RF Exposure Information

Radio Frequency (RF) Exposure

Your device contains a transmitter and a receiver. When it is ON, it receives and transmits RF energy. When you communicate with your device, the system handling your connection controls the power level at which your device transmits.

Important safety information regarding radio frequency radiation (RF) exposure. To ensure compliance with RF exposure guidelines the device must be used with a separation from the body.

Failure to observe these instructions could result in your RF exposure exceeding the relevant guideline limits.

The device was tested according to FCC RF exposure procedures to address hand and near-body exposure conditions, and the highest SAR value as reported to the FCC is 1.43 W/kg.

Operating machinery

Transfer or resale of a product will automatically terminate warranty coverage with respect to that product. After the one year warranty period, you must pay all shipping, parts and labor charges. In the event that the product is deemed un-repairable or has been removed from the list of products supported by the Seller, you will only be liable for shipping and labor charges.

This limited warranty does not cover and is void with respect to the following: (i) any Product which has been improperly installed, repaired, maintained or modified; (ii) any Product which has been subjected to misuse (including any Product used in conjunction with hardware electrically or mechanically incompatible or used with accessories not approved by Seller), abuse, accident, physical damage, abnormal operation, improper handling, neglect, exposure to fire or liquid; (iii) any Product operated outside
