13 DESCRIPTION OF EQUIPMENT

The subject equipment is a small, self-contained, battery powered, wireless, infrared to Bluetooth transceiver that communicates with hand-held portable gas detection instruments. The existing handheld instruments were designed with infrared transceiver capabilities, using a tiny optical port on the lower rear of the housing. This assembly is designed to physically mate with the existing instruments so that the optical ports on both devices align, enabling infrared digital information exchange. The device performs translation of this data and is provided with a wireless Bluetooth RF transceiver to exchange digital signal data with other (unspecified) Bluetooth devices located within a limited range of < 10 meters.


Several versions of this battery powered, self-contained device are available. One version utilizes an ultrasonically welded housing, and is designed to be disposable. The other version is provided with a two part housing that is held together with four M2 screws to facilitate battery replacement. Both of these variants are made available with, and without a momentary contact switch in the area where this device mounts to the "host" instrument.

All versions utilize a single 3V lithium manganese dioxide (Li/MnO₂) coin cell primary type battery, with a diameter of approximately 24.5 mm, by 5 mm thick as the only energy source. There is no wiring to or from this device. A periodically blinking LED signal on the front of the device is the only visible indication that the device is functioning.

The equipment is intended to mount directly to the rear surface face of a portable hand-held gas detection instrument. The geometry of a male boss, moulded into the rear of the housing is intended to mate with the geometry of a female boss moulded into the rear of the gas detection instrument, securing it in place.

Model BWC-1000 is the same as above, but it has an alternate mounting base.






