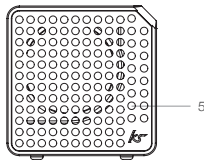
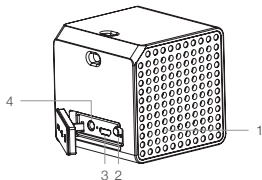

## Functions

1. LED input indicator
2. On/Off switch
3. Micro USB charging port
4. Aux-in port
5. LED charge indicator



## IPX5 rating

The speaker is rated IPX5. This means it protects from water jets at any direction, but is not impervious to large amounts of water.

Please do not directly immerse in water.

## Instructions for use

### Charging the speaker

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the Micro USB charging port (3) and plug into power
2. The LED charge indicator (5) will be red whilst charging which will take up to 2 hours
3. Once fully charged the LED charge indicator (5) will turn off

**Note:** Allow up to 4 hours for the first charge.

## Pairing the speaker to your device

1. Turn speaker on, and it will enter pairing mode, with the LED input indicator (1) flashing blue quickly
2. Turn your iOS, Android, or Windows device's Bluetooth ON and search for new devices
3. Select 'KS HAWAII 1.0'. If asked for a passcode, enter '0000', and the device will pair

**Note:** 'Bluetooth' is a trademark of Bluetooth SIG, Inc. This product is in no way affiliated with or endorsed by Bluetooth SIG Inc.

## Re-pairing or pairing new devices

1. Turn wireless connectivity off on any previously paired devices
2. Follow the 'Pairing the speaker to your device' instructions
3. If a previously paired device is not present within the wireless connectivity range then the speaker will re-enter pairing mode

## Playing music on your speaker

### Wireless

When connected wirelessly, play the music on your device and the sound will play through the speaker. Some devices may require you to select the audio output.

### Auxiliary

1. Plug the cable into the speaker's Aux-in port (4) and your device
2. The LED input indicator (1) will glow a solid red colour

### Changing the volume

When playing music via wireless and auxiliary inputs all volume and track controls are operated from the master device e.g. smartphone or tablet.

### **Please note:**

Your device will have an internal amplifier and if it is playing digital files like MP3s it will also have an integrated DAC (Digital Audio Converter).

If you turn the volume up to 100%, your device will be sending a distorted signal. To avoid this, and to get the best quality from the speaker, we recommend that you do not run your device any higher than 95% volume. Some devices output higher than others, so you may need to reduce the volume if you experience distortion.

## **Care for your Hawaii 1.0**

### **Please DON'T:**

- Submerge the Hawaii speaker in water
- Drop the Hawaii speaker as this will invalidate your warranty
- Open up the Hawaii speaker. There are no user serviceable parts inside
- Expose the Hawaii speaker to extreme temperatures or rapid changes of hot to cold or vice versa

### **Please DO:**

- Clean the Hawaii speaker with a soft dry cloth and no detergents
