BATTERY PRECAUTIONS

SET UP

- 1. Insert 4 AA batteries (not included). Note that in this device, the batteries' (+) and (-) indicators all face the same way.
- 2. Place your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard in an area where it receives a good signal. The ambiental icon displays the strength of signal that your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard is receiving. If you're only getting one bar, try moving towards a window or going upstairs—two to three bars of signal strength are ideal. A map of our signal coverage is available at http://map.myambient.com.
- 3. When you see ONETWORKFOUND, you're all set—sit back, relax, and wait for your first update. Please note, this could take up to six hours. If you've waited more than eight hours without receiving data, please see the Troubleshooting Guide at the end of this booklet.

GETTING STARTED

Your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard automatically knows whether you're in the off-season, the preseason, the regular season, or the playoffs. The following pages explain what will happen in each case.

HOW TO READ THE SCREEN

The screen is divided into two main areas:

The LINE SCORE section at the top of the screen gives you the inning-by-inning scores from the most recently played or live game.

The SCHEDULE/STANDINGS section displays either the upcoming schedule of games for your team or the division standings. In standings mode, press the DIVISION button to see another division's standings.

Press the DATA button to toggle between game schedules and division standings.

The information available in the Standings section is:

The top line of text next to the time displays the team whose statistics or schedule you're seeing. Press the \blacktriangleleft or \triangleright button to scroll through all teams.

The most recent game results are below the team's name, in the LINE SCORE section of the screen. If you're checking your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard during a game, you'll see scores and run/hit/error statistics updated at the end of every half-inning. **FINAL** appears to indicate that the game is over and TODAY'S GAME will appear on the screen if the game displayed is currently being played, or has already been played in the current day. The home team is always on the bottom.

The lower part of the screen has two views-game schedules and division standings. The label for this part of the screen will read SCHEDULE or STANDINGS to show what kind of data you're seeing. Press the DATA button to switch between the two views.

Standings are listed in order, with division leaders listed in the top row. Press DIVISION at any time to see the standings for another division.

STANDINGS VIEW

PRESEASON

During preseason, your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard displays scores for preseason games as well as regular season lineups and game schedules.

Use the \blacktriangleleft or \blacktriangleright button to select which team's schedule and statistics you'd like to see. The team's name is displayed in the top line of text, next to the time.

Use the DATA button to change between the preseason standings and schedules for each team. Some data, like the starting pitcher, may not appear right away. This updates when that information is available.

If a game is currently underway, the LINE SCORE section of the screen will update the score and run/hit/error statistics at the end of each half-inning. The space will be blank if the half-inning has not yet ended.

If there are no games currently being played, the LINE SCORE section of the screen will display the results from the most recent preseason game, with **FINAL** indicating that the game is over. Press the DIVISION button to switch between preseason leagues; GF stands for Grapefruit League, and CA is the Cactus League.

Since some teams that play during the preseason are not MLB teams, their team name will be designated as "----" when playing MLB teams.

As the preseason comes to an end, your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard will automatically begin displaying schedule and standings information for the regular season.

REGULAR SEASON

During the regular season, your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard displays current game scores, future game schedules and lineups, and the standings in each division.

Use the \blacktriangleleft or \blacktriangleright button to select which team's schedule and statistics you'd like to see. The team's name is displayed in the top line of text, next to the time.

If the team you are viewing is currently playing a game, the LINE SCORE section of the screen updates the score at the end of each half-inning.

If your team is not currently playing, the LINE SCORE section of the screen displays the results of the most recent game, with **FINAL** indicating that the game is over.

Use the DATA button to switch between the schedule of upcoming games and each team's standings so far. Standings are presented in order, with the leading team at the top of the list.

To see the standings in another division, press the DIVISION button. A label indicating which division is displayed is on the far left of the screen, next to the Team column.

PLAYOFFS

During the playoffs, your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard displays current game scores and rankings, as well as final standings for teams not in the playoffs.

Use the \blacktriangleleft or \blacktriangleright button to select which team's schedule and statistics you'd like to see. The team's name is displayed in the top line of text, next to the time.

If your team is currently playing a game, the LINE SCORE section of the screen updates the score at the end of each half-inning.

If your team is not currently playing, the LINE SCORE section of the screen will display the results of your team's most recent game, with **FINAL** indicating that the game is over.

Use the DATA button to switch between the schedule of upcoming games in a division's playoff race and the series standings so far. Standings are presented in order, with the leading team at the top of the list.

Press the DIVISION button to see the playoff race in a different division. A label indicating which division is displayed on the far left of the screen, next to the Team column.

OFF-SEASON

During the off-season, your Wireless Baseball Scoreboard displays final standings from the previous season.

Use the \blacktriangleleft or \blacktriangleright button to select which team's schedule and statistics you'd like to see. The team's name is displayed in the top line of text, next to the time.

The LINE SCORE section of the screen will display the results of the last game the team played in the previous season.

The **SCHEDULE/STANDINGS** section of the screen will summarize the division standings at the end of the previous season. Standings are presented in order, with the leading team at the top of the list.

X indicates that the team has clinched a playoff berth.

- **y** denotes a division champion.
- * indicates wild card winner.
- **FINAL** appears at the end of the Line Score, and indicates that the game is over and the score is final.
- appears in the **SCHEDULE/STANDINGS** section during the playoffs.
- RAIN DELAY indicates that the game was postponed or delayed due to inclement weather
- TODAY'S GAME indicates that the game is being played or was played on the current day.

EXTRA INNINGS INDICATOR

When a game goes into extra innings, the EXTRA INNINGS indicator will appear, with the current inning number displayed to the right of the indicator. All scores in the LINE SCORE will shift to the left. This means you'll always see the scores for the last nine innings. See diagrams below.



NO COVERAGE INDICATOR

NO COVERAGE: TRY ANOTHER LOCATION appears when your device has been unable to receive a signal for an extended period. Check our map at http://map.myambient.com to ensure that your location receives coverage from our network.

CONTACT AMBIENT DEVICES INDICATOR

BATTERY LOW INDICATOR

appears on the screen when your batteries are getting low and will soon need replacement.

ISSUE	RESOLUTION
The unit's display is totally blank	Ensure batteries are fresh and installed correctly according to polarity signs
No network signal.	Go to map.myambient.com and enter your zip code. If you are in an area without a lot of coverage, move the device to another location in your home or office for better reception.
Network time. is not correct.	Press the TIME ZONE button in the battery compartment on the back of the device until the proper time appears.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE (CONTINUED)

ISSUE	RESOLUTION
Dashes appear. on display.	This occurs until the unit receives its first update. If this continues for more than 8 hours, move the unit to a location with better signal coverage, such as near a window or upstairs.
I'm only seeing line score data, where are the standings and schedules?	We update game information more frequently than schedule and standings data, so it's possible that your device has received one update but not the other; in this case, you should receive the other update within the next six hours.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE (CONTINUED)

ISSUE

My clock's time is correct, but it's stuck showing data from a few days ago.

RESOLUTION

This is almost always the result of "lagging," a condition that occurs when your device is not receiving a consistently strong signal. If you notice this happening, try changing the location where you usually keep your Baseball Scoreboard. We recommend that you keep it somewhere where it shows at least two bars of signal strength.

There is a dash in the LINE SCORE, what does that mean? A dash in a score field indicates that the inning is not going to be played, either due to game cancellation, the home team winning after 8 and a half innings, etc.

What can I do to improve battery life?	Your Baseball Scoreboard is designed to use very little battery power when it's receiving a strong signal. If it's in an area with inconsistent or weak signal, it will work harder to make sure it's updating properly. The best thing you can do is ensure it's in an area where it receives three bars of signal strength.			
Some parts of the schedule line-up are blank.	Some things, like starting pitchers or game dates, are not available at the same time as other data; this information will update as soon as it's known.
