

# **11** Set the packaging unit in place.


Hold the handle on the packaging unit and return the packaging unit to its original position. Push it all the way in until it clicks.

When the packaging unit is set in place, the beep sound is played.



#### 12 Close the lower doors.

Close the right door first and then close the left door.




## **13** Resume dispensing.

Tap [Resume] to restart dispensing.



Dispose of the used ink and protective cap according to the disposal regulations and rules in your community.



#### Maintenance Tank

Note: This chapter only covers the inkjet printer type.

When the maintenance tank becomes full, the warning appears on the touch panel and the packaging machine stops operation.

Replace the maintenance tank with the new one.




#### **CAUTION**

Do not lick or swallow the ink. If so, call a physician immediately. Do not leave the maintenance tank removed for a long time. Do not detach the maintenance tank unless it needs to be replaced. Replace the maintenance tank carefully to avoid ink adhesion to your hands.

After removing the used maintenance tank, put it in a reclosable plastic bag and zip the bag securely.

Do not shake or press the used maintenance tank hard. Also, do not hold the maintenance tank with the ink port facing down. Doing so may cause the ink to leak out, resulting in staining of clothing or the surrounding area.




#### **1** The warning appears.

The inkjet maintenance tank warning is displayed on the touch panel and the audio guidance is played.

Tap [Mute] to stop the audio guidance.

Note: If you tap [Disconnect], the packaging machine goes into the "Printer OFF Mode" and dispenses medicine without printing. If you restart the computer and the packaging machine, the "Printer OFF Mode" is switched back to the normal mode.






If there is a string of pouches in front of the lower doors when you try to open them, press the End Cutter button.


2 Open the lower doors.

Open the left door first and then open the right door.



### **3** Pull out the packaging unit.

Hold the handle on the packaging unit and then pull it out.




### 4 Open the packaging unit.

Pull the lever on the packaging unit.

After unlocking the packaging unit, pull it out.


#### **CAUTION**

#### **5** Remove the maintenance tank.


Pull the maintenance tank full of ink to the left to remove it.



Put the removed maintenance tank in the provided disposal bag and zip the bag securely.


#### **CAUTION**

#### **6** Install the maintenance tank.


Install the new maintenance tank. Note: Insert it all the way in.

Hold the lever on the packaging unit and push the packaging unit.


Push it all the way in until it clicks.

Hold the handle on the packaging unit and return the packaging unit to its original position. Push it all the way in until it clicks.


When the packaging unit is set in place, the beep sound is played.






#### **9** Close the lower doors.


# Journal Printer Paper

Even though the journal printer paper roll becomes empty, no error is displayed on the touch panel.

(Please check the paper lamp on the control panel.)


If the journal printer paper roll becomes empty, set the new one.

If the journal printer paper roll becomes empty, the paper lamp on the control panel turns on in red.




### **1** Open the journal printer cover.

Press the open button to open the journal printer cover.



### **2** Set the new printer paper.


Remove the empty paper core and set the new paper roll. Set the paper roll so that the paper comes out of the upper side.






## **3** Close the printer paper cover.


Close the cover with the end of the paper taken out a little.

When the replacement is completed, the Online lamp turns on.



# Tablet Drop Sensor


### **1** Open the upper door.

### **3** Clean the tablet drop sensor.


Wipe with a soft dry cloth.



Do not wipe with a damp cloth. Doing so may cause a failure.


#### 4 Attach the canister.

# **5** Close the upper door.


Close the upper door of the main body or the front door of the slide unit.

#### **1** Open the DTA tray.


Tap [DTA Open/Close] to open the DTA tray.



### **2** Remove the DTA partition tray.


When holding the DTA partition tray, hold its both sides.

Wipe with a soft dry cloth.


