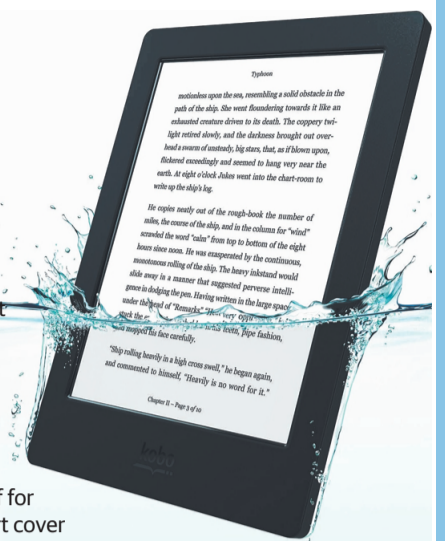

### KOGAN PORTABLE FISH FINDER

The Kogan portable fish finder can tell you just about everything you need to know to successfully catch fish. On the fish finder's display, you will see fish icons that show you the location of fish in the water, including what depth they are swimming at. You can even set an alarm to sound when the fish finder detects fish that correspond to the alarm setting. The system uses sonar to locate and define structure, bottom contour and composition, as well depth directly below the transducer.

### KOBO WATERPROOF E-READER

LOVE sinking into the bath for a good soak and relaxing with your favourite book or magazine but fear the pages will get soggy? Even e-readers or tablets won't survive a quick accidental dunking. Banishing those fears for bookworms is the Kobo Aura H2O waterproof e-reader which has just arrived in Australia. Officially launched late last year as the "world's premium waterproof and dustproof e-reader", it promises to be waterproof for up to 30 minutes in a metre of water with the port cover closed. "So if you drop it in the bath or accidentally spill a drink on it, your Kobo Aura H2O will still work like new," states the website. "Just use the included drying cloth to dry the screen, so you can get back to reading." The latest Kobo comes with up to two months of battery life.

### VIRB ELITE ACTION CAM

Garmin's take on an action cam offers a point of difference: they tap into data from a heart-rate strap so action videos show how you handled rushes of adrenaline. The VIRB Elite is bigger than some action cams but it's waterproof without the need for extra housing. It has a 1.4-inch screen, can capture 16-megapixel still images, and can shoot up to three hours of full-HD video. It also has image stabilisation, built-in GPS, an accelerometer, and altimeter.
