

NOTICE: In this manual "short by" a certain button, the button is pressed after the release, "long by" one button, the button is pressed to maintain two seconds or more than two seconds.

2.2 Battery

2.2.1 Remove and install of the Battery.

- When removing the battery follow the following steps:
 - ① Push the battery cover towards bottom;
 - ② Raise the battery bottom, break out the battery from the Smart-phone.
- When installing the battery follow the following steps:
 - ① Make the battery metal contact completely contact with the battery compartment metal contact, and then push the battery to inset the phone.
 - ② Put the battery cover on.

Warning: remove battery previous must turn off your cell phone. It is forbidden to boot or have other external power of connection directly take out the battery, or possible damage to the SIM card and a mobile phone.

2.2.2 Battery charging

- Plug the charger connector with the phone, and plug the charger into the electrical outlet.
- At this time the charge level icon will repeatedly flash at the top right corner of the mobile phone's screen; If the mobile phone charging while power off, a charging indication will appear on the screen. If the mobile phone was used even after there

was insufficient power, it might take some time after having begun charging until indication of charging appears on the screen.

When the battery level icon does not flash anymore, this means that the battery is fully charged. If charging while power off, there will still be an indication on the screen when the charging is complete. This process usually takes more than 2.5 hours (The first three times you recharge, you'd better keep 12-14 hours, as this will help extend battery life). The mobile phone and charger will become warm during charging and this is normal.

- When charging is complete, unplug the charge connector from the electrical outlet and the mobile phone.

ATTENTION:

- Charging must be performed in a well-ventilated area with a temperature between -10°C and +45°C. The factory-supplied charger must be used. Using an unapproved charger could be dangerous in addition to being in breach of the provisions of the repair warranty.
- If the mobile phone automatically shuts down, or indicates that "Battery is low" you should immediately charge the battery. If the battery has not been entirely used up before charging, the mobile phone will automatically decrease the recharging period.

2.3 Connect network

2.3.1 SIM card

Before using your phone, you must first insert a valid SIM (Subscriber Identity Module) card in the phone. The SIM card provided by the network provider.

All set up and network connection of the related information were recorded on a SIM card in the chip, and they recorded in on the card and your SIM card in the telephone book store name, telephone number and short messages.

SIM card can from your phone out, put any a mobile phone in use (novice the opportunity to automatically read the SIM card).

In order to prevent loss and damage information in the SIM card, touch the metal contact surfaces should be avoided, and the SIM card is placed away from electric, magnetic place. Once the SIM card is damaged, you will not normally use the phone.

Warning: take out the SIM card previous must turn off your cell phone. It is forbidden to have external power supply connected cases insert or take out the SIM card, or possible damage to the SIM card and a mobile phone.

2.3.2 Insertion of the SIM Card

Metal interface of SIM card is very easy scraped. Before inserting into the phone you must carefully remove it.

- Turn off the phone; remove the battery and unplug other external power sources.
- Insert the SIM card into the SIM slot.
- When you need to remove the SIM card, please first turn off the phone, remove the battery, then remove the SIM card.

2.3.3 Insertion of the Memory Card

- Turn off the phone; remove the battery and unplug other external power sources.
- Insert the T-FLASH card to the T-FLASH trough.

- When you need to remove it, please first turn off the phone, remove the battery, then remove the memory card.

2.3.4 Turning the Phone On and Off

To turn on or off the phone please hold down **the Power key**.

If you turn on the phone without having inserted the SIM card, phone will display **"No SIM card"**. After inserting the SIM card, the phone will automatically check if the SIM is useable.

The following will be displayed in this order:

Input Phone Lock Code

—If you set the Phone Lock.

Input PIN

—If you set the SIM Lock.


Searching

—The phone will conduct a search to find the appropriate network connections.

2.3.5 Phone card unlock

In order to prevent the illegal use, your phone can be setup lock password to encryption protection. Choose this function, every time you need to enter on the screen lock password so that you can to the screen to unlock, allows handset into the normal use state. Users can be closed screen lock, in this case, mobile phones can't prevent be illegal use.


Long press the power key to open the phone.

Input screen lock password, Click on the " " deletion errors input. Click "ok" confirmation.

2.3.6 SIM card unlock

In order to prevent the illegal use, Your SIM card using PIN (personal identification number) code encryption protection. Choose this function, if you have already set up PIN code protection, in every time you boot must input PIN code, so that you can unlock a SIM card, and then to normal cell phone use. The user can close a SIM card password protection, but in this case, the SIM card can't prevent be illegal use.

- Long press the power key to open the phone.

- Input PIN, Click on the " " deletion errors input. Click "ok" confirmation. For example, if the PIN is set for 1234, the following input:

1 2 3 4 OK

If you input three times error PIN code of the SIM card, your SIM card network will be locked and the phone will be asked PUK code.

NOTICE: Your network supply chamber of commerce for your SIM card set a standard PIN (4 to 8 digits) number, you should be the change as soon as possible for your personal password.

2.4 Screen control

You can through the screen of a series of operations to control your phone.

- Click: you can choose the screen by clicking on the screen of the project, and the open application, use the buttons below the screen input.
- Sliding: you can pass on the screen horizontal or vertical sliding, realize the pages up and down, or displayed around.
- Long press: you can through the long by some projects get its available menu. In the long press application programming interface program icon, can the application shortcuts to add to the main screen.
- Drag: you can drag on the screen through some projects achieve certain operation.
- Did screen switching: you can flip through mobile phone screen display of switching namely. Did display function only in some interface effective, such as text input interface, surf the web interface, etc.

2.5 Idle interface

Turned on and unlock the screen, the display shows the interface is the idle interface.



In addition to the diagram shown in the shortcut icon of the idle interface, need to add or delete a folder, other shortcuts or widgets. When idle space after use, you can slide horizontally on the screen to open the home of the extension interface and add the desired content.

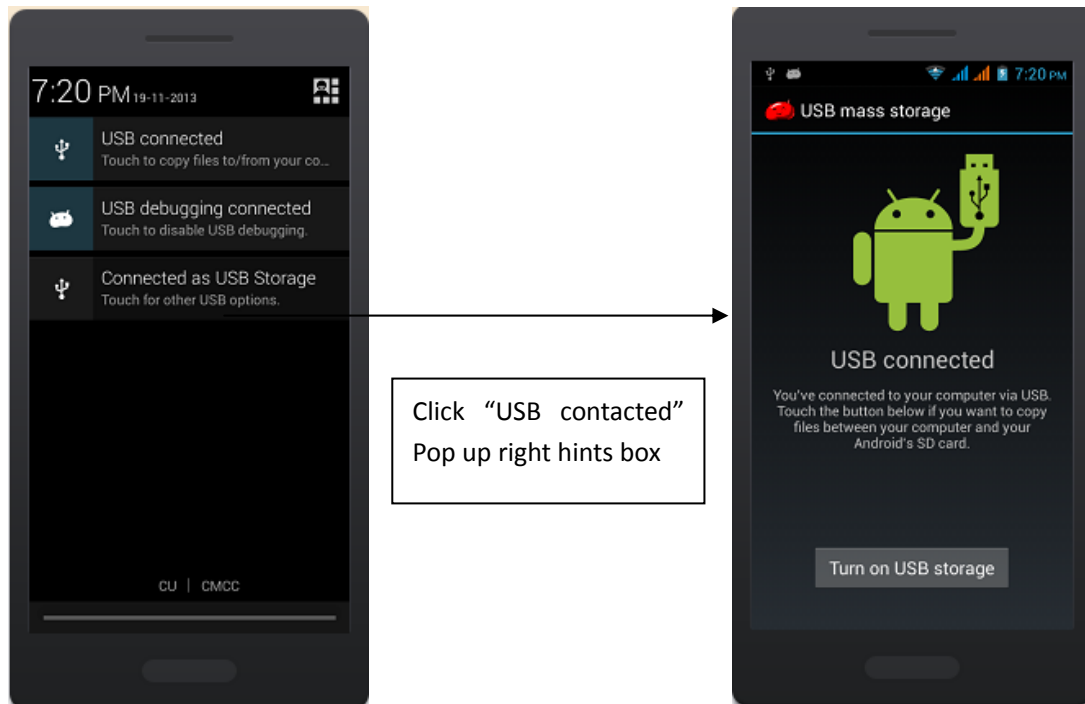

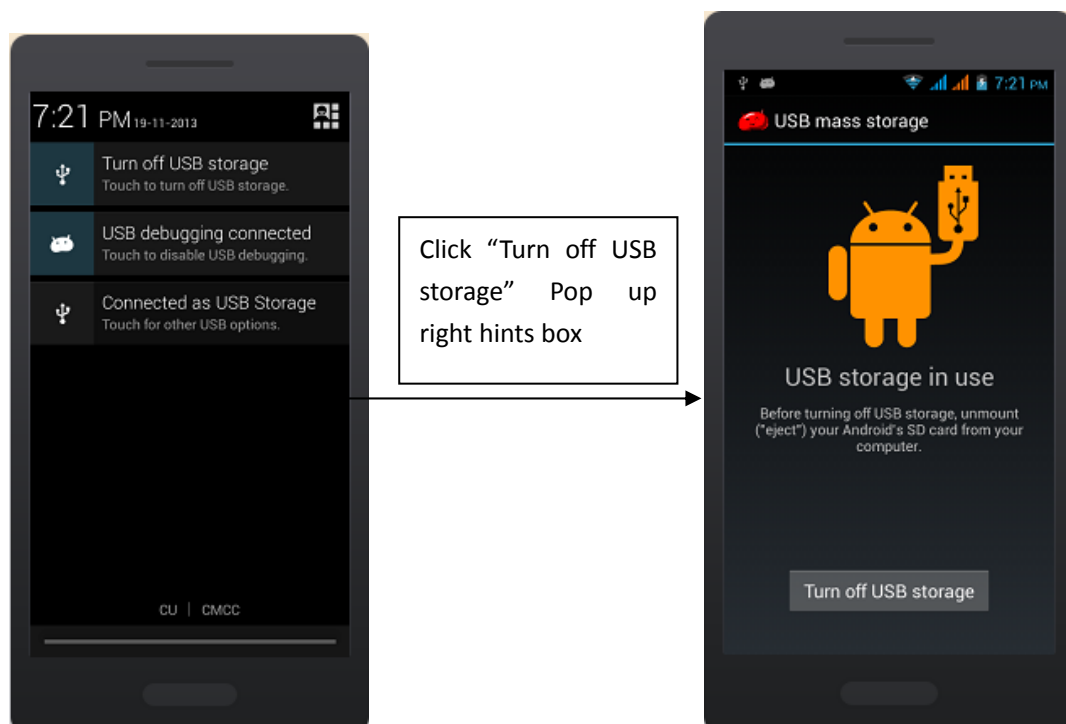
1. Use USB line will be mobile phone connected to the computer. The status bar will show the notification icon.

3.5 WLAN

Provide as far as 300 feet WLAN (100 M) wireless network access range. If you want to use the mobile phone of WLAN, you have to connect to wireless access point or "hot


spots".

NOTICE: The availability of WLAN signal coverage and will depend on the quantity, infrastructure, and other signals penetrate the object and decide.

3.5.1 Open the WLAN and connect to a wireless network

1. Press the Home key, click on " " -> Settings-> Wireless & networks.
2. Select WLAN check box, to open Wi-Fi. The phone will automatically scan can be used a wireless network.
3. Click on the Wi-Fi settings. Then WLAN network will display a list of WLAN to find the network of the name and security Settings (open network or with WEP, WPA/WPA2 encryption). If the opening set of WLAN network notice, to find a cell phone in the open wireless network can be used in the status bar shows the icon().

4. Touch one of the WLAN network to connection. When you select open network, mobile phone will be connected to the network. If selected is WEP, WPA/WPA2 encryption network, it must first corresponding input password, and then the touch connection

NOTICE: When the phone is connected to a wireless network, the status bar will display the WLAN icon () , and displays the approximate signal strength (light up the number of strip).If touch mobile phone at present the connected to a wireless network, will display the name of the state, WLAN network, speed, signal strength, safety information and IP address. If you want to remove phone wireless networks set, please touch this window on the "don't save". If you want to connect to the network, you must enter again these Settings.

Unless you choose not to save network, or the next mobile phone to connect to previously had connected encryption wireless network, will not have to enter a password accordingly. The network will search by WLAN, also is the mobile phone does not need to perform additional steps can be connected to the WLAN network.

Unless you choose not to save encrypted network, or the next mobile phone to connect to previously had connected encryption wireless network, will not have to enter a password accordingly. The network will search by WLAN, also is the mobile phone does not need to perform additional steps can be connected to the WLAN network.



3.5.2 Connection to other WLAN networks

1. Wireless and network on the screen, touch the WLAN settings. Find WLAN networks will be displayed in the WLAN network list.
2. Touch other WLAN networks can be connected to the network.

3.6.2 Matching and connecting Bluetooth headset


1. Press the Home key, click on " " -> Settings.
 2. Click on "Wireless & networks" -> Bluetooth Settings, Then Select Bluetooth check box, to open Bluetooth. Then your phone to scan within the scope of the Bluetooth, and will all find to device display in Bluetooth device list below.

- 1) If the list can not find your device, touch "Scan for devices", re-scan again.
 - 2) Please make sure you want the pairing of Bluetooth equipment is set to can detect the mode.
 - 3) Touch device list headphones, to match.

NOTICE:

The general Bluetooth devices need to enter a password to pair, more than "0000" as the default password. Matching and connection status displays in Bluetooth devices list below the headset. When the Bluetooth headset connected to hand unit, the status bar will

display Bluetooth already connection (). Then you can start to use headphones call or to answer the phone.

3.6.3 Interrupt and the Bluetooth headset connection

1. Press the Home key, click on " " -> Settings -> Bluetooth Settings.
2. In the list of Bluetooth devices, touch or tap and hold hands-free headset is connected.
3. Long press and select "Disconnect & un pair".

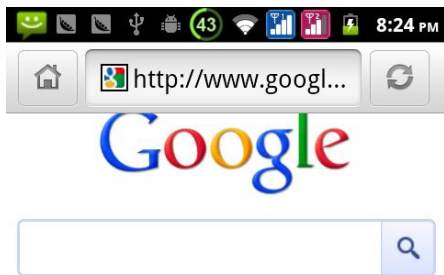
5.1 Browser

5.1.1 Open Browser

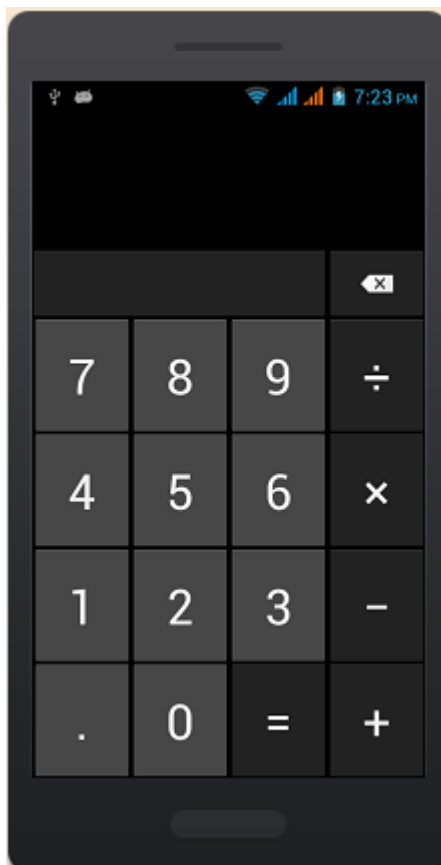
Touch Brower can open the browser. Interface as shown in the diagram:

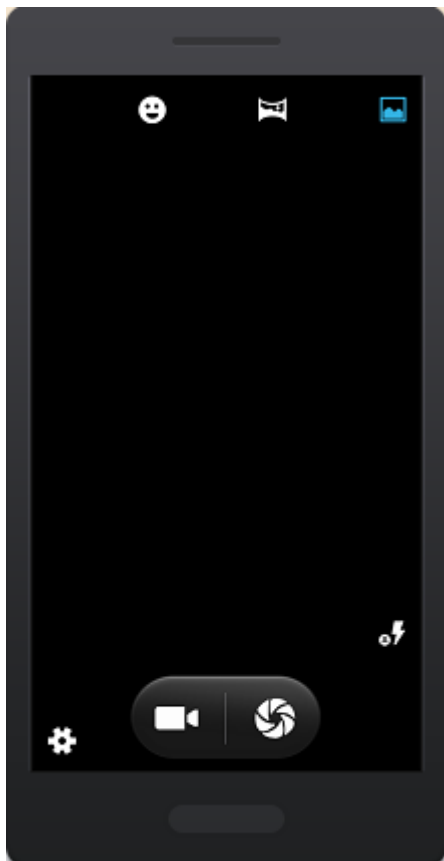

Click on the camera can turn on the camera.




Warm prompt: in the camera's interface, you can click "" fast switching to the camera to video camera, click  to smile mode and click  to Multi view mode;

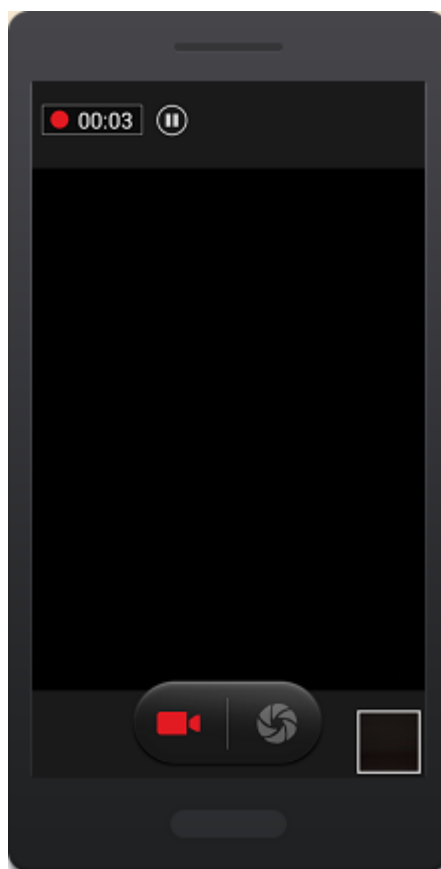

5.7.1 To open Email applications

5.7.2 To create Email account

Touch the "Email" icon, enter the Email account setting pane. Touch the arrow symbol at the top-left corner, exit E-mail account setting panel and return to main panel. Enter the E-mail account address and the password, and click user login, it tips your account has been set up and usable, input account name and name shown in the E-mail, then touch "finish", in order to be recognized by receiver. After creating an account, if you need to create another e-mail account, touch the "Menu" button ->add account and enter E-mail account and password (You can also switch to account list panel, press the "+add account" icon at the top-left corner), after entering the e-mail account and password you can choose->Send mails from this account default.

5.7.3 To compose and send e-mail

Note: If you want to copy or blind carbon copy e-mail sent to other recipients, press the MENU button, then click the Add Cc / Bcc

4. Enter the e-mail subject.
5. Compose your e-mail.

To add attachments, please touch add attachment, and then choose the options below:

- Pictures: Select camera and attach photos, or select pictures to attach pictures in the

storage card.

- Video: Select VCR and additional films, or select films to add films in the storage card.
- Audio: Select recorder and additional recordings, or select music and sounds to attach music file or recordings in the storage card.

6. Touch Send to send the e-mail.

Note: To save the mail as a draft for modifying, touch “save draft”, the system will save it automatically.

5.7.4 To delete e-mail

1. On the e-mail account inbox, touch and hold the e-mail you want to delete, pops up the windows menu, touch Delete.

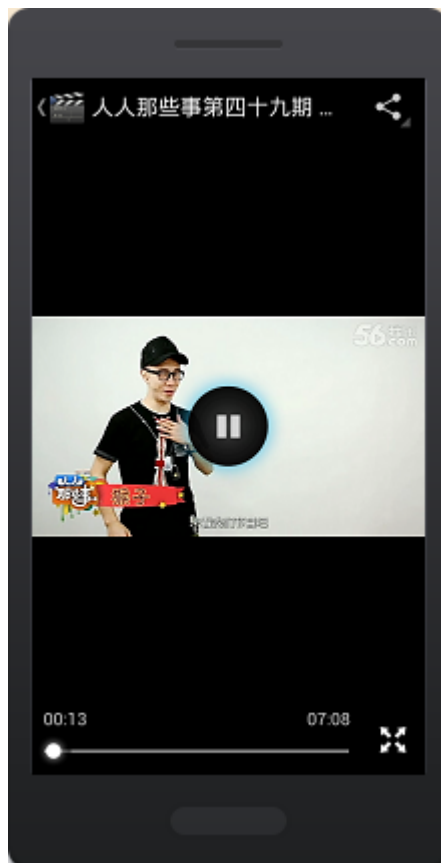
