



STEP 1 - GETTING STARTED

- > Fully charge the Bluetooth headset until the LED turns BLUE
- > Connect the USB adapter to install the Windows drivers
- > Insert the provided CD-ROM and follow the on-screen installation instructions

STEP 2 - CONNECT YOUR ADAPTER



Before installing the application and starting using Skype, you need to connect the adapter to your USB port.

Before connecting the adapter please make sure to save your work as connecting the adapter for the first time will trigger your PC to install or load the appropriate drivers, on some systems a restart could be required and the following screen will be displayed. 3

After saving all your work and active documents select Yes as your PC has to restart for the adapter and drivers to function correctly.

STEP 3 – CD INSTALLATION



- The setup program should launch automatically, if it fails to launch please run the Setup file from the CD-ROM by double clicking the * setup.exe icon. Follow the on screen instructions.

NOTE: The setup program will check that Skype is pre-installed on your computer. If Skype is not present you will be presented with the option to either install Skype from the CD-ROM or download the latest version from the Skype website. Alternatively you can visit: http://www.skype.com/intl/en-gb/get-skype/

STEP 4 - START EASYCHAT

Press the Finish button to complete the installation. The setup application will launch the i.Tech EasyChat automatically.

NOTE: If you are using Windows Vista or 7 setup will not launch the application automatically. To start EasyChat click the Windows start menu and select All Programs, then click the i.Tech EasyChat folder and click the i.Tech EasyChat VOIP PC Suite to launch the application.

STEP 5 - CONNECT YOUR HEADSET

The headset and USB dongle have been pre-paired from the factory so you simply have to follow the easy on-screen instructions on how to connect your headset to your PC.
