In compliance with Benton County, Arkansas, Ordinance #O-2004-11 Section 58-37, the above stated company/individual does hereby make application to construct private driveways or other accesses connecting to a County Road. All steps are required to be followed in the order in which they are established. Failure to comply with this agreement will result in a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or double such sum for each repetition thereof. If the violation is in its nature, continuous in respect to time, the penalty for allowing the continuance thereof is a fine not to exceed \$250.00 for each day that the same is unlawfully continued. In the event of a necessary road closing, the applicant must contact the Road Superintendent, CENCOM, and any affected schools running busses in the area. Applicants MUST contact one call at 1-800-482-8998 for the marking of Underground Utility Lines BEFORE starting work.
