









## **Eversolo Bluetooth Connection Steps**

- 1: Press the overall master volume button for few seconds to start;
- 2 : And then press the music button, the LED light will continuously flash when the Bluetooth function was on:
- 3 : Open Bluetooth function on your cell phone, and find the device called "eversolo":
- 4 : Click "eversolo" to make connection:
- 5 : There was a sound "toot" comes out when connects to eversolo successfully, and then waiting the LED light turns off;
- 6: Turn off the Bluetooth function by clicking the music button:
- 7: If the eversolo is at Bluetooth state, the eversolo will automatically connect to your device when you turned Bluetooth on on your device.
