How to Turn On the Power

The packaging machine is connected to the system of the computer.

If the computer is turned on, the packaging machine is automatically turned on.

Note: The breaker needs to be controlled such as when installing the packaging machine or cleaning the print head.

1 Insert the power plug to the outlet.


Use a three-pronged grounded 120VAC or 230VAC outlet depending on the standard in the geographic area of use.
When using a two-pronged outlet, use a three-prong/two-prong adapter.
Do not connect the power plug to the power strip with an excessive number of plugs inserted.







How to Turn Off the Power


Turn off the power after use. When turning off the power, turn off the computer first.

When the system is turned off, the machine is automatically turned off.

Note: When moving the packaging machine or cleaning the print head, turn off the breaker as well.







When restarting JSD.NET, the packaging machine is restarted as well.





When dispensing only medicines stored in canisters, enter the prescription on the computer and then release it.



Dispensing Medicines from DTA

■ When Dispensing Medicines from DTA

When dispensing tablets which are not stored in canisters such as those are seldom used, set them in the DTA tray manually for each prescription. Enter the prescription on the computer and release it first. Then set tablets in the DTA tray manually.


When DTA LED Lights (Option) are Installed

The LED lights on the DTA tray turn on in blue, red, green, purple, light blue, and yellow depending on the method.

1 Release the prescription.

When dispensing tablets manually, the audio guidance "Set DTA." is played and the DTA instruction is output from the journal printer. Then dispense tablets from the main body in the following procedures.



"S" printed on the DTA instruction (normal) indicates the start date, and "E" indicates the end date.

Image of DTA instruction (normal)




Image of DTA instruction (detail)
