

**CITY OF HAVEN
BURN SITE**
State Permit # 1033

Hours: 11 AM – 7 PM Wednesdays & Saturdays (April 15 – October 1)
 10 AM - 6 PM Wednesdays & Saturdays (October 2 – April 14)
 (Weather Dependent)

Use:

Any use of the Burn Site must be during the site's regular hours with the following exceptions:

- Use by City employees or City-hired contractors for City purposes.
- Tree services dumping trees and brush from work performed within the City.
- USD 312.

Tree services and USD 312 may be let in by Public Works outside of burn site hours (but during regular City hours) subject to Public Works' availability.

Outside of use by the City, tree services, and USD 312, use of the burn site should be only by City of Haven residential trash customers. Burn site users may be asked by the burn site attendant to validate their status as a City of Haven residential trash customer by showing their City bill or bill stub or state-issued photo ID indicating an address within the City limits of Haven.

The burn site attendant is authorized to turn away users who do not meet the above criteria.

Materials

Trees and brush may be accepted at the State-licensed burn site from City of Haven residential trash customers only.

Slide-off hoppers are kept at the site as a convenience to Haven residents. At the present time we have containers for scrap metal and trash.

The following materials or items are NOT allowed to be placed in the hoppers, either because they are not accepted at the Reno County landfill when mixed with household trash, or because they will fill up the hopper and do not allow fair use by all citizens:

- Tires
- Batteries
- Oil
- Paint
- Chemicals
- Concrete
- Pallets
- Railroad ties
- Construction/remodeling debris*
- Roofing or shingles
- Appliances that have contained refrigerant
- Commercial or business trash.

The burn site attendant is authorized to determine what items may be accepted and where they will be unloaded.

* Small amounts of construction / remodeling debris may be accepted at the discretion of the burn site attendant. If you have a big project you will need to rent your own container.
