

CHARGING THE BLUETOOTH DEVICE

- 1. Connect the speaker's Micro USB socket (6) with the Power Source's USB port through USB cable.
- 2. The display will show a progress bar while the battery is charging. When the device has reached a full charge the device will show a full progress bar.
- 3. Disconnect the USB cable when it is fully charged. A full charge will take approximately 4-6 hours.

*Please charge the speaker before first use.

PAIRING / RECONNECTING THE DEVICE

- 1. Press and hold the Multi-Function button to turn on the device (1); the device's display will indicate bluetooth pairing mode.
- 2. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your device.
- 3. Search for "STRIDER" and select it to pair (for first time pairing or pairing a new mobile device).
- 4. The Speaker will reconnect automatically if your mobile phone has been paired previously. With some devices you will be prompted for a password, input "0000". (Depending on the device's type and configuration, reconnecting manually may be required.)
- 5. If pairing is successful, your speaker will make a tone to confirm.
- 6. When finished press and hold the Multi-Function (1) button to power off

(Note: If you cannot search for the speaker, this means the last device is reconnecting automatically. Restart the speaker and hold the Multi-Function button until the Bluetooth mark brinks on the screen. This will indicate the device has entered Bluetooth searching mode.)

SPEAKER CONTROLS AND FUNCTIONS

- When playing music, press the Multi-Function button (1) to pause and again to resume playing music.
- Short press the Volume Up button (2) to increases the volume.
- Short press the Volume Down button (3) to decreases the volume.
- Long press the Volume Up button (2) to play next track.
- Long press the Volume Down button (3) to play previous track.

SPORT MODE FUNCTION



To sync and track activity data from the speaker to your smartphones, download the "STRIDER" app from App Store® / Google play store.

- 1. With the device powered on, long press the Sport Mode button (4).
- 2. The speaker will switch to "Sport" mode, which will record data for your workout that you can then later track on the "STRIDER" App.
- 3. You can also check your progress at any time by short pressing the Sport Mode (4) button. The speaker will announce your progress.
- 4. To exit "Sport" mode, long press the Sport Mode (4) button again.

HANDS FREE FUNCTIONS

- Press the Multi-Function button (1) to pick up a call, any music playing will automatically be paused.
- · Long press the Multi-Function button (1) to reject a call.
- Press Multi-Function button (1) again to hang up the call when finished. The paused music will resume playing automatically.

(Note: Speak within a foot of the device to get the best speaker-phone performance when necessary.)

SOS ALARM FUNCTION

- · In the case of an emergency or accident and you are in need of assistance or to alert other, you can sound an alarm.
- To activate the SOS alarm function long press the SOS (5) Button. This will begin to sound the alarm.
- To end the SOS alarm function short press the SOS (5) button.

- · Restart the device and try to reconnect.

Bluetooth device will not reconnect with the Speaker

• From your Devices bluetooth menu select the "STRIDER" speaker and choose "Forget". Now repeat the steps to pair to the speaker.

- · Ensure the Bluetooth function is activated on your device.
