


Watch Features

- 12 or 24 hour format
- Calendar
- Display shows hours, minutes, seconds, month and date

Watch Battery Replacement

The watch uses one AG3 button cell battery (or equivalent). Make sure to install battery with the correct polarity as indicated below.

- 1. Slide the On/Off Button (6) to the OFF position.
- Using a small Phillips screwdriver, unscrew the Walkie Talkie Battery Compartment Cover (10) screw and remove the cover.
- 3. Remove the five remaining screws that secure the Watch Battery Compartment Cover (11).
- 4. Remove the old battery and replace with a new AG3 button cell battery, ensuring that the "+" side of the battery faces up.
- 5. Reattach Watch Battery Compartment Cover (11) and the Walkie Talkie Battery Compartment Cover (10).

Walkie Talkie Battery Replacement

The walkie-talkie uses four AG13 button cell batteries (or equivalent). Make sure to install batteries with the correct polarity as indicated below.

- 1. Slide the On/Off Button (6) to the OFF position.
- 2. Using a small Phillips screwdriver, unscrew the Walkie Talkie Battery Compartment Cover (10) screw and remove the cover.
- 3. Remove the old batteries and replace with four new AG13 button cell batteries, ensuring that the "+" sides of all batteries face up.
- 4. Reattach the Walkie Talkie Battery Compartment Cover (10).

To Set the Time and Date

- 1. Press the Set Button twice; the month digits will display. Press the Mode Button until the number of the correct month is displayed.
- 2. Press the Set Button again; the date digits will display. Press the Mode Button until the correct date is displayed.
- 3. Press the Set Button again; the hours digits will display, followed by either A (AM), P (PM), or H (24-Hour display). Press the Mode Button until the correct hours digits AND the desired display format (12 or 24 Hour format) are displayed. The hours digits will cycle through AM, PM, and 24-hour display in order.
- 4. Press the Set Button again; the minutes digits will display. Press the Mode Button until the correct minutes digits are displayed. Press the Set Button again, then press the Mode Button to exit and return to normal time display.

To Use the Walkie Talkie

- 1. Plug the earphone into the Earphone Jack (4) and put the earphone onto your ear.
- 2. Slide the On/Off Button (6) to the ON position.
- 3. The Walkie Talkie has an internal microphone; to send a message, push the Push-To-Talk Button (8) and speak clearly into the unit while holding the unit about 2-3 inches from your mouth.
- 4. Release the Push-To-Talk Button (8) in order to receive messages.
- 5. Slide the On/Off Button to the OFF position to turn the Walkie Talkie off.

To Change Faceplates

Remove existing faceplate by lifting it up from the right hand side at the indentation in the watch face. Snap new faceplate into place by lining up the six pegs with the holes in the watch face and pressing down firmly.

Care and Maintenance

Clean product with a soft, dry cloth only. Do not use solvents or detergents. Keep product away from dripping or splashing water. Do not immerse in water or other liquids.

Battery Handling and Usage

WARNING: Only adults should handle batteries. Do not allow a child to use this product unless the Battery Compartment Cover is securely attached to the Battery Compartment in accordance with all product usage instructions.
