


# how to use the cam lock system




Screw cam bolt into panel




Align cam bolt(s) with cross-bored hole(s) and insert all the way until panels are flush



Push cam into panel - arrow feature on cam top points to panel edge




Rotate cam(s) clockwise 180° to lock panels together




Panels should be tight against each other and connection should be rigid

# step 1: attach trim and bottom panel to left side panel




- 1.1. Carefully tap small wooden dowels into place in left side panel. Leave 1/2" of the dowels sticking out.
- 1.2. Screw-In cam bolts must be screwed down flush in left side panel.
- 1.3. Refer to page 7 for instructions on how to use the cam lock system. Do not over tighten bolts.

## step 2: attach right side panel




- 2.1. Carefully tap small wooden dowels into place in right side panel. Leave 1/2" of the dowels sticking out.
- 2.2. Screw-In cam bolts must be screwed down flush in right side panel.
- 2.3. Refer to page 7 for instructions on how to use the cam lock system. Do not over tighten bolts.

## step 3: attach top panel



- 3.1. Carefully tap small wooden dowels into place in top panel. Leave 1/2" of the dowels sticking out.
- 3.2. Align bolts with pre-drilled holes to attach side panels to top panel. Do not over tighten bolt.

# step 4: attach back panel




\*\*FAILURE TO FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS ON THIS PAGE MAY RESULT IN UNEVEN DOOR ALIGNMENT\*\*

Begin by installing all of the screws along one edge of the back panel. Next, using a square or tape measure, make sure that the cabinet is square. (If using a tape measure, the distance from one corner, diagonally to the other corner should be the same in both directions.) If not, apply gentle pressure to the diagonally opposite corners to shift case into alignment. Re-measure to ensure equal distances. Install the remaining screws, starting with the corners.

(H8) x 19 5/8" pan-head screw









4.1. Make sure the pan-head screws go through the pre-drilled holes properly to attach back panel. Do not over tighten screws.

# step 5: attach knobs to doors



5.1 Align knob bolts with pre-drilled holes to attach knobs to doors. Do not over tighten bolts.

# step 6: attach doors to cabinet




(H11) x 8 short flat-head screw



6.1 Align flat-head screws with pre-drilled holes to attach doors to cabinet. Do not over tighten screws.

# step 7: install adjustable shelves




(H12) x 4 shelf supports




- 7.1. Insert shelf supports into desired hole. Different holes accommodate different shelf heights.
- 7.2. Angle shelf to fit between the rails and set on top of shelf supports.

## step 8: assemble drawer box




- 8.3. Screw-In cam bolts must be screwed down flush in drawer front and drawer back.
- 8.4. Refer to page 7 for instructions on how to use the cam lock system. Do not over tighten bolts.
- 8.5. Align flat-head screws with pre-drilled holes to attach drawer back. Do not over tighten screws.

9.2 Align tracks on drawer box with tracks on left side panel and right side panel.



### how to adjust door alignment

#### Tips for proper door alignment:

- -Adjustable levelers will reduce minor door mis-alignments caused by an uneven floor.
- -Use a level to determine if the cabinet top is level. If not, start with the levelers retracted and adjust them as needed. To retract the levelers turn them counterclockwise. To extend the levelers turn them clockwise.
- -If door mis-alignment persists, refer back to Step 4 (pg. 11) for additional information. If the cabinet is not square you will need to repeat this step.




