1% Sales Tax Revenue County Share - 19.1936% of Total Collections

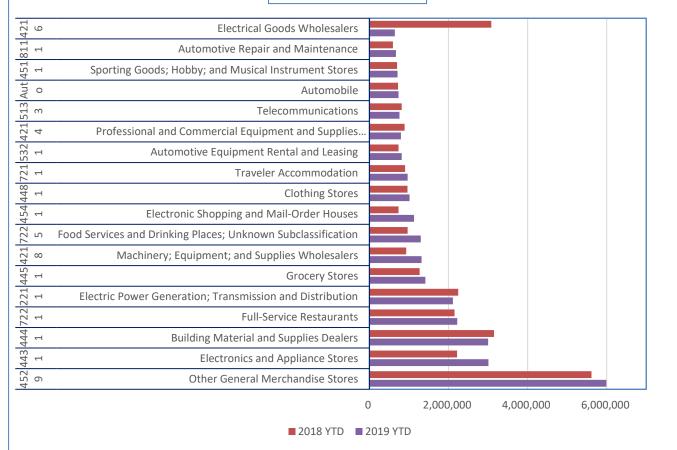

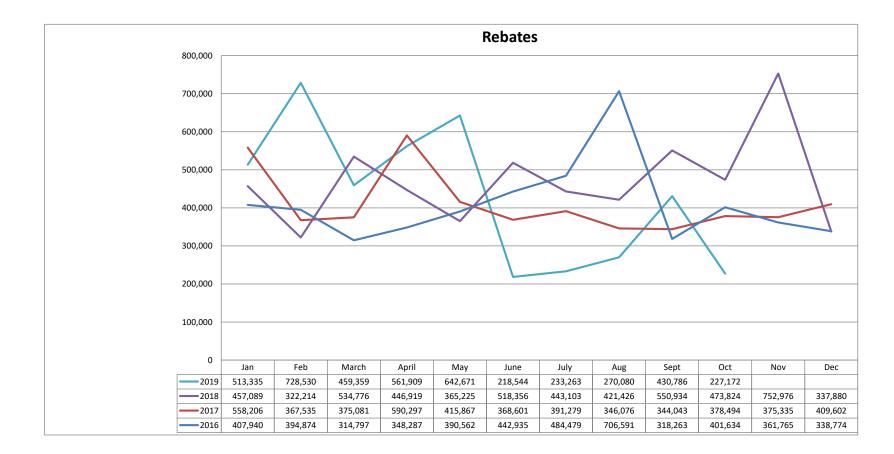

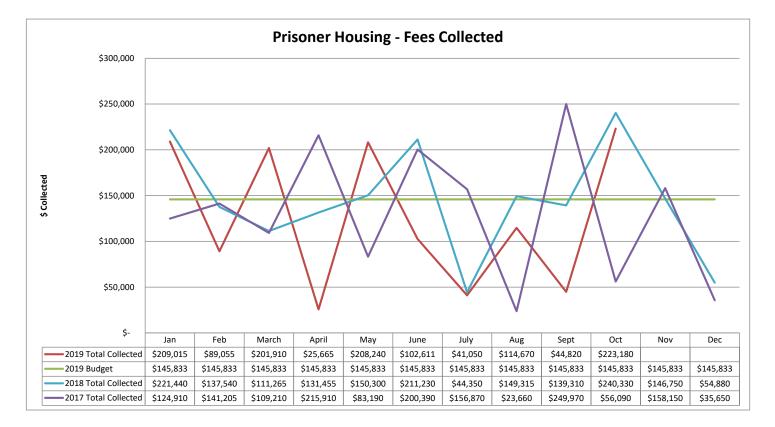

Judge Karren Capital Request for Courtroom Technology 10/28/19:

Division II of Benton County Circuit Court utilizes virtual/video appearances on Mondays of criminal dockets for an average of 50 prisoners per day. A few weeks ago we had a failure in the video system and my court reporter went to the jail to make the record in the presence of the inmates and defense counsel and Judge Karren conducted proceedings via telephone from the Division II courtroom. During proceedings the reporter had to repeatedly ask the participants in the courtroom to speak up as the audio level was not sufficient for the defendants and defense counsel to be able to hear proceedings. While an upgrade for the microphones was planned for down the road, it is now apparent this upgrade needs to be advanced in order to continue video proceedings in a manner that the defendants and defense counsel can hear.

I have funds in my courtroom technology budget that were earmarked for other items which I am going to put off so that those funds can be applied to this upgrade and would request the Quorum Court approve funding the balance of the cost of this upgrade.
