
Remote Control

Control heli launcher to move backward






Control heli launcher to move left








Control heli launcher to move right




- Slide the ON/OFF switch to turn on the heli ball.
- Press(Heli Ball Launch / Stop Button) on the controller to turn heli ball into standby mode.
- 8 Put heli ball on the heli launcher holder until it is located upright inside the holder by the locating pin.
- Press(Heli Ball Launch / Stop Button) to launch the heli ball.
- (5) Press(Heli Ball Launch / Stop Button) again to stop heli ball from flying and start landing.










This function requires a Heli Ball to play with. Please purchase heli ball separately to unlock maximum fun.

Remote Control Batteries Installation




To install batteries into the controller, open the battery box cover. Insert 2 x "AA" 1.5V batteries (Not Included) into the battery box. Batteries should be placed as shown on the diagram.

Heli launcher Batteries Installation




To install batteries into the heli launcher, unscrew the screw on the battery box cover to open the cover. Insert 4 x "AA" 1.5V batteries (Not Included) into the battery box. Batteries should be placed as shown on the diagram.

When inserting the batteries, you must insert according to the correct polarity, the heli launcher wont function if batteries are reversed.

Power On/Off & Front Axle Control



Power On/Off
Slide the ON/OFF Switch to the left to turn on the heli launcher.
Slide the ON/OFF Switch to the right to turn off the heli launcher

Front Axle Control

Slide the Front Axle Control Switch to adjust front axle alignment.

Performance Tips

- 1. Do not drive the heli launcher on grass, sand or go through water.
- 2. Do not drive the heli launcher in windy or rainy weather.
- 3. Do not drive the heli launcher into any hard object.
- 4. Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from heli launcher.

RC Frequency Information

Same color Hell Launcher will affect each other if operating at same area. One controller will try to control both Hell Launcher or you'll get erratic behavior in one or both Hell Launcher.

To operate in close proximity, make sure each vehicle is a different frequency. A Grey Heli Launcher and a Orange Heli Launcher can run alongside each other with no problem

Care and Maintenance

Always use dry and soft cloth to clean this product.

Avoid this product from being exposed to sunlight or heat.

Avoid immersing these toys in water, otherwise, the electronic parts may be

Check the product regularly. If any damages are discovered, please stop using immediately, until it is completely repaired in good working condition.

Warning

This product is suitable to be used by people who has operating experience in rc car model or aged no less than 10 years old.

Please do not put the product in your mouth to prevent choking hazard of small parts.

When the product is not in use, please switch off the power supplies of the heli launcher and the remote control, and remove the batteries from the product.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

⚠ CAUTION:

1. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

a. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and - polarity markings.

b. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries

- c. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- d. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- e. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- 2. Should this product cause, or be affected by local electrical interference, move it away from other electrical equipment.Reset (switching ON&OFF again or removing and re-inserting batteries) if necessary.
