


Power

Plug one end of the included USB charging cable and adapter into the Micro USB Port on the unit and an AC power outlet to power the dock.


Mobile Dock

Line In Indicator


Speakerphone/Play /Pause

Bluetooth Setup

Pairing a Bluetooth Device for the First Time

- Power on the unit by pressing the **Power** button.
- 2. Press the Pair button.

The **Pairing Indicator** will flash blue auickly.

When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.

 Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select the "ISB563" in your Bluetooth settings to pair.

If your device requests a password, enter the default password " 0 0 0 0".

Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.

 When successfully paired and connected, the Pairing Indicator will display a solid blue light.

After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.

If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps or press the Pair button to start the pairing process pairing again.

Pairing a NFC Bluetooth Device

 Power on the unit by pressing the **Power** button.

Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on how to check for NFC availability and turn the feature on.

- After activating your mobile devices NFC, lightly touch your device to the NFC logo on the unit and hold it there for several seconds. The unit will connect the device automatically.
- 3. For more information on NFC, see the section in the user's guide for your mobile
- When successfully paired and connected, the Pairing Indicator will display a solid blue light.

After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.

Using Bluetooth

Playing Audio Wirelessly

- Follow the instructions for <u>Pairing a</u> Bluetooth Device.
- Use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device to select a track.
- To play or pause the selected track, use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device.
- Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.

Using the Speakerphone

- Follow the instructions in <u>Pairing a</u> <u>Bluetooth Device</u>.
- 2. When a call is received, a ringtone will sound through the speakers.
- Press the Speakerphone button to accept the call or accept the call with the native controls on the connected device.
- The incoming call received through the device will now be heard through the speakers.
- To end the call, press the Speakerphone button or end the call using the native controls on the connected device.

Line In

Using the Line In

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (included)

- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the Line In on the unit and an audio output on an MP3 player or other audio source.
- Use the native controls on the connected MP3 player or other audio source to play and control audio played through the clock radio.
