

# Q&A QuickBayt® Spot Spray FAQs

**Q:** What is QuickBayt Spot Spray?

**A:** QuickBayt Spot Spray is an innovative next-generation spray-on fly bait formulation that delivers easy, effective and long-lasting house fly control.

**Q:** How does QuickBayt Spot Spray work?

**A:** QuickBayt Spot Spray contains powerful fly attractants. Flies seek it out, feed on the sugar-based bait and ingest the active ingredient (imidacloprid), which quickly kills them.

**Q:** How fast does QuickBayt Spot Spray work?

**A:** QuickBayt Spot Spray starts killing flies in less than 60 seconds.<sup>1</sup>

**Q:** Where can I use QuickBayt Spot Spray?

**A:** QuickBayt Spot Spray can be used in and around poultry houses, feedlots, dairy barns, swine confinement buildings, horse barns and stables, kennels and other animal confinement facilities where house flies are a nuisance or health hazard. It can be applied to almost any surface where flies rest or feed, as long as it does not come into contact with livestock or domestic animals.

**Q:** Does QuickBayt Spot Spray provide residual control?

**A:** Yes. One application of QuickBayt Spot Spray provides control for up to six weeks indoors and up to two weeks outdoors.

**Q:** How do I apply QuickBayt Spot Spray?

**A:** QuickBayt Spot Spray is mixed with water and applied with a pressurized sprayer. For best results, make a number of spot sprays throughout the facility (the whole area doesn't need to be treated). A 4-sq-ft spot size is ideal.

**Q:** What is the composition of QuickBayt Spot Spray?

**A:** QuickBayt Spot Spray is a sugar-based water-dispersible granular formulation of the insecticide imidacloprid (10%). It also contains the fly attractant muscalure (z-9 tricosene) and a flavoring agent that draws flies to the bait and stimulates them to feed.

**Q:** Why should I use a fly bait product?

**A:** QuickBayt Spot Spray is the ideal solution for adult fly populations that require chemical control measures. It can be applied indoors or out, wherever house flies are found, but because it's formulated to attract flies, you don't need to treat every surface where flies are seen. And QuickBayt Spot Spray features long residual activity, especially indoors, eliminating the need for frequent retreatments.
