

Attention Adults -To Install Batteries

To Install Batteries In The Base Station

- I. Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the base station. Use a small Phillips head screwdriver to loosen the screw, and unclip the battery cover.
- 2. Place batteries in compartment as shown Fig A.
- 3. Replace battery cover and tighten screw.

To Install Batteries In Each Sensor

- I. Remove the sensors from the base station (see below).
- 2. Locate the battery compartment on the bottom of the sensor. Use a small

Phillips head screwdriver to loosen the screw, then remove battery cover.

- 3. Place batteries in compartment as shown Fig 8,
- 4. Replace battery cover and tighten screw
- 5. Repeat for each sensor.



To Set Sensors

- I. Push back the red latch on the base station and open the lid (Fig. I).
- 2. Pop out each sensor by pushing down from above (Fig 2).
- 3. Unwind the antenna from around each sensor and straighten,
- 4. Remove a tube from inside the base station cover and alide it over the ancenna until it snaps onto the sensor (Fig 3).
- 5. Slide each sensor's switch to the "ON" position (Fig 4).
- 5. Place each of the sensors in a hidling place anywhere up to 75 feet from the main unit.

NOTE: Be sure to set the sensor lens facing away from any obstructions (walls, books etc).

- Open the base station.
- Slide the on/off switch to mute or audio position (Fig 5). The map grid will Illuminate.

Wait for someone to trip a sensor!

With the on/off switch in audio-position, when someone moves it Trans of a sensor the base station will announce which sensor has been tripped and the sensor's LED will flash.

With the on/off switch in mute position, when someone moves in front of a sensor there will be no audio warning but the sensor's LED will flash. To stop the LEDs flashing press the reset button (Fig 7).

by Tip: Use the Spy Tracker to protect your gear, or ay hide & seek and never get caught.

Collect each sensor and wrap its antenna around the sensor body. Snap the antenna tip onto the clip.

Press each sensor back into place on the base station cover.

Wipe off the map grid with a clean dry paper towel.

Slide the on/off switch to the off position.

publishooting

Before setting the sensors, move your hand in front of the lens, if the LED on the base station does not flash, check the antenna and/or batteries.

Check that nothing is blocking the sensor lens. The sensors will only detect movement five feet directly in front of the lens

insure that the sensor antenna is set as straight as possible.

sensor works best in well lighted areas. Performance will be lower in dimly lighted areas.

Do not aim sensor directly at a light source.






