

Self-screen Prior to Reporting to Work

The below is a self-screening for non-remote-enabled staff reporting to an Exelon Nuclear station.

You are required to conduct this self-screening before reporting to work.

<p>Are you experiencing <u>ANY</u> of the symptoms: Fever, repeated shaking with chills, cough (a new onset cough that is not a symptom of an on-going chronic health conditions), shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, an unusual continuous headache for greater than 24 hours*, nasal congestion/runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea not due to pre-existing chronic conditions, muscle pain**, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell?</p> <p><i>*Unusual and different from headaches that you previously experienced like a sinus headache, allergy headache or migraines.</i></p> <p><i>** Abnormal muscle aches not due to physical exertion or exercise.</i></p>		
<p>Outside of the work environment in the last 14-days, have you had close contact*** with or cared for someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or that had all the symptoms of COVID-19 (outlined above)?</p> <p><i>***Close contact is defined as being within approximately 6 feet of a COVID-19 case for greater than 10 minutes; close contact can occur while caring for, living with, visiting, or sharing a healthcare waiting area or room with a COVID19 case or having direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (e.g., being coughed on).</i></p>		
<p>Is your temperature greater than or equal to 100.0F?</p>		

If the answer is “yes” to any question, you must call the Site Nurse for instructions. Don’t come to work until cleared by Occupational and Health Services (OHS). If directed to stay home, call the Absence Reporting Line 1-877-7EXELON (1-877-739-3566) and call your Supervisor.

If the answer is “no” to all three questions, please feel free to come to work as normal.
