Install the ReadySHARE Vault Utility

➤ **To install the ReadySHARE Vault utility on your Windows computer:**

1. Connect a USB HDD to a USB port on your router.
2. Visit <http://support.netgear.com/product/ReadySHARE%2bVault>.
3. In the Downloads section, click the **ReadySHARE Vault PC Utility** link.
The file downloads to the your computer.
4. Open the file and follow the onscreen instructions to install the utility.

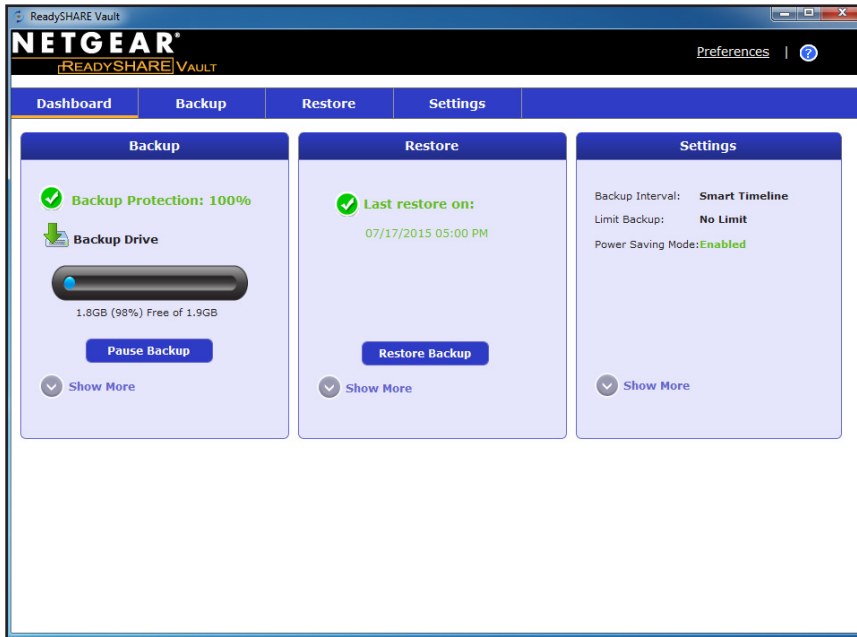

Back Up Files to a HDD

➤ To back up files on your Windows computer to a HDD connected to your router:

1. Connect a USB HDD to a USB port on your router.
2. Launch ReadySHARE Vault.



3. Click the **Backup** tab.
The backup page displays.

4. In the Select Backup Drive section, click the **Show More** menu and select a HDD you want to back up your files to.

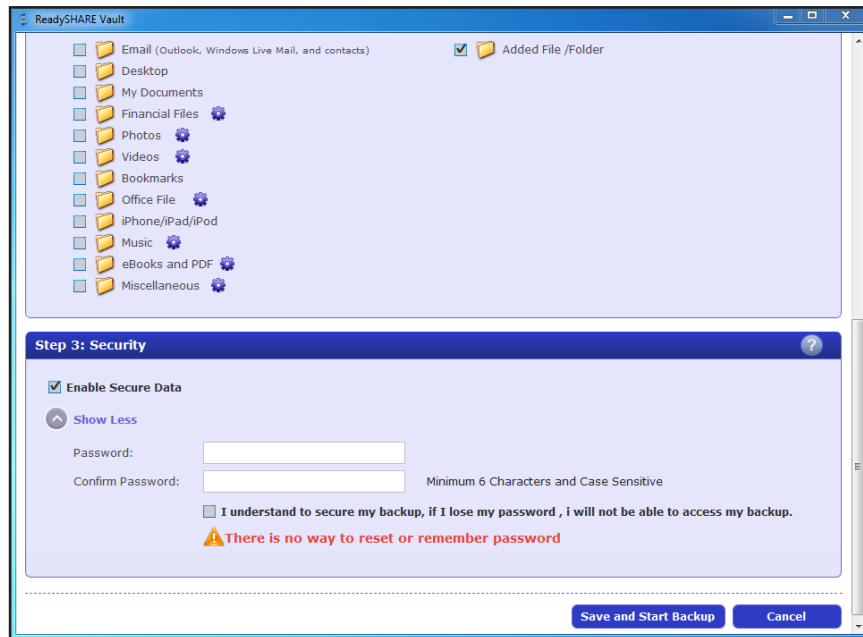


5. (Optional) To rename the folder that your backup files will be save to, click the **Rename Backup Folder** link and do the following:
 - a. Click the **Rename Backup Folder** radio button.
 - b. In the **Backup Folder** field, enter a new name for the folder.
 - c. Click the **Save** button.
6. In the Select Files and Folder section, you can select all, or click check boxes to select specific files and folders on your computer that you want backed up to the HDD.



You can click one of the following options to view the folders and files on your computer:

- Click the **Show More** menu to view the main folders on your computer.
 - Click the **Select Additional Files/Folder** link to view all the folders and files on your computer.
7. (Optional) In the Security section, if you want your backup to be password protected, select the **Enable Secure Data** check box.



If you set up a password, then you will have to enter it in order to access the backups. ReadySHARE Vault does not save the password, so make sure that you store it in a secure location.

8. Click the **Show More** menu and enter a password in the **Password** and **Confirm Password** fields.
9. Select the **I understand** check box to accept the security warning.
10. Click the **Save and Start Backup** button.

Your changes are saved.
