INTRODUCTION

Wicos201 & Wicos202 is a Bluetooth Headset based on Bluetooth wireless technology.

Please carefully read this Manual before using your Headset.

When can I use my Headset?

You can connect your Headset, WICOS201 & WICOS202 to your mobile phone when you are at the office or in the car. This Manual focuses on how to use the Headset with your mobile phone. The phone can be tucked away in your pocket or in a bag. You can handle incoming and outgoing calls, and adjust the volume, using the volume key on the Headset.

Preparing the Headset.

To be able to use the Headset (WICOS201 & WICOS202) together with a mobile phone, you need to have a Bluetooth mobile phone (WICOS202), or a Non-Bluetooth mobile phone connected to a Phone Adapter (WICOS201)

HOW TO USE

Getting Started

Before you start using the Headset with a mobile phone for the first time, you should:

- Charge the Headset in the Cradle and the Phone Adapter in the Charging Holder
- Decide on which ear you want to wear the Headset (It? delivered for left-ear use)
- Please refer More Convenience (P.16)

Charging

The Headset (& Phone Adapter) comes with a built-in rechargeable Li-Polymer battery.

The battery is not fully charged when you buy the Headset

We recommend that you charge the Headset until the indicator light turns green before using it for the first time. Put the Headset into the Cradle to charge it and also need to charge the Phone Adapter Battery in the Charging Holder

- It takes 1.5 hours to fully recharge the battery
- When the battery is fully charged, the indicator light on the Cradle (or, on the Charging Holder) turns green

How to charge the battery

Connect the Charging Connecting Cable to both the connecting holes on the Cradle and

the Charging Holder

Insert the Headset into the charging cradle as shown in the picture.

Please make sure the connector pins are aligned with the connector holes in the Headset

To remove the Headset from the cradle, slide the release catch backwards and lift the Headset up.

Connect the plug in Cigar-code into the Cigarette lighter in the car

Press the Power button on the charging holder

Insert the Phone Adapter into the charging holder as shown in the picture

- At the Office

Connect the A/C power adapter to the charging cradle and to the charging holder

Pairing

Headset & Phone Adapter are paired when you buy it, and don't need to be paired again.

However in case you lost headset & phone Adapter link, you must pair the Headset with the Phone Adapter

Initiate Bluetooth Pairing in the Phone Adapter to pair it with the Headset

- Press and hold call button on the Headset & Phone Adapter button for up to 6 seconds

until the Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash red and green

- While the Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash red and green, press the Phone Adapter button once again

- When pairing has been completed, both Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash red

To use the Headset with Phone Adapter

- Press Call button on the Headset up to 1.5 seconds again. After this, both Headset & Phone Adapter indicator light flashes green and red
- When connection has been completed, both Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash green

Turning the Headset & Phone Adapter On and Off

- In use WICOS201

To turn the Headset & Phone Adapter on

- Press and hold Call button on the Headset & Phone Adapter button
- The Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash red
- Press Call button on the Headset up to 1.5 seconds once again. After this, both Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash green and red
- When pairing has been completed, both Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash green

To turn the Headset & Phone Adapter off

- Press and hold Call button on the Headset & Phone Adapter button
- The Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights are switched off
- After you finished the calls, simply press the Call button up to 1.5 seconds in order to be stand-by mode.

Note: At the stand-by mode, the Headset & Phone Adapter indicator lights flash red

Making and Receiving Calls

In connection with making and receiving calls you press the Call button on the Headset to;

Making Calls

1. Make sure the phone and the Headset are on and within range of each other.
Press the Call button on the Headset once.
Both Headset & Phone Adapter (WICOS201) indicator light flashes green.
2. After the beep, press dial as you would.
3. End the call by simply pressing Call button on the Headset

Answering Calls

1. When the phone rings, press the Call button on the Headset once.
- Indicator light flashes green when they connect
2. End the call by simply pressing Call button on the Headset

A. Using an Ericsson Phone with Built-in Bluetooth Capability

You pair the Headset with your phone by adding it to a list of paired devices in the phone.

They then recognize each other when they connect.

I. To pair the Headset with the phone

1. With the Headset turned off, press and hold the Headset button for up to 7 seconds
until the indicator light on the Headset flashes Green and Red
2. In the phone, scroll to Connect, YES -> Bluetooth, YES -> Paired devices, YES -
> Add devices, YES -> Phone initiates, YES -> Headset, YES
3. Enter the Headset Passkey, press ?000? YES, The phone starts searching for the Headset.
4. When pairing has been completed, the Headset indicator light flashes Red

In case you lost the headset link by accident

1. In the phone, scroll to Connect, YES -> Bluetooth, YES -> Paired devices, YES -

> Add devices, YES -> Delete, Yes

2. Go back to the step I. and follow the instructions

B. Using a Nokia Phone with Built-in Bluetooth Capability

You pair the Headset with your phone by adding it to a list of paired devices in the phone.

They then recognize each other when they connect.

I. To pair the Headset with the phone.

1. With the Headset turned off, press and hold the Headset button for up to 7 seconds

until the indicator light on the Headset flashes Green and Red.

2. In the phone, scroll to Bluetooth, Select -> Search for audio accessories, Select

3. Enter the Headset Passkey, press 0000? OK

4. When pairing has been completed, the Headset indicator light flashes green?

In case you lost the headset link by accident

1. In the phone, scroll to Bluetooth, Select -> View paired devices -> WICOS HS,

Option -> Delete pairing, Select -> Delete pairing? WICOS HS, OK

2. Go back to the step I. and follow the instructions

For More Convenience

Putting On the Headset

- Put on the Headset with the ear hook behind your ear
- Make sure the microphone is pointing towards your mouth

Adhere to Mobile phone On Phone Adapter

-In use Wicos 201

- When you use the Phone Adapter with a mobile phone, please adhere Phone Adapter to the backside of mobile phone using steel plate

Right- Ear use

If you want to wear the Headset on your right ear, you have to change the orientation of the ear hook.

1. Gently pull the ear hook from the Headset as shown above.
2. Turn the hook 180°
3. Gently press the ear hook into place.

Adjusting the Volume

Adjusting the Listening Volume

You can adjust the Headset listening volume during a call.

To adjust the listening volume

- To increase the volume, slide the Volume key up.
- To decrease the volume, slide the Volume key down

Guidelines for safe and efficient use

Product care

Please note only Wicos Co.,Ltd. Partners should remove or replace the battery.

- Do not expose your Headset to liquid or moisture or to humidity
- Do not expose your Headset to extreme high or low temperature
- Do not expose your Headset to lit candles, cigarettes, or cigars, or to open flames etc.
- Do not drop, throw or try to bend the product as rough treatment could damage it
- Do not attempt to disassemble your Headset. The Headset does not contain consumer

serviceable or replacement components. Only Wicos Co.,Ltd. Service Partners should

perform service.

Do not keep the Headset in an area prone to dust and dirt. Only use a soft damp cloth

to clean your Headset

If you will not be using the Headset for a while, store it in a place that is dry, free from

damp, dust and extreme temperatures

Radio frequency exposure

Your Bluetooth Headset is a radio transmitter and receiver. When in operation, it communicates with a Bluetooth mobile device by receiving and transmitting radio frequency (RF) electromagnetic fields (microwaves) in the frequency range 2400 to 2500MHz. The output power of the radio transmitter is low, 0.001 watt.

Driving

Check the laws and regulations on the use of mobile phones and Headset in the areas where you drive.

Electronic equipment

Most modern electronic equipment is shielded from RF energy. However, certain electronic equipment is not, therefore:

Do not use your Headset near medical equipment without requesting permission. If you are using any personal medical devices, e.g. a pacemaker or a hearing aid, please read in your mobile phone? User? Guide for further information.

Aircraft

Turn your Headset OFF before boarding any aircraft. To prevent interference with communication systems, you must not use your Headset while the plane is in the air.

Battery information

Please note that only Wicos Co.,Ltd. Service Partners are able to remove or replace the battery in a proper way.

A rechargeable battery has a long service life if treated properly.

A new battery or one that has not been used for a long period of time could have reduced capacity the first few times it is used.

Do not expose the battery to extreme temperatures, never above +50 degree. For maximum battery capacity, use the battery in room temperature. If the battery is used in low temperatures, the battery capacity will be reduced.

Warranty

If, during the warranty period, this Headset fails to operate under normal use and service, due to improper material or workmanship, Wicos Co.,Ltd. Service Partners will, at their option, either repair or replace the Headset in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated here in.

Our Warranty

Wicos Co., Ltd. Warrants this Headset to be free from defects in material and workmanship at the time of its original purchase by a consumer, and for a subsequent period of one (1) year.

- This warranty does not cover any failure of the Headset due to normal wear and tear, or

Headset. Nor does this warranty cover any failure of the Headset due to accident, modification or adjustment, acts of God, improper ventilation or damages resulting from

liquid.

- This warranty does not cover Headset failures due to improper repair installations, modifications or service performed by a non Wicos Co., Ltd. Service Partners.
- Tempering with any of the seals on the Headset will void the warranty.

Supported Bluetooth functions

This Headset supports the Headset profile.

In France Bluetooth is authorized in the whole band 2.4GHz (2400-2483.5MHz) with 10mW for indoor use and 2.5mW for outdoor use, but for more power you have the upper band 2446.5-2483.5 MHz which is opened until 100mW but only for indoor use.
