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1.Introduction

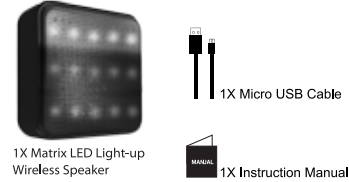

- 5 Do not use the Bluetooth speaker in a hazardous location.

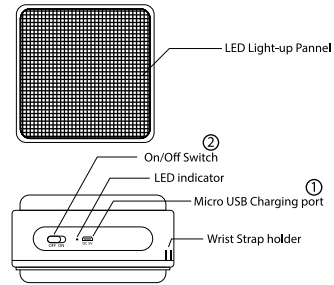
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2.Packaging Contents

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4.How to use

4.1.General Functions

Desired Result	Required Action
Turn on & Enter the pairing mode	Slide the button to the right.
Pairing	You must use a Bluetooth function mobile phone or other Bluetooth device to perform necessary pairing action.
Turn off	Slide the button to the left.
Charging	Plug the Micro USB to the port enable the Bluetooth devices.

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4.2.Pairing to Mobile phone or other device

To use your Bluetooth Speaker, you must first pair your speaker with a phone or a computer. Once your Bluetooth Speaker is paired to a specific mobile phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.

Pairing to a phone and Entertainment:

- Turn on your phone and ensure its Bluetooth function is activated
- Turn on the speaker go to the pairing mode.
- Search your Bluetooth device on your phone by following the phone's instructions. Refer to your phone's user manual for more information.
- After a few second the phone will list the "Matrix LED Speaker" as a discovered device. Select it and follow your phone instruction to select this pairing.
- Your phone will confirm the pairing, and then press Yes/OK.
- Finally, select to connect with Lightup Wireless Speaker from your phone.
- You can play music; watch TV/movies and play games with your phone, then you can hear all the sounds or music from the speaker. You can also control the player by operating the speaker. Example, volume up and next music.

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4.3.Charging your speaker

Use the Micro USB cable accessory provided with this speaker. Connect the Micro USB plug to the Micro USB charging port on the speaker positioned at ① in speaker diagram on page 2. Connect the USB plug to a USB port on a computer or wall adapter to activate charging.

**Make sure to keep the speaker charging for a minimum of 6 hours before initial use.



Warning:

- You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer.
- You must charge the Bluetooth speaker if it has been not used for more than 12 months.

6.FAQ

1. Why is there no power even when the Speaker is turned on?
Ans: Ensure the battery has been charged up to 6 hours for initial use.
2. There is no sound when playback.
Ans: Check the connection between speaker with phone or computer, if the connection is not established, please reconnect again. Make sure the speaker is paired and connected with your target phone or other master device.
