


## Step 1. Connect and power up the WAX202

- 2. Click the **Advanced** button.
- Click the **Continue to routerlogin.net** link.
- Follow the onscreen Setup Wizard prompts:
- Set a new admin password for local login.
- You can set a new WiFi network name (SSID) and WiFi password. If you do, reconnect with your new SSID and WiFi password to complete the setup.

## Optional Step 4. Change the operation mode

If a device in your network already provides router functions, change to access point mode.

- When logged in to the WAX202, select
  ADVANCED > Advanced Setup > Router / AP / Bridge Mode.
- 2. Select the **AP Mode** radio button and click the **Apply** button.
