INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Thank you for purchasing the Range Wireless Earbuds. This manual provides more information about the wireless earbuds, please read the instructions before using.



Range Wireless Earbuds x 1 Micro USB Cable x 1 Power On/Off Power On Press and hold down the On/Off Button for 2 seconds and the LED will flash. Power Off Press and hold down the On/Off Button for 3 seconds and the LED will turn off. Pair the wireless earbuds with your mobile device 1. Keep the distance between your wireless earbuds and mobile phone (or other devices) within 32.8 Feet. 2. Power on the wireless earbuds. Micro USB Charging Cable: 3. Activate the Bluetooth function on your phone within range and select @ ← B USB Plug "BT RANGE BUDS" from the list shown 4. The LED blinks in blue when paired successfully. Farbuds Overview

♦ When you receive a call, press the On/Off Button once to accept the call. or answer the call normally via your mobile phone

◆ Long press On/Off Button to reject a call

Charging your Earbuds

- LED indicator light turns red when charging your earbuds.
- ◆ LED indicator light turns to blue when your earbuds are fully charged.

Ensure that your earbuds are in pairing mode or reconnection mode. Ensure that Bluetooth search function of your mobile device is activated.
