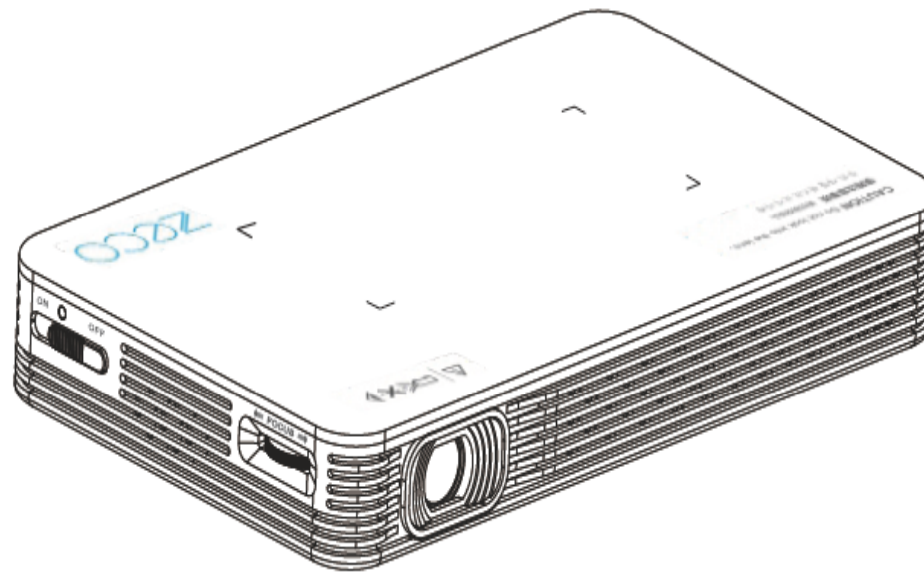

This mark means that there are modules without electric insulating treatment, and it may cause electric shock. So, It is dangerous to touch components inside.

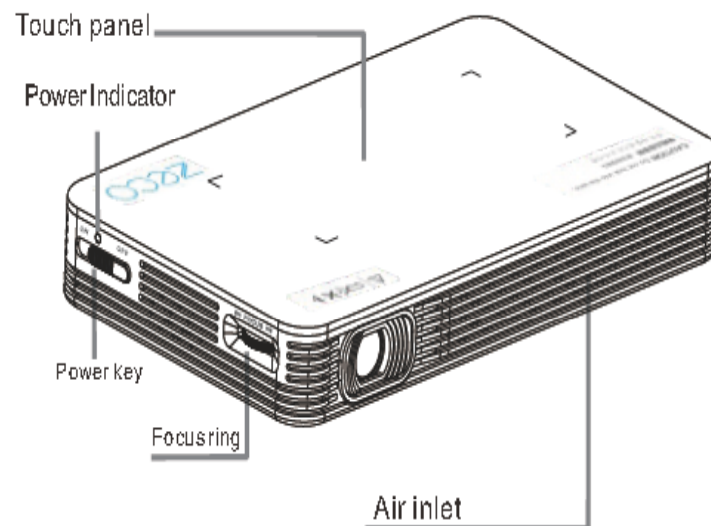

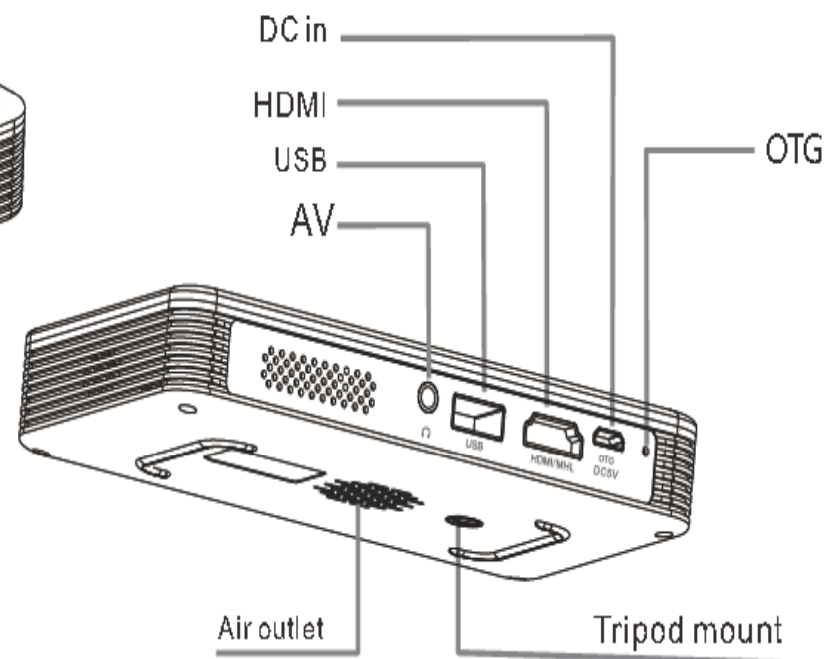

To prevent fire and shock, please do not expose the projector to rain or humid environment.

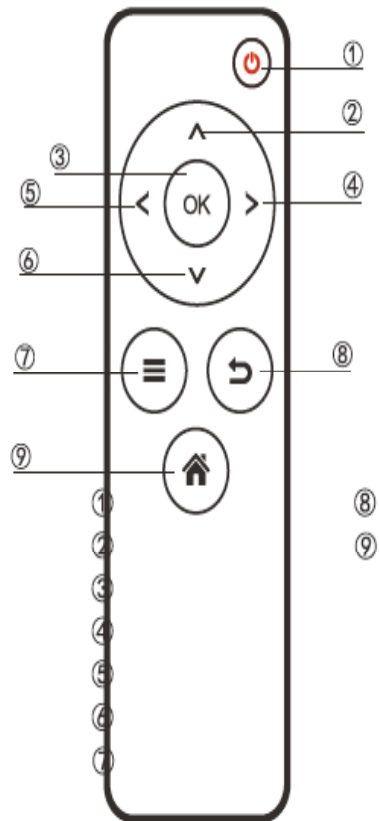
Projector Parts

Remote Illustration

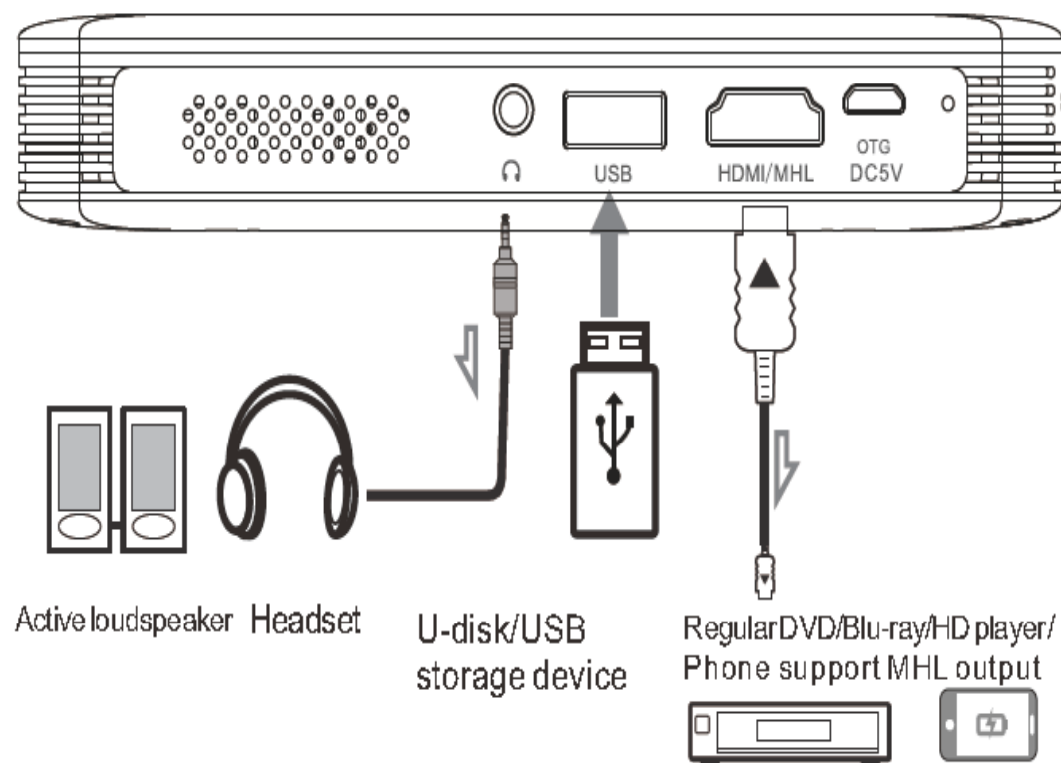

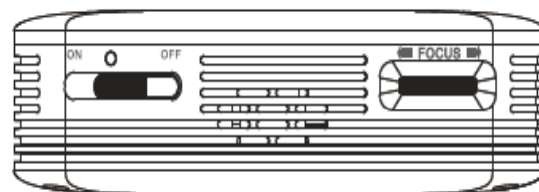
Remote Controller Usage Notes:

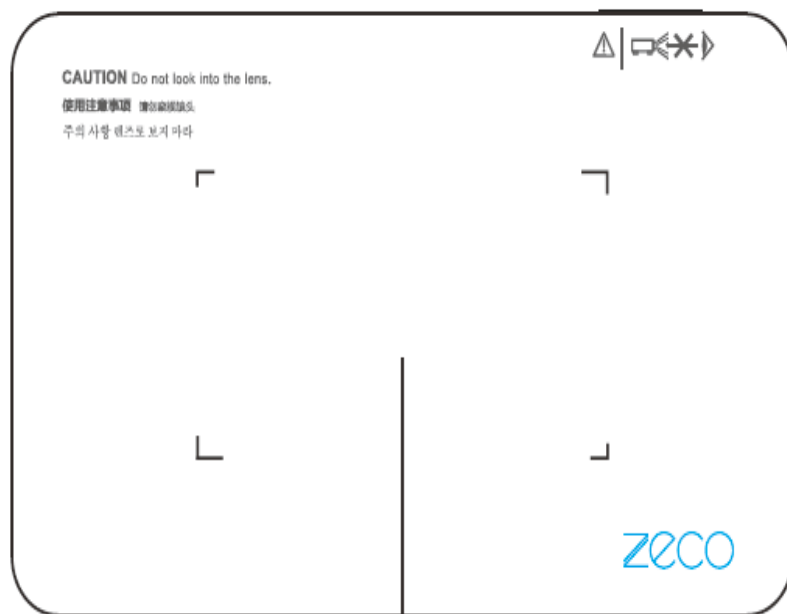
Power switch functions illustrating



“OFF: When the switch is poked to this position, the projector is turned off and enters into the most low power modes. The remote controller could not power on the projector, and power bank function is not available via the USB socket under this mode. Please poke the switch to this position when you do not use the projector to extend the life of the battery.

“ON: Poke the switch to this position and hold on 5 seconds, the projector will power on or will enter into the standby mode. the battery can be charged in these two mode, we advise you charge the projector in standby mode.

Touch panel instructions



Touch panel

This is capacitive touch panel, Operating with fingers, and please never use sharp objects to operate.

Instructions as follow:

Single tapping with one finger:

Means "Enter", tapping to enter a application or type the characters.

Single tapping with two finger:

Means "Back", back to previous menu or home page.

2. Select the Wi-Fi signal and tap correct password;

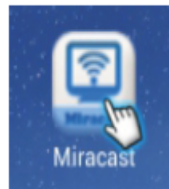

Miracast Application

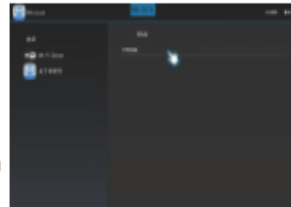
Miracast is the wireless mirroring technology based on Wi-Fi Direct. Stream the screen on projector via the technology.
