



Product sketch map




- 1. Play/pause (under Bluetooth mode)
- 2. Skip previous (under Bluetooth mode)
- 3. Skip next(under Bluetooth mode)
- 4. AUX: Press AUX button to turn to AUX play mode
- 5. Press Bluetooth button to turn to Bluetooth play mode.
 Press and hold for 3S to disconnect with the Bluetooth device
- 6. Volume down
- 7. Volume up
- 8. Power button: Press to turn on the speaker
 Press and hold for 3S to turn off the speaker



9. AUX indicator: red10. Bluetooth indicator: Pairing: Flash slowing

Pairing Bluetooth Speaker

- 1. Press the Power button to turn on the speaker. The speaker is defaulted in Bluetooth reconnect Mode and the Blue light is flash slowly.
- 2. Turn on your Bluetooth device, search "iBT35" in your Bluetooth searching list, then pair your Bluetooth device with the speaker. (If your Bluetooth device ask for password, please insert "0000".)

Both the speaker and your Bluetooth device will store the device name. Next time, when you use the same

Playing Audio Wirelessly

- 1. Follow the instruction of Pairing Bluetooth Device
- 2. Adjust the volume by press or hold on the or native controls on the Bluetooth device.
- 3. Press to skip previous or next. Press to play/pause.
- 4. Press and hold button for 3s to disconnect with the paired Bluetooth device, The speaker will search for other Bluetooth device.
- 5. When do not play music, please press the Power button to turn off the speaker.
- 6. The speaker will be off if there is on audio input in 15mins(here,pls update the manual on SP58050 as well)

Using the 3.5mm Audio Input

- 1. Plug the UL adaptor with the speaker and make sure it is well connected with the power.
- 2. Turn on the speaker.Press AUX button to turn the speaker to AUX play mode,and now the AUX indicator is red.
- 3. Plug one end of a 3.5mm Audio cable into the unit. Plug the other end of the 3.5mm Audio cable into other audio devices.
- 4. Turn on the speaker, it will play music from the audio device.
- 5. Press and hold on the buttons to adjust the volume.
- If you want to Play/pause the tune, just control the native buttons on your audio device.
