Safety Rules

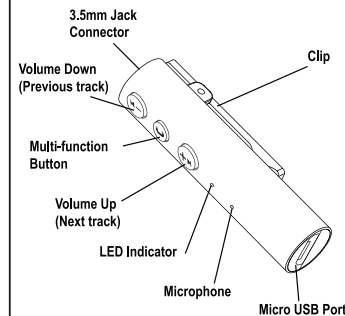
- 1 Please follow the rules depicted in this manual closely to ensure your safety. Before using this Bluetooth Converter we would strongly encourage you to read through this user manual.

4. How to use

4.1.General Functions


Desired Result	Required Action
Power On/ Power Off	Press and hold the multi-function button for 3 seconds until the LED light turns blue.
Volume Control	Long press + / - for volume control.
Switch Tracks	Press + / - to switch track.
Pairing	Use a Bluetooth function mobile phone or other Bluetooth master device to perform necessary pairing actions.
Charging	Plug the Micro USB cable into the charging port.
Answering a Call	When you receive a call, press the multi-function button once to accept the call, or answer the call normally via your mobile phone.
End a Call	Press the multi-function button once to end the call or hang up your mobile phone.

4.2. Pairing Bluetooth Converter to a mobile phone or other device

1. Keep the distance between your Bluetooth Converter and mobile phone (or other devices) within 33 Feet.
2. Power on the Bluetooth Converter.
3. Press and hold the multi-function button for 6 seconds. The LED indicator flashes blue to indicate pairing mode.
4. Activate the Bluetooth function on your mobile device and select "Bluetooth Adapter" to pair. The LED indicator keep blue if pairing has been successful.

4.3.Charging your Bluetooth Converter

Use the Micro USB cable provided with this product. Connect the Micro USB plug to the Micro USB charging port on the product positioned at  in the product diagram on page 2. Connect the USB plug to a USB port on a computer or wall adapter to activate charging. The LED will turn red while charging, the light will turn off once fully charged.
****Make sure to keep the Bluetooth Converter charging for a minimum of 3 hours before initial use.**



Warning:

- You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer.
- You must charge the Bluetooth Converter if it has been not used for more than 12 months.

The USB port only be used charging and can't be used to transfer data with PC.

6. FAQ

1. Why is there no power even when the Bluetooth Converter are turned on?

Ans: Ensure the battery has been charged up to 3 hours for initial use.

2. There is no sound during playback.

Ans: Check the connection between the Bluetooth Converter and the phone or computer, if the connection is not established, please connect again. Make sure the Bluetooth Converter are paired with your Bluetooth enabled device.
