


JOYSTICK CONTROL:






1. Push both sticks forward to skate forwards





3. Turning clockwise. To skale form ciocinvise circle push the left stick forwards. To skate backwards in a wide clockwise circle pull the right atick back




se circle pull the left stick back to skate forwards in a wide anti-clockwise circle push the right stick forwards. spin on the spot clockwise.




Push the right stick forwards and the left stick backwards at the same time and the skater will spin on the spot anti-clockwise.






IMPORTANT BATTERY INFORMATION

- "Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mbr alkaline, standard (Carbon zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium)
