 *Remove the 2*5* Hooks from the parts beg and install them through the eye boths at the top of the sign

 *Remove the 2*5* Hooks from the parts beg and attach one or both to the *5* hooks. Measure the distance between them

 *Remove the location for the ceiling hooks, AOTE: The ceiling hooks need to be placed in a surface that will support a minimum

 of 10tos. If mounting in metal, drill a loth tole first. If in mounting in a drop ceiling, use a back place to robge boths. For all other surfaces, consult your local hardware store/electrical professional.
- * Mount ceiling hooks securely using pilers

Sign Function Options

Your Spectrum Digital Hours OPEN Sign comes with 4 function options in addition to On/Off. These functions can be toggled through in the following order by depressing the "FUNCTION' button in the

Function 1: Static Lit - In this function mode, both the border and the OPEN will be lit without flashing, scrolling, or chasing. This is a great function mode to use if you want to match the colors of your sign to your other business colors

Function 2: OPEN Scroll, Border Chase - In this function mode, the OPEN scrolls from left to right & the border chases clockwise. This is a great basic function to show off the colors and get your customers' attention

Function 3: Color Scroll - In this function mode, both the OPEN and the border scroll through all 8 of the color options in order. This is a very flashy and eye catching function that shows off all the colors of the rainbow.

Function 4: OPEN Flash, Border Phasing - In this function mode, the OPEN flashes ON & OFF and the border phases in & out of each color in order. This function mode is great if you want to combine the single OPEN color with the expression of multiple border colors

Updating Your Sign Using Bluetooth Via Your Smartphone Your OPEN Sign comes equipped with Bluetooth technology. You can use your bluetooth-enabled iPhone or Android phone to undate your sign.

General Instructions

Step 1: Plug your sign in and wait 30 seconds before continuing. Note - you can only program one sign at a time. If you have more than one GLI sign, please unplug the others as the signs are programmed to auto connect to only 1 sign at a time

Step 2: Stand within 5 feet of your sign with your phone in hand

Step 3: Launch the 'GLI OPEN Sign' App

Step 4: The application will automatically attempt a connection with the sign

Step 5: Once the application has successfully connected, the loading screen will slide away and you can make any updates necessary. Be sure to tap the 'Update' button when you are ready to update the sign with any changes you've made in the application

Step 6: The sign will automatically be updated with the most recent time from your phone. Use the

On/Off tab in the app to automatically program your sign to turn on and off Step 7: Change any color on your sign using the 'Colors' tab

Step 8: Try a new animation function under the 'Effects' tab

Step 9: Under the 'Hours' tab, you can adjust the open/closed times displayed on your sign. To change between military and standard time, tap on the settings gear icon in the top right of the app and toggle







Manually Setting the Digital Hours

The Digital Hours portion of your sign has the following features:

- * Display your operating hours in standard or military time
- * Show the days your are CLOSED. To spell CLOSED use 0 (zero) for D and 5 (five) for S
- * Show the days you are open 24 HOURS. To spell 24 HOURS, use A for R and 5 (five) for S
- * Indicate PM by leaving a dot in the lower right hand corner of the last digit in each row next to the printed PM * Change the color of the days of the week by pressing the 'DAYS' button
- * Change the color of the hour digits by pressing the 'HOURS' button
- 'The digital hours control panel is located on the right side of the sign. The top button labeled 'CURSOR' is used to move the cursor from left to right, top to bottom, just like reading a book. The button labeled 'CHANGE' is used to scroll through the character options for each digit. Each digit has the following options to choose

Option 1: = (Off / Blank Digit)

Option 2: 0 - 9 Option 3: 0. - 9.

Option 4: R, C, E, H, L, U, -





Remote Control Operation

The remote control provided controls the ON and OFF functions of your sign. To turn your sign ON, press button marked 'ON'. To turn your sign OFF, press the button marked 'OFF'. To replace the remote control battery, unscrew the two screws on the back cover and remove the cover. Remove the old battery and insert a new battery. Re-attach the back cover. Battery polarity is marked on the back of the remote case as indicated helow:
