- Lot Number/Serial Placement:
  - Lot number is located on a sticker placed on the cross frame.
  - There are some differences in the components and vary by version. The lot number is crucial to identify which version the customer purchased.

### **Appendix A - Components**

Please note the lot number as some of these components differ per version. The below specifies the components found in each version.

Item	Photo
Items with lot numbers that begin with 885 Hardware – Contains 1 washer, 5 short (same size) hand screws and 4 long (same size) hand screws  Note: Short hand screws are same size, 4 screws is used to attach the backrest pad to the backrest pad frames. 1 screw is inserted through the center of seat to secure the frames (see picture on top right)  Items with lot numbers that begin with 956 Hardware – Contains 1 washer, 5 short (1 may be longer than the other 4 short hand screws) hand screws and 4 long (same size) hand screws  Note: 4 short hand screws will be the same size and are used to attach the backrest pad to the backrest pad frames. 1 hand screw will be longer and will be inserted through the center of seat to secure the frames (see picture on bottom right)	Photo
1 Backrest pad	
Items with lot numbers that begin with 885 -1 Seat - pre-stamped with a '1' and '2' to aid in assembly. Please note that the seat may appear different than in the picture.  Items with lot numbers that begin with 956 1 Seat - pre-stamped with 'A' and 'B' to aid in assembly. Please note that the seat may appear different than in the picture




### Appendix B

- 1. Place the seat upside down on top of a raised flat surface. You should be able to the indentations of where the frame should be placed.
- 2. Note the seat will be imprinted with '1' and '2' for the version with lots numbers beginning with '885'. This will be the **back** end of the seat.

Note the seat will be imprinted with 'A' and 'B' for the version with lots numbers beginning with '956'. This will be the **front** of the seat.



3. Locate the main frames, these are imprinted with '1' and '2'. Match the frame imprinted with '1' to the indentation on the seat imprinted '1' or 'A' (depending on the version). Do the same for the frame and seat imprinted with '2' or 'B'. **Note**: the '1'/ 'A' frame is on the bottom, while the '2'/ 'B' rests on top of '1' / 'A' as shown below.

4. Use the washer and one (1) of the five (5) short hand screws provided to secure the center cross section.

Note: items with lot numbers beginning with '885' will all have the same size short hand screws. Items with lot numbers beginning with '956' will have one that is longest of the short screws and this one will be used to secure the cross section.



- 5. Lay the bench on its side.
- 6. To attach the backrest tubes to the bottom of the bench, use the four (4) long hand screws. Each hand screw should be inserted through the back rest tube and leg tube. Ensure that the back rest tubes to attach the backrest pad is towards the back end of the seat. **Reminder:** the back end of the seat is where the imprinted '1' and '2' are located for items with lot numbers beginning with '885'. Items with lot numbers beginning with '956' will have 'A' and 'B' imprinted on the front side of the seat.

7. Ensure the leg extensions are adjusted to the same height. The leg extensions have six (6) different notches.



8. Stand the chair upright and use the remaining four (4) short hand screws to attach the backrest pad.



9. Please note that the armrest holsters are on the side of the frame as shown below.

10. Insert one arm rest into the armrest holders as shown below. Please note that the arm rests should flare outward.
