Wireless Camera

Before you install the camera, carefully plan where and how it will be positioned, and where you will route the cable that connects the camera to the power adapter. Before satting permanent installation, verify its performance by observing the image on the monitor when camera is positioned in the same location/position where it will be permanently installed and the monitor is placed in the location where it will be used most of the time.

Installation Warnings

Alm the cameral job best oplimize the viewing area: Select a location for the camera that provides a clear view of the area you want to monitor, which is free from dust, and is not in line-of-sight to a strong light source or direct sunlight.

Avoid installing the camera where there are thick walls or obstructions between the camera and the monitor.

No picture from a Camera The picture may become choppy when experiencing a lower frame rate (i. e. 10 frames per second vs. a higher 20 frames per second).

1. Try moving the camera closer to the monitor.

2. Remove obstructions between the monitor and camera. The picture is or has become choppy
