

PAIRING YOUR BLUETOOTH® SPEAKER

- Slide the power switch 'ON' to turn on the speaker. When the speaker is activated in Bluetooth® Pairing Mode, a blue LED will start flashing.
- With your device powered on, search "HEX-1" on your bluetooth searching list. Proceed to pair your Bluetooth® device with the speaker. (If your bluetooth device asks for password, please enter "0000.")
- After being paired successfully, you will hear an audible signal.
 When paired you are able to use this device to play your media of choice.
- 5. Press Pause/Play button on the speaker to control the current track. You can also control your speaker with a Bluetooth® device.
- Press the Play button during an incoming call to activate 'Hands-Free' calling. The speaker will continue playing your track when the call has completed.
- When you are finished using your speaker, turn off your device by using the ON/OFF switch.

USING THE 3.5mm AUDIO INPUT

- Securely fasten one end of the 3.5mm Audio cable into the device.
 The mode indicator light will glow red.
- 2. Securely fasten the opposite end into your audio device.


