Remedial Massage	Diploma of Remedial Massage (HLT52015 – formerly HLT50302/7)	 ANTA MMA (AAMT) AMT MA MAA ATMS SNTR AACMA MA (IRMA) FCMA ANPA nib updated the criteria for remedial massage in August 2006. Prior to this, a Cert IV in massage (otherwise known as 'old' Diploma) was required. Since August 2006 all providers need to hold a current Diploma of Remedial Massage (HLT50302, HLT50307 or HLT52015) to register with nib (regardless of when they completed their qualifications). Providers with Diplomas issued prior to August 2006 are 'Grandfathered' and therefore eligible for recognition, but must maintain current Membership (including Insurance, First-Aid and CPE) with an Association.
