The charging LED is lit red during charging. The LED turns off when fully charged. It is recommended to charge 10 minutes before power on if you 7 days unused, then you can continue to use while charging.</p> <p><b>POWER ON/OFF</b>        Power on: Long press power on the speaker, then the Bluetooth indicator light is on and you can connect Bluetooth devices.        Power off: Long press power on the speaker, and then Bluetooth indicator will turn off.</p> <p><b>CONNECT THE SPEAKER</b>        On your device search for Bluetooth devices. Select the speaker from the list. The speaker will give an indication sound when the connection is successful. Only one Bluetooth device can be connected at the same time. If you want to connect another device to the speaker, then first disconnect the current one.</p> <p><b>DISCONNECT THE SPEAKER</b>        On your device, disconnect the Bluetooth connection with the speaker.</p> <p><b>RECONNECT THE SPEAKER</b>        Some Bluetooth devices support automatic reconnection, with those devices the speaker will automatically reconnect. It can take a few more seconds before speakers connect to each other.</li> <li>4: Go into the Bluetooth menu on your smartphone and pair the speakers with your phone by selecting the speaker model number . (it will only display 1 number which is both combined in to one)</li> </ol> <p><b>TWS DISCONNECTION</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Press and hold the Play/Pause-button on one of the speakers for about 2 seconds until you hear a "beep" sound</li> </ol> <p><b>NOTE</b>        When speakers are previously paired with each other: If they do not automatically pair with each other when you turn them on, press and hold the Play/Pause button on one of the speakers for about 2 seconds. It can take a few more seconds before the speakers connect to each other.        If you are connected to both speakers without the TWS connection between them, then you have to disconnect from one of the speakers.</p> <p><b>EXPLANATION</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Please power on your speakers if the light isn't on. Please charge the speaker if the light is still not on.        (2) Please turn off the other Bluetooth devices, if there are many Bluetooth devices surrounding. This may result in search difficulties.
