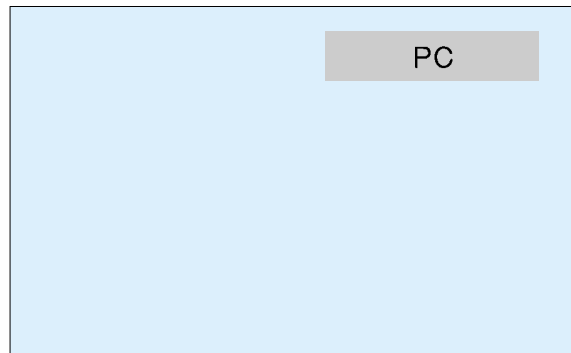


## 1 Press the INPUT SELECT button.

INPUT SELECT



- Press the [INPUT SELECT] button on the Remote Control or PDP Display to select [COMPONENT 1] or [COMPONENT 2].
- Each time you press the [input select] button, a different screen mode appears. The sequences used are as follows: COMPONENT 1 → COMPONENT 2 → VIDEO 1 → VIDEO 2 → COMPUTER



## NOTES:

- \* If external device is not connected or INPUT signal is not applied, Warning Message ("No Signal") would be displayed.
- \* If this is the case, check if external device is connected or terminal connection is properly done.

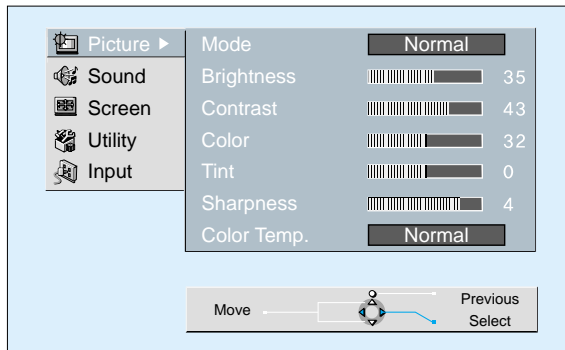

## Checking the Current Input Signal

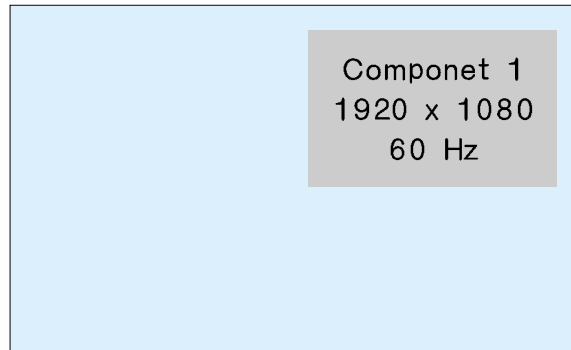
- Used to check INPUT signal mode, resolution, frequency, etc. of the current screen.

### 1. If you watch Digital Broadcasts:

Componet 1 → Displays which input terminal is used, and indicates signal mode.  
 1920 x 1080 → Indicates the horizontal and vertical resolution of current INPUT signal.  
 60 Hz → Indicates the mode and frequency of current INPUT signal.

### 2. If you watch DVD image:

Componet 2 → Displays which input terminal is used, and indicates signal mode.  
 YUV 60 Hz → Indicates the mode and frequency of current INPUT signal.

### 3. If you watch VCR image:

Video 1 → Displays which input terminal is used, and indicates signal mode.  
 NTSC 60 Hz → Indicates the mode and frequency of current INPUT signal.



### NOTES:

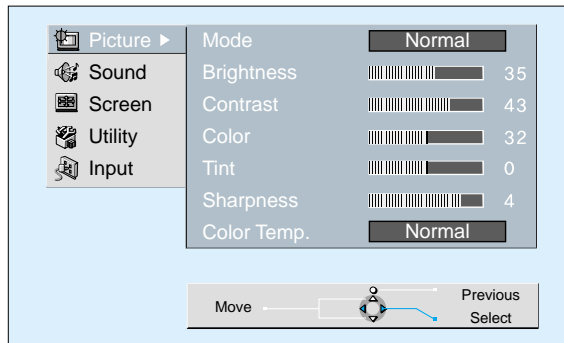
- \* SUMMUS PLASMA can receive NTSC, PAL, SECAM, etc.
- \* "1920 x 1080" displayed in the INPUT signal does not indicate the resolution of the monitor, but the signal that is sent by Digital Broadcasting Receiver.

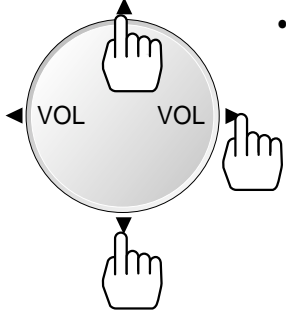
- Select [MENU BACKGROUND SCREEN] by pressing ▶ button.

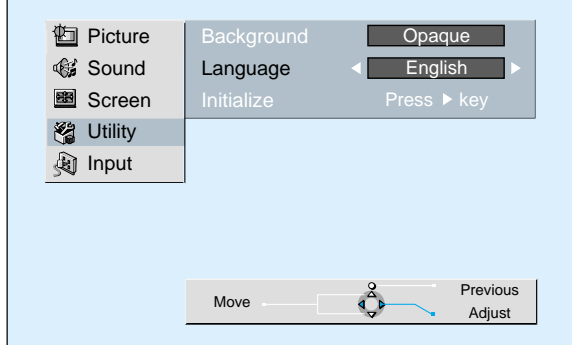

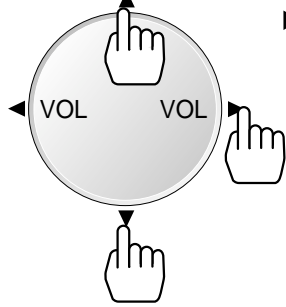

\* When Power is turn ON first time, 'SELECT LANGAUGE' Mode will be displayed, then select a desired language. (Displayed only once)

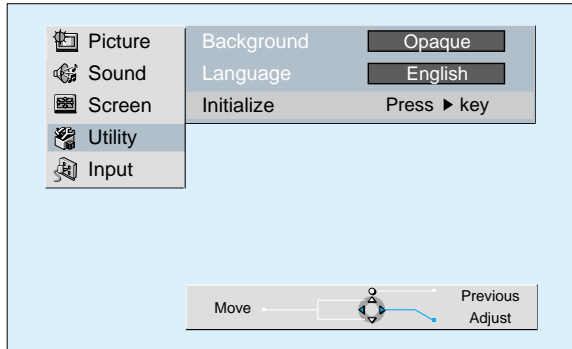
## Back to Initialization

- You can restore the values of the adjustment/setting made in the MENU to factory settings.

## 5 INITIALIZATION will start.

### When [INITIALIZATION] is completed:

- \* When [INITIALIZATION] is completed, those values that have been set in the CUSTOM Mode of [SCREEN MODE] and [SOUND MODE] will be returned to the factory preset values.
- \* When you try to initialize, be advised that you should think it over.
- \* The items in the [SCREEN] Menu in PC INPUT are also initialized (i.e., Horizontal Value, Vertical Value, Horizontal Position, Vertical Position, Phase, Frequency, etc.)

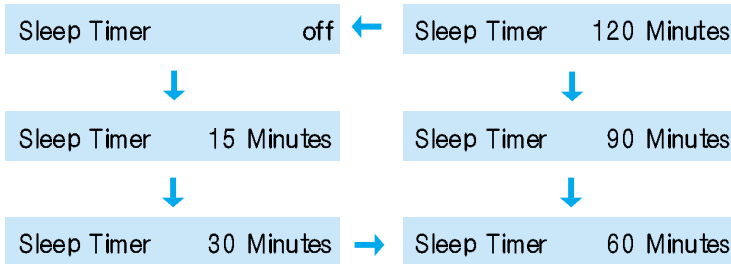
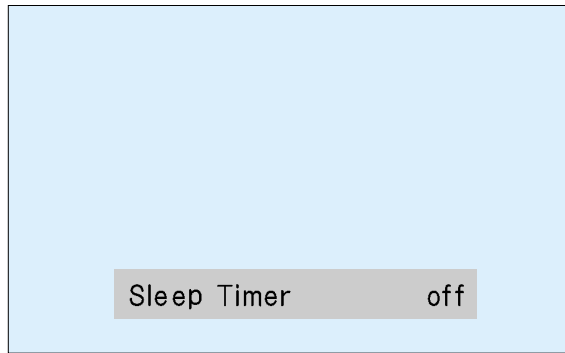
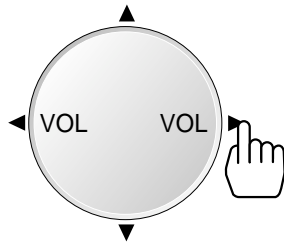


# Setting Sleep Timer

## 1 Press the SLEEP TIMER button.



- Press the [SLEEP TIMER] button on the Remote Control.
- Pressing the [SLEEP TIMER] button first time will display the current setting for SLEEP TIMER.
- To cancel the SLEEP TIMER, press ► button to select 'OFF'.

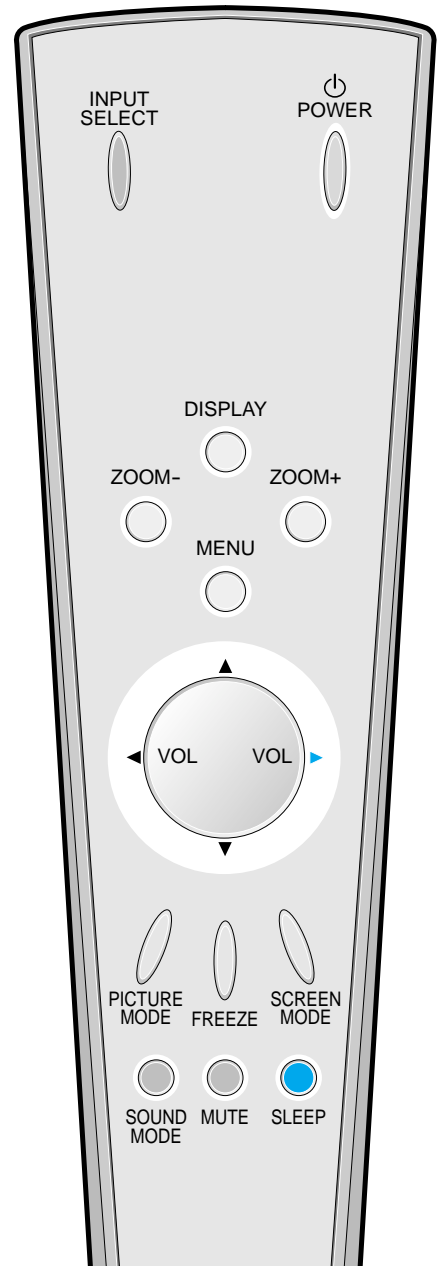


### NOTES:

- 1) On-screen information disappears if you do not take any action for about two seconds after pressing the SLEEP TIMER button.
- 2) If you turn the Monitor off after setting the SLEEP TIMER, the setting is erased.

## Setting Sleep Timer

- SLEEP TIMER turns the Monitor off after a preset time.



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# Before Requesting Service

Before requesting service from the nearest Daewoo Electronics Service Center, check the following points once again.

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## • Remote control does not function properly.

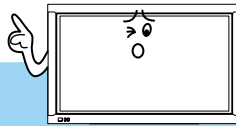
- Check for any obstacle between the Remote Control and the Display.
- Check for dead batteries and incorrect battery orientation.
- Check if the Remote Control is right one.
- Remove any obstacle between the Remote Control and the Display.
- Replace batteries and use the correct polarity (+) or (-) of the batteries.
- Use the Remote Control proper to the model.

## • The Display makes a snapping sound.

- Check if pictures and sound are normal.
- This sound is produced due to variations in room temperature.
- This sound does not indicate that the Display has a problem, if picture and sound function properly.

## • There are empty spots in the top and bottom area of the screen.

- Check if the screen size of an image is wider than 16:9 aspect ratio (theater screen size).
- When video screen is wider than 16:9 aspect ratio, you may find dark areas at top and at the bottom of the screen.



# Before Requesting Service



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## • There are spots on the screen or screen rolls.

- Check if your product is affected by interference from automobiles, high-voltage transmission lines, neon signs or other potential sources of interference.

## • Screen size is suddenly changed.

- The screen size of a video image may not be matched to the size of the dark initial screen.
- Check by using other video tape.

## SPECIFICATIONS

### In the event that the product has been submerged in the water in rainy season:

Immediately wash it with clean water, and dry in shadow place, then call for service from the nearest DaeWoo Service Center.  
Never plug the Power Cord since there is risk of electric shock and of damaging the product.
