Battery Safety Information:

- · Only adults should install and replace batteries.

Attention Adults —To Install Batteries

Requires two (2 X 1.5V) "AAA" (LR3) batteries for each sensor and two (2 X 1.5V)

"AAA" (LR3) batteries for the base station; total eight (8) batteries (batteries not included).

To Install Batteries In The Base Station

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the base station. Use a small Phillips head screwdriver to loosen the screw, and unclip the battery cover.
- 2. Place batteries in compartment
- 3. Replace battery cover and tighten screw.

To Install Batteries In Each Sensor

- I. Remove the sensors from the base station
- 2. Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the sensor. Use a small

Phillips head screwdriver to loosen the screw, then remove battery cover.

- 3. Place batteries in compartment as shown
- 4. Replace battery cover and tighten screw.
- 5. Repeat for each sensor.

To Set Sensors

- 1. Push back the red latch on the base station and open the lid
- 2. Pop out each sensor by pushing down from above
- 3. Unwind the antenna from around each sensor and straighten.
- 4. Remove a **tube** from inside the base station cover and slide it over the antenna until it snaps onto the sensor
- 5. Slide each sensor's switch to the "ON" position
- 6. Place each of the sensors in a hiding place anywhere up to 75 feet from the main unit.

NOTE: Be sure to set the sensor lens facing away from any obstructions (walls, books etc).

Surveillance

- I. Open the base station.
- 2. Slide the on/off switch to mute or audio position. The map grid will illuminate
- 3. Use the dry-erase marker to draw a plan on the map grid showing where the sensors are set

Surveillance Tip: Draw a line from each sensor's LED to its position on the plan.

- 4. Wait for someone to trip a sensor!
- 5. With the on/off switch in audio position, when someone moves in front of a sensor the base station will announce which sensor has been tripped and the sensor's LED will flash.
- 6. With the on/off switch in mute position, when someone moves in front of a sensor there will be no audio warning but the sensor's LED will flash.
- 7. To stop the LEDs flashing, press the reset button

Spy Tip: Use the Spy Tracker to protect your gear, or play hide & seek and never get caught.

Leave No Trace

- I. Collect each sensor and wrap its antenna around the sensor body. Snap the antenna tip onto the clip.
- 2. Press each sensor back into place on the base station cover.
- 3. Wipe off the map grid with a clean dry paper towel.
- 4. Slide the on/off switch to the off position.

Troubleshooting

- Before setting the sensors, move your hand in front of the lens. If the LED
 on the base station does not flash, check the antenna and/or batteries.
- Check that nothing is blocking the sensor lens. The sensors will only detect movement five feet directly in front of the lens.
- Ensure that the sensor antenna is set as straight as possible.
- Sensor works best in well lighted areas. Performance will be lower in dimly lighted areas.
- ¥ Do not aim sensor directly at a light source.
